It is hoped that care will be taken to send characteristic specimens. The names of places should also be written in a legible manner.

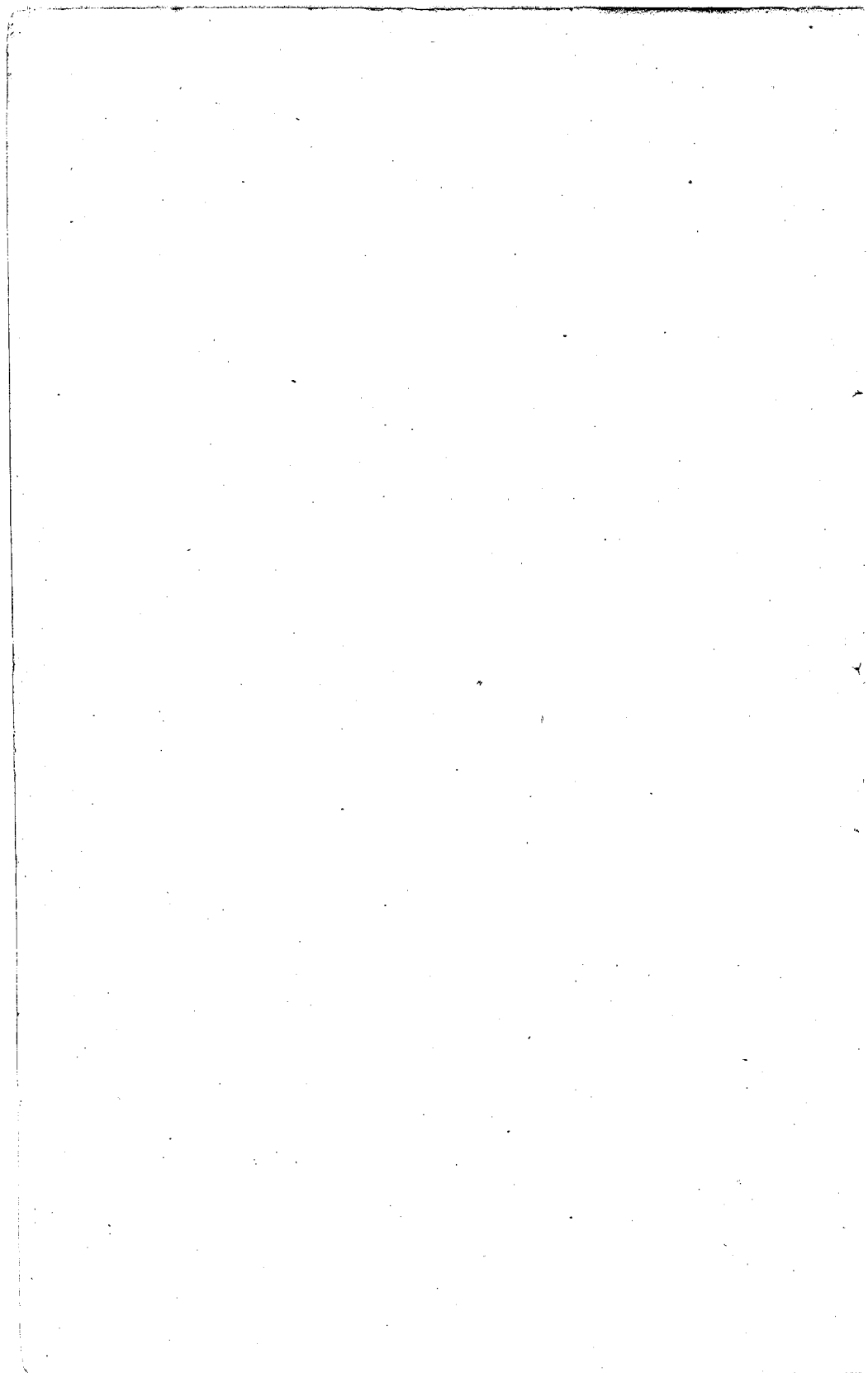

**L. tenuis**, Kitaibel. Upland pasture, Harlow Hill, Harrogate, M. W. Yorks. *Thos. J. Foggitt.*

**Astragalus glycyphyllus**, Linn. Woods, Gloddaeth, Llandudno, Carnarvon. *Chas. Bailey.*

**Vicia Orobus**, DC. North Devon. It extends about a hundred yards along a hedge-bank by the road-side about two miles from Bradworthy on the road to Killchampton. Found

by the late Mr. Husband, by whom it was given to Mr. Ed. Parfitt, of the Devon and Exeter Institution. *Hewett C. Watson.*

*Lathyrus sylvestris*, Linn. Thickets on landslip, Fairlight Glen, East Sussex. *Mrs. B. M. Oakeshott.*

*Agrimonia odorata*, Miller. Coppice, White Hill, Caterham, Surrey. Three plants found within a few yards of each other. *F. C. S. Roper.*

*Poterium muricatum*, Spach. Field near Chelsfield, West Kent. *J. Groves.*

*Alchemilla montana*, Willd. Pasture, Stichel, Roxburgh. As common as the type in Berwick, Selkirk, and Northumberland. *A. Brotherston.* — Near Tal-y-llyn Station, Brecon. Cwm Idwal, Carnarvon; only one piece noticed: the type was abundant on the mountain precipices. Near head of Bassenthwaite Lake, Cumberland. *A. Ley.* — Muncaster Castle, Ravensglass, Cumberland. Fields on the banks of the Wye, in the neighbourhood of Miller's Dale, Derbyshire. *Chas. Bailey.*

*Potentilla alpestris*, Hall, fl. Clogwyn-y-garnedd, Snowdon, Carnarvonshire. One or two small plants only seen. *A. Ley.*

*Rubus suberectus*, Anders. In an old wood near Guestling, East Sussex. *Mrs. B. M. Oakeshott.* — Chartley Moss, and Whitmore, Staffordshire. *John Fraser.*

*R. Lindleianus*, Lees. Near Sturry and Canterbury, East Kent. *T. B. Blow.* — Newbald, S.E. Yorks. *H. F. Parsons.*

*R. leucostachys*, Sm. *Vestitus.* Near Wolverhampton, Staffordshire. *John Fraser.* — Near Welwyn, Herts. *T. B. Blow.*

*R. macrophyllus*, Weihe. Border of Haywoods, Baddersley Clinton, Warwick. *Schlechtendalii.* *J. Bagnall.* — Leckley Wood, near Arley, Staffordshire. *John Fraser.* Near *amplificatus.*

*R. diversifolius*, Lindl. Moat-bank, Codsall, Stafford. *John Fraser.*

*R. Bagnalli*, Blox. Haywoods, near Baddersley Clinton, Warwick; very abundant. Mr. Bloxam considers it a distinct species. Prof. Babington considers it distinct as a variety of *Rubus Briggsii.* New to Britain, and first found September, 1874. *James Bagnall.*

*R. Lejeunii*, Weihe. Leckley Wood, near Arley, Stafford. *John Fraser.*

*R. Guntheri*, Weihe. Leckley Wood, near Arley, Stafford. *J. Fraser.* — Woods near Canterbury, East Kent. *T. B. Blow.* — Harmer Green Wood, near Welwyn, Herts. *Jas. Groves* and *T. B. Blow.*

*R. atro-rubens*, Blox. Wood near Canterbury, East Kent. *T. B. Blow.* — Solihul, lane from Shirley to railway-station. *James Bagnall.*

**Rubus cæsius**, Linn. *Ulmifolius*, Presl. Tweed-side, Kelso.  
*A. Brotherston*.

**R. cæsius**, Linn. *Pseudo-Idæus*, Weihe. Springwood Park woods, Kelso, Roxburgh. *A. Brotherston*. Seems to be the form noticed by Prof. Babington, which differs from the Herts plant by having the terminal leaflet narrowed to the base.

**Rosa Doniana**, Woods. Near Patrick's Bridge. Lane to Meriden Marsh, Hampton-in-Arden, Warwickshire. Also at Allersley and near Warwick. *James Bagnall*.

**R. pomifera**, Herm. Roadside at the highest part of the ridge above Sweethorpe, Roxburgh. Two plants on different sides of the road, as far as possible, under the circumstances, from any house or garden, half-way between two farm-places. I never saw it in a garden in the district, so that I have no idea how it got there. *A. Brotherston*. Possibly native, as Ray localizes it 'in montosis septentrionalibus Eboracensis et Westmorlandici agri copiose.' See Mr. Baker's Monograph. *T. B. Blow*.

**R. mollissima**, Willd. Hedge near Fawley, South Hants. *J. Groves*. A notable New County Record, much extending the known distribution of the plant.

**R. tomentosa**, Sm., *var.* Hedge, Barnes, Kelso, Roxburgh. *A. Brotherston*. Seems very near to *R. sylvestris*, Woods.

**R. micrantha**, Sm. Hedge, Muirdean, Kelso, Roxburgh. *A. Brotherston*. — Walhampton, near Lymington, South Hants. *H. Groves*.

**R. Watsoni**, Baker. Hedge near Kelso, Roxburgh. Ditch-side near Roxburgh Castle. *A. Brotherston*.

**R. marginata**, Wallr. Meadow by Blythe Bridge, near Solihul, Warwickshire. *Jas. Bagnall*.

**Cratægus oxyacanthoides**, Thuil. Bury-me-wick, Cresbrook Dale, Derbyshire. Eastern side of Wardlow Hay Cop, near Monsal Dale, Derbyshire. *Chas. Bailey*.

**C. monogyna**, Jacq. Border of wood, Ecclesbourne Glen, East Sussex. *Mrs. B. M. Oakeshott*.

**Epilobium eu-tetragonum**, Syme. Roadside to Cobo Bay, Guernsey. Very fine and typical. This seems to be the plant of Guernsey. *E. obscurum*, Schreb., of Jersey.

**Hippuris vulgaris**, Linn. Marsh-ditch near Water-works, Eastbourne, East Sussex. Rather rare in neighbourhood. *F. C. S. Roper*.

**Callitriche obtusangula**, Le Gall. Ditch near Abbey Wood Railway Station, West Kent. *H. and J. Groves*. — Slow stream, Romsey, South Hants. *Jas. Groves*. — Roadside ditch near the level crossing of the railway near Bottisham Lock, Cambridge.

*T. B. Blow*. — St. Peter's Marsh, Jersey. Pond near the sea St. Sampsons, Guernsey. *T. B. Blow*. New to the Channel Islands. — Mitcham Common, Surrey. *H. and J. Groves*. — Ditches at Amwell, Herts; also near River's Mouth, near Rye House. I had not time to cross the river to see if it grew in the ditches on the Essex side. *T. B. Blow*.

*Saxifraga sponhemica*, Gmel. North cliffs of Carnedd Daffydd, Carnarvonshire. Cwm Glasian, near Dinas Mowddwy, Merionethshire. *A. Ley*.

*S. hypnoides*, Linn. Wyndcliff Woods, Monmouth. *A. Ley*. — Victoria Cave, Settle, M.W. Yorks. *H. F. Parsons*.

*Cicuta virosa*, Linn. Appleby, near Cheshunt, Herts. In a swampy pool, borders of a meadow, luxuriant. *Eyre de Crespigny*. — Rare, and seemingly confined to the south-east of the county. *T. B. B.*

*Seseli Libanotis*, Koch. Amongst furze between Beachy Head and Bell Point Lighthouse, Eastbourne. Rare, but occurs also between the mouth of the Cuckmere and Seaford, E. Sussex. *F. C. S. Roper*.

*Rubia peregrina*, Linn. Hedge near Sowley Pond, Lyvington, South Hants. *James Groves*.

*Galium erectum*, Huds. By side of Luton Railway, near Ayott Green, Welwyn, Herts. *T. B. Blow*.

*Arctium minus*, Schk. Roadside between Winterton and Winterringham, North Lincoln. *W. Fowler*.

*Valerianella eriocarpa*, Desv. Undercliff, Portland, Dorset. *J. C. Mansell-Pleydell*. No specimen sent.

*Serratula tinctoria*, Linn. *Monticola*, Bor. Large meadow, York Road, near Thirsk. *T. J. Foggitt*. — Fields at Saltfleetby, North Lincoln. *W. Fowler*.

*Centaurea Isnardi*, Linn. Hills above St. Ouen's Pond, Jersey. Sands opposite Grand Mere, Vazon Bay, Guernsey. *T. B. Blow*.

*Filago spathulata*, Presl. Roadside near Sowley Pond, Lyvington, South Hants. *J. Groves*.

*Gnaphalium sylvaticum*, Linn. Near Broughton Wood and Sawcliffe, North Lincoln. *W. Fowler*.

*Senecio erucifolius*, Linn. Newtown, St. Boswell, Roxburgh; also on Hadden. *A. Brotherston*.

*Aster Tripolium*, Linn. Shore of the Frith mouth of the Forth, Stirling. *A. Croall*.

*Taraxacum erythrospermum*, DC. Downs above Meads, Eastbourne, East Sussex. *F. C. S. Roper*. — Between Welwyn and Woolmer Green, Herts. *T. B. Blow*.

*Phyteuma spicatum*, Linn. Abbott's Wood, between

Arlington and Hailsham, E. Sussex. Very abundant over nearly a mile of ground. *F. C. S. Roper.*

*Vaccinium Vitis-idaea*, Linn. Hills above Mitchel-Tray, Monmouthshire. *A. Ley.*

*Arctostaphylos Uva-ursi*, Wimm. Senior Clough, near the source of the Derwent; also on Kinder Scout, Derbyshire. *M. Ward* and *J. Whitehead.*

*Andromeda polifolia*, Linn. Boggy ground by the railway near Llanllwch, Carmarthenshire. I have only seen one large clump of it. *H. L. Jones.*

*Pyrola secunda*, Linn. Limestone woods, Wyndcliff, Monmouthshire. Occupying five or six square yards of ground, in conjunction with *P. minor*, at a station long known for that species. Over this space the plants of *P. secunda* were scattered in tolerable abundance. *A. Ley.* A most remarkable and unexpected New County Record for Monmouth. From Mr. Ley's remarks there would seem no doubt as to its nativity. It is scarcely likely to have been planted; and Mr. Watson informs me that *Pyrolas* bear removal badly. *T. B. B.*

*Fraxinus excelsior*, Linn. Mull. Appears to be native. *Geo. Ross.*

*Linaria vulgaris-repens*. Hedge-banks between Weston and Clarbeston, Pembrokehire, with *L. repens* and *vulgaris*. *H. L. Jones.*

*Veronica humifusa*, Dicks. Cliff of Cwm Lloer, Carnedd Daffydd, Carnarvonshire. *A. Ley.*

*Nepeta Cataria*, Linn. Between Scotter and Scotton, N. Lincoln. *W. Fowler.* 'An escape?' *Top. Bot.* p. 307. Dr. Lees thinks it is undoubtedly wild.

*Lithospermum purpuro-cæruleum*, Linn. Among dense thickets by the sea, Salcombe Valley, Sidmouth, South Devon. *W. M. Rogers.*

*Pinguicula vulgaris*, Linn. Boggy springs, Newbald, and Riccall Common, S.E. Yorks. *H. F. Parsons.*

*Statice bahusiensis*, Fries. Walton-on-the-Naze, North Essex. *Ch. Babington.* A very old locality, mentioned by Dale and Ray.

*Rumex rupestris*, Le Gall. In the joints of the brickwork of a water-way close to the shore at Beaumont, Jersey. Mr. Newbould has, I believe, seen it at St. Aubins, which is close by. *T. B. Blow.*

*R. conspersus*, Hartm. Plentiful on Tweedside near Kelso, mostly on gravelly places liable to be flooded; sometimes on the grassy banks, but always near the river-side. Both of its reputed parents, *R. obtusifolius* and *R. aquaticus*, grow with it. *A. Brotherston.*

**Polygonum arenastrum**, Bor., and **P. littorale**, Link. On the beach south of St. Bees' Head, between St. Bees' and Nethertown, Cumberland. *Chas. Bailey.*

**Hippophae rhamnoides**, Linn. Coast near Tongue, West Sutherland. Old gnarled trees, twenty-five to thirty feet high. *Geo. Horn.* Mr. Horn expresses no opinion respecting nativity.

**Thesium humifusum**, DC. Downs above Cow Gap; also at Beachy Head and Cowlink, East Sussex. *F. C. S. Roper.*

**Salix hirta**, Sm. Boggy ground in plantation, Rutherford, Roxburgh. *A. Brotherston.*

**Potamogeton polygonifolius**, Pour., var. *pseudo-fluitans*, Syme. Peaty pools, Trelleck Bog, Monmouthshire. *A. Ley.*

**P. nitens**, Web. Tweed, Norham, Northumberland. *A. Brotherston.*

**P. lucens**, Linn., var. *decipiens*, Nolte. In the River Wye near Sellack, Herefordshire. Plentiful, and fruiting freely. *A. Ley.*

**P. pusillus**, Linn., var. *tenuissimus*. Pond at Low Ling, parish of Westward, Cumberland. *R. Wood.*

**P. scoparius**, Syme. Ditches at sea-side, Great Coates, North Lincoln. *W. Fowler.*

**Zannichellia eu-palustris**, Syme. In the Staffordshire Canal near the stone bridge at Ketley, near Kingswinford, Staffordshire. *F. A. Lees.*

**Habenaria chlorantha**, Bab. Broughton Wood, N. Lincoln. *W. Fowler.* — Mountain meadow near Capel Curig, Carnarvon. More common than *H. eu-bifolia*. *A. Ley.*

**Spiranthes æstivalis**, Rich. Bogs on both sides of the road near Lyndhurst, South Hants. St. Ouen's Pond, Jersey. Grand Mere, Vazon Bay, Guernsey, in abundance. *T. B. Blow.*

**Iris Bastardi**, Bor. Several plants in the broad ditches by the side of the main line of the Great Eastern Railway near the River's Mouth, Broxbourne, Herts. *H. Groves* and *T. B. Blow.*

**Polygonatum officinale**, All. Black Rock, near Tenby, *H. L. Jones.*

**Juncus maritimus**, Sm. Banks of Esk in Muncaster Park, in the neighbourhood of Ravenglass, Cumberland. *Chas. Bailey.*

**Blysmus rufus**, Link. Sea-shore, Humberstone, N. Lincoln. *W. Fowler.*

**Carex divulsa**, Good. Roadside bank, Fuggleston, South Newton, S. Wilts. *W. M. Rogers.*

**C. axillaris**, Good. Bank of ditch, Woodend, Lympington, S. Hants. *H. Groves.*

**C. elongata**, Linn. Bradnocks Marsh, and lane from Meriden Marsh to Berkswell, Warwickshire. *Jas. Bagnall.*

**C. Watsoni**, Syme. Tweed-side between Yair Bridge and Caddenfoot, Selkirk. *A. Brotherston.*

*Carex ornithopoda*, Willd. On grassy slopes beneath limestone cliffs, Cresbrook Dale, near Monsal Dale, Derbyshire. A station pointed out to me by Mr. Thos. Rogers, two miles north-east of the Miller's Dale station, where this species was discovered by Mr. Whitehead. *Chas. Bailey*.

*C. distans*, Linn. Chesterton Mill-pond, near Harbury, fairly abundant; also at Itchington Nolt and Binton Bridge, near Stratford-on-Avon, Warwickshire. All on same geological formation, lias. *Jas. Bagnall*. — Water-meadows, Stapleford, S. Wilts. *W. M. Rogers*. — Walsworth and Norton Commons, near Hitchin, Herts. *T. B. Blow*. — Meadows below Tinterne, Monmouthshire. *A. Ley*. — Sea-shore, Tobermory, Mull. *Geo. Ross*. This sub-littoral sedge would seem to have been passed over as *C. fulva*. A specimen so named, from Hitchin, is in the Edinburgh herbarium; it was collected many years ago by Mr. Isaac Brown. If specially looked for, it will probably be found in many inland counties. *T. B. B.*

*C. punctata*, Gaud. Cliffs, Moulin Huet Bay, Guernsey. Grand Mere, Vazon Bay, Guernsey. In Grand Mere it is confined to one spot, about an acre, associated with *Spiranthes astivalis*, *Pyrola rotundifolia*, *Epipactis palustris*, &c. — This may account for Dr. Syme and Mr. Watson failing to find it. *T. B. Blow*.

*C. fulva*, Good. Sutton Park, above Blackroot. The only Warwickshire habitat, and now scarce, owing to the railway having been cut through the marsh in which it grows. *Jas. Bagnall*.

*C. lepidocarpa*, Tausch. Salcombe Hill, near Sidmouth, South Devon. *W. M. Rogers*. — Bog, Trelleck, Monmouthshire. *A. Ley*. — Hills above Bettws-y-Coed, Carnarvon. *A. Ley*. — Forms intermediate between this species and *C. flava* are sent from Stapleford, South Wilts. *W. M. Rogers*. — Mountain-side near Llanthony, Monmouth. *A. Ley*. — Swampy ground in St. Helen's Wood, near Hastings, East Sussex. *Mrs. B. M. Oakeshott*.

*C. riparia*, Curt. Bank of River Wye opposite Hadden Castle, Derbyshire. *Chas. Bailey*.

*Agrostis interrupta*, Linn. Tuddenham Heath, W. Suffolk. *W. Jordan*.

*Aira alpina*, Linn. Northern precipices of Cairn Gorm, Easternness. *A. Ley*.

*Catabrosa littoralis*, Parnell. Shore of the River Dee at Hoylake Point, Cheshire. *J. Harbord Lewis*.

*Sclerochloa loliacea*, Woods. Priestholm, on Puffin Island, Anglesea. *R. H. Alcock*. — Sandy places, Ilfracombe, Devon, sparingly. *T. B. Flower*.

**Festuca ambigua**, Le Gall. Sandy ground by the station on Gorey Common, Jersey. I noticed this almost on the sandy edge of the platform when waiting for the train. I had not time to ascertain whether it was in quantity. New to the Channel Islands. *T. B. Blow.*

**Bromus madritensis**, Linn. Sandy places, Exmouth, South Devon, scarce. *T. B. Flower.*

**B. mollis**, Linn., var. *glabrescens*. Roadside, Kelso; in some parts as common as the type.

**Lastræa Filix-mas**, Presl., var. *abbreviatum*. Cwm-glasback, Snowdon. One small root: all the fronds, and the withered ones of last year similar. *A. Ley.*

**L. Oreopteris**, Presl. Side of wood near Hawsham, North Lincoln. *W. Fowler.*— Bog at Trelleck, Monmouthshire. *A. Ley.*— Alderbury Common, South Wilts. *W. M. Rogers.*

**Polypodium Phegopteris**, Linn. Mountain-side, Llanthony Valley, Monmouthshire. Plentiful in company with *P. Dryopteris*, and, in places, *P. Robertianum*. The latter I did not notice within the Monmouth border. *A. Ley.*

**Equisetum palustre**, Linn., var. *polystachium*. Crosby Warren, North Lincoln. *W. Fowler.*
