The Wisconsin Department of Corrections is excited to announce the kick-off of the new automated COMPAS PSI. As of July 1, 2014 all new Pre-Sentence Investigations ordered by the court will be completed in this new format. July of 2014 marks almost 4 years of work by the Statewide PSI Committee in developing the new PSI created through COMPAS. The objective in creating this new PSI report is to incorporate additional evidence-based criminogenic risk and need information into the document, while still preserving valuable, comprehensive, and concise social history information relative to our defendants. We sincerely hope the final product accomplishes this goal.

Attached to this email you will find a mock version of the new PSI that will provide you with a good example of the new format and what you should expect to see in the coming months.

Likewise, please feel free to utilize the link below for a 16-minute ELearn video that offers more information about why we are moving in this direction and how the new structure and format of the PSI will be different.
