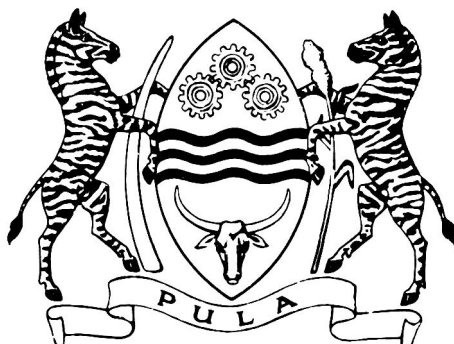

CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorization to Exercise Functions of the Office of President

TO: THE HONOURABLE FESTUS GONTEBANYE MOGAE, M.P., VICE-PRESIDENT, AND MINISTER OF FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT PLANNING

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President to discharge such of the functions of the office of President as he may specify, and the Vice-President may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorization, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana on the 10th December, 1995 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorize you, FESTUS GONTEBANYE MOGAE in your capacity as Vice-President and Minister of Finance and Development Planning, to discharge with effect from the 10th December, 1995, all the functions of the Office of President, except —

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution:

Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant Ministers to act in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available;

- (c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant Minister from office in accordance with the provisions of section 43 of the Constitution;

until my return to Botswana or this authority is revoked by me which ever happens first.

TYPEWRITERS AND OFFICE EQUIPMENT

Telegraphic, telephone and telex tenders will not be considered. Tenders to be submitted in duplicate.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing the Government of Botswana is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender nor to incur any expenses in the preparation thereof.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO TENDERERS

1. Tender for the supply of the above goods will be for the duration of two years.
2. All tenderers must submit a copy of a valid trading licence. Bids unaccompanied by licence will not be considered.
3. Instruction to tenders and general conditions must be strictly adhered to.
4. The cost analysis column of the schedule of quantities must be completed fully by every tenderer otherwise the bid will be rejected.
5. Prices quoted should be firm for a period of one year. Tenderers are required to indicate this in their submission. Tenderers who do not indicate that, their submissions/tenders will not be considered.
6. All electrical equipment voltage should be 220-240 volts.
7. Back up service must be provided.
8. For every new photocopier supplied, toner and developer should be included as package.
9. Training package which will be offered to government technicians should be clearly defined including the provision of technical manuals.
