

# THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FORMER NORTHERN NIGERIA

As modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967



By His Excellency Major-General YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

Major-General Yakubu Gowon, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

WHEREAS by section 50 (2) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the High Court of the former Northern Nigeria shall consist of the Chief Justice and any such number of judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 4 (1) of the High Court Law of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Court shall consist, in addition to the Chief Justice, of a Senior Puisne Judge and seven other judges:

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (6) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967, it is provided that if the office of any judge of the High Court other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a judge of the High Court and a person so appointed shall continue to act for the period of his appointment:

Now THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, has appointed DAVID LINDSAY BATE, to act as Senior Puisne Judge from 1st February, 1968 to 11th May, 1968.
