# FINDING-LIST OF PLANTS AT BREEZE HILL GARDENS

THE list which follows was compiled particularly to give aid in the consideration of the flowers and plants grown at Breeze Hill for the purpose of supplementing the photographic collection of the J. Horace McFarland Company. As the collection is being constantly improved and changed it is accurate only as of September, 1926.

The Breeze Hill property, which includes 2.4 acres, is nearly a quarter segment of a circle, as shown on the finding diagram, page 2. There is a variation in contour of approximately 15 feet on the property, from which the ground falls away gently to the north and much more sharply to the south and east. The average height is 485 feet above sea-level.

The old mansion house in which Mr. McFarland lives was built in 1875 as the summer home of Jacob Haehnlen, a Philadelphia lithographer, who was devoted to grape-growing. Much of the original farm was in vineyard, and there yet exist in the little vineyard shown on the plan, eleven bearing Concord vines known to have been planted in 1858.

When Mr. McFarland came into possession of the property in the winter of 1908 (his living occupancy beginning June 1, 1909), the place was in great disorder. There were many dead pear trees and decrepit grapevines. The two hedges of American arborvitæ, which now give separation to the place, had evidently been rudely sheared off after they were probably 10 feet high. The dominating trees were a great American sycamore and seven horse-chestnuts; there were hemlocks, pines, Norway spruces, Norway maples. Of fruit trees, there remained two persimmon and two Buffum pear, and a dozen sour cherry trees. During the years of neglect, many black locusts and Norway maples had sprung up. The only shrubs were a few old lilacs and some "old-fashioned" roses.

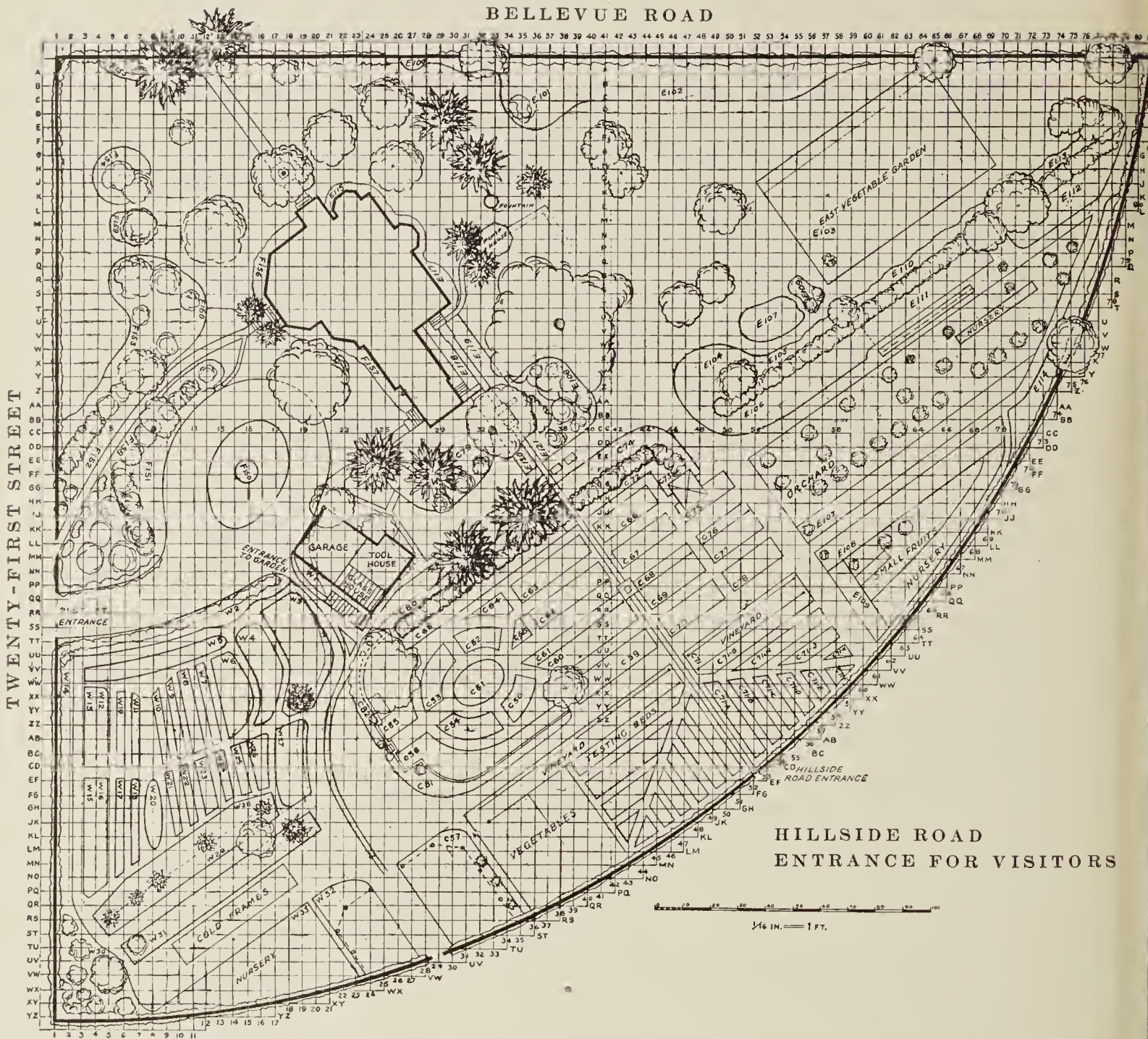
Mr. McFarland's aim, in addition to establishing a pleasant place in which to live, has been to so plant as to create pictures from and to the house, and of latter years to establish a representative collection of plants worth attention. He has been particularly favored by the Arnold Arboretum, by the authorities of Highland Park, Rochester, N. Y., and by many friends who have provided rare plants. In the last five years much attention has been paid to the rose collection, with special emphasis on the hardy climbers.

The finding-list that follows takes no account of annuals or biennials, of some perennials, or of bulb, fruit or vegetable trials.

Breeze Hill gardens are open to the public. It is preferred that approach should be made from the Hillside Road entrance.

Approach to Breeze Hill from the center of the city is by Market Street, east to 21st Street, thence on 21st Street south to Bellevue and Hillside Roads, between which the property lies. Reservoir Park cars run to 21st and Market Streets, and Breeze Hill is two blocks south to the right.

The upper or northern boundary of the tract is Bellevue Road, and the western boundary is on 21st Street. The curved southern boundary is that of Hillside Road. The plot is 400 x 340 x 585 feet in size. The diagram is laid off in five-foot squares for finding plants by the intersection of the lettered and the numbered lines, in accordance with the finding-list, but the larger number of references are to the various borders and beds noted above.

There are certain arbitrary garden divisions. The West Garden (including most of the roses) is the southwest corner. The Center Garden runs east from the Service entrance on Hillside Road to the Orchard, and north to the walk from the tool-house. The Cutting Gardens are south of the vineyard. The East Garden includes the Orchard and the grounds east of the residence to Bellevue Road. The Front Garden includes the front lawns and the trees and shrubbery in the northwest corner.

# FINDING-LIST OF PLANTS AT BREEZE HILL GARDENS

SEPTEMBER, 1926

The letters and numbers at the ends of the lines indicate the location of the plants, as shown by the cross lines of the map. Letters and numbers in parentheses indicate beds or borders in which plants may be located; the designating letter-number will be found on the concrete marker in one or two corners of each bed or border. The large maps for easy locating are posted in the tool-house. The plants are mostly labeled with embossed aluminum labels. On the shrubs these hang nearest the walk; on bush roses and most perennials they are on metal rods. There are also some zinc labels at ground level.

The nomenclature is generally that of Standardized Plant Names, a copy of which will be found in the Garage. It may be useful in seeking common names.
