● Nature

Along the shores of Lake Yunoko, the flowers of *Hydrangea paniculata* are conspicuous, and also many of *Rhododendron tschonoskii* are in full bloom.

There is a small marshland at the base of Usagi Island, where the flowers of Sundew are at their best.

The flowers are less than 1 cm in diameter, but this year they are numerous and conspicuous. The distinctive leaves that gave the moss its name can be seen near the roots.

● Information

An empty lunch box was left on a rock overlooking the shore of Lake Yunoko, and was also pushed into a crevice in a neighboring rock. As this is a habitat for wild animals, please be sure to take your garbage home with you.
