2. Toirmiscear leis seo duánacht le haon bhaoite seachas cuil bhréige a dhéanamh, sna codanna seo a leanas d'Abhainn na Sláine agus ina cuid craobh-aibhneacha a shníonn isteach sna codanna sin—

- (a) idir Droichead Bhaile Uí Chearnaigh agus Droichead Áth Fadhat—ón 1ú lá d'Aibreán, gach bliain, go dtí an lá sa bhliain sin díreach roimh an lá is tús don séasúr coiscthe bliantúil i leith duánacht bhradán nó don séasúr coiscthe bliantúil i leith duánacht bhreac (cibé acu is déanaí) is infheidhme ar na huiscíní ;
- (b) idir Droichead Inis Coirthe agus Droichead Bhaile Uí Chearnaigh, agus suas an sruth ó Dhroichead Áth Fadhat ón 1ú lá de Bhealtaine, gach bliain, go dtí an lá sa bhliain sin díreach roimh an lá is tús don séasúr coiscthe bliantúil i leith duánacht bhradán nó don séasúr coiscthe bliantúil i leith duánacht bhreac (cibé acu is déanaí) is infheidhme ar na huiscíní sin.

BYE-LAW NO. 517.  
No. 2 or WEXFORD DISTRICT.

I, BRIAN Ó LUINEACHÁIN, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Lands, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act, 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), and the Fisheries (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order, 1961 (S.I. No. 258 of 1961), hereby make the following Bye-law :

1. This Bye-law may be cited as the River Slaney (Angling) Bye-law No. 517, 1964.

2. Angling with any lure other than artificial fly is hereby prohibited in the following portions of the River Slaney and in its tributaries which flow into those portions—

- (a) between Ballycarney Bridge and Aghade Bridge—from the 1st day of April in each year to the day immediately preceding the commencement in that year of the annual close season for angling for salmon or the annual close season for angling for trout (whichever is the later) applicable to those waters ;
- (b) between Enniscorthy Bridge and Ballycarney Bridge, and upstream of Aghade Bridge—from the 1st day of May in each year to the day immediately preceding the commencement in that year of the annual close season for angling for salmon or the annual close season for angling for trout (whichever is the later) applicable to those waters.
