

# 2023 Minnesota State Fair 4-H Dairy Judges

#### **Bob Hagenow – Judge of Registered Holsteins**

Bob grew up on a dairy farm in Manitowoc County, WI and graduated with a BS in Dairy Science in 1985 from UW Madison participating in the Badger Dairy Club and in the judging program. He spent 2 years as an area representative and classifier for the National Brown Swiss Association after college. Since 1987, he has been employed by Vita Plus Corporation, a regional feed company based in Madison, Wisconsin. At VitaPlus, he works as a nutrition consultant on farms, supervises 12 salespeople, is a business unit manager and serves in various other capacities there. Bob has spent numerous years coaching county 4-H teams and has judged over 300 dairy shows in the last 35 years. He is the secretary/treasurer of World Dairy Expo and has served as the Brown Swiss and Holstein ring man at World Dairy Expo since 1987. He is very happy to have World Dairy Expo taking place again in 2021 after a year off due to the pandemic.

#### Kaleb Kruse - Judge of Grade Holsteins

Kaleb is part owner of KCCK genetics with his two younger brothers Cole and Carter Kruse at Dyersville, IA. They raise and show all seven dairy breeds at the local, state and National levels. Kaleb graduated from Kaskaskia College with an associate degree. While at Kaskaskia, he was a member of the 2nd place dairy judging team at Harrisburg, 2<sup>nd</sup> place team at World Dairy Expo and 1st place team at NAILE and received All-American individual honors. After transferring to the University of Minnesota, he was a member of the 2nd place team at Harrisburg, 3rd place team at World Dairy Expo and the 1st place team at the NAILE. Kaleb was the 2019 Merle Howard award winner at World Dairy Expo. Kaleb has judged several local, district and state shows. Kaleb was the associate judge at the 2020 National Ayrshire Show in Louisville KY and judged the 2021 National Ayrshire Junior Show in Louisville KY. Kaleb works for cowbuyer.com and Innovative Ag as an Agronomy Sales Advisor. He coaches the Delaware County 4 H team.

#### Eric Houdek – Judge of Total Merit

Eric grew up on his family's 400-cow Registered Holstein farm, Wake-Up Holsteins, in Caledonia, Minnesota. Growing up, he was actively involved in the MN 4-H dairy project and FFA. Eric graduated from the University of Minnesota with a degree in Animal Science and was a member of the national champion collegiate dairy judging team in 2015. He completed his master's degree at the University of Minnesota in dairy cattle genetics and has been employed in the sire department at ABS Global since. Eric lives in Hastings, Minnesota with his wife, Gabriella. He continues to help manage the genetics of his family's herd and assists in management of his in-law's dairy. Eric also volunteers as a dairy judging coach for the University of Minnesota and Dakota County 4-H dairy judging teams. Eric has judged county and district shows across three states in the Midwest and is excited to be judging at the Minnesota 4-H dairy show again.

#### Crystal Sinn - Judge of Red and White, Crossbreds, other colored breeds

Crystal Sinn grew up in Cleveland, Wisconsin on her family's Registered Holstein farm where she exhibited purebred Holsteins at local, state, and national levels. She has bred one EX-95 cow, Siemers Alisha Gold Ava-ETS, who was recognized in 2012 as the Star of the Breed, courtesy of Holstein Association USA. Alongside her mother and grandmother, Crystal enjoys acquiring, breeding, and showing elite Jerseys and Holsteins under the name "Cupid Cattle Company." Crystal graduated from the University of Minnesota where, she was part of the winning team at the National Intercollegiate Dairy Judging Contest at World Dairy Expo. Crystal served Wisconsin's agriculture industry as the 70th Alice in Dairyland. Currently, Crystal works for Sartori Cheese as a National Sales Account Manager, selling bulk cheese to food service and ingredient customers, and closely collaborates with chefs and research and development teams across the United States. Crystal and her husband, Ean, own and operate the "Sinn Family Celebration of Life Center," a funeral home and event center in Trimont, MN. One of her biggest passions in life is working with youth on their dairy judging and showmanship skills.

#### Ryan Weigel - Judge of Colored Breeds: Jerseys, Brown Swiss, and other colored breeds

Ryan Weigel is an Animal and Dairy Science Instructor at Southwest Wisconsin Technical College in Fennimore, WI. Before his employment at SWTC, Weigel worked many years for Accelerated Genetics and East Central Select Sires. Ryan is also a managing partner is his family's farm: Weigland Registered Holsteins. Weigel was awarded Wisconsin's Distinguished Young Holstein Breeder in 2014. Weigel has bred and/or owned over 25 All-American nominated cattle in 4 different breeds. KHW Regiment Apple-Red and Budjon-Abbott Alexandra are two of the more popular females that Weigel has worked with, both of whom hoisted champion banners at World Dairy Expo. Mr. Weigel coaches the Southwest Tech Dairy Judging Team. Additionally, he has judged multiple county, district and state dairy cattle shows and served as an official for many different judging contests and clinics throughout the United States. He has also judged internationally in Australia, Japan and Hungary. Ryan resides in Platteville, Wisconsin with his wife Traci and their children: Kaelyn, Kenadee and Keegan.

# **Total Merit Championships**

The purpose of the total merit championship drive is to provide additional recognition to 4-H exhibitors whose animals have both excellent functional type and high genetic values for the production and health traits. Within the blue ribbon group, the two animals with the highest genetic value for Net Merit \$\\$ will be asked back to compete for Champion Total Merit Heifer or Champion Total Merit Cow.

In the Total Merit Championship Ring, the judge will evaluate the animals based on a combination of the animal's functional type and genetic value (GV) for NM\$. All genetic values for NM\$ have been verified by University of Minnesota personnel using the August 2016 USDA genetic evaluations. The GV for cows or heifers is equal to their published PTA x 2. For animals without a PTA, the GV = Sire PTA + Dam PTA. If Dam PTA is unavailable, the  $GV = Sire PTA + \frac{1}{2} MGS PTA$ . Genomic values are used if available.

The weightings of genetic traits in the Net Merit \$ Index as of August 2021 are:

The PTA is the average genetic superiority or inferiority that an animal is expected to pass on to their offspring. We use the genetic value which is the PTA multiplied by two because this is the measure of the full genetic differences between animals. Another name for "Genetic Value" is "Breeding Value".

# **Showmanship Procedures**


