A simple change for a major improvement.

HOW IT WORKS

Approval voting lets you say yes or no to every candidate, rather than letting you say yes to only one candidate. 'Yes' votes are added as normal and the candidate with the most wins!

This simple change:

- Allows voters to vote their conscience
- Elects more representative candidates
- Cools down the political atmosphere

WHY WE NEED IT

When you ask these people why they don't vote you'll hear one of two things: "My vote doesn't matter" or "My voice won't be heard". Both of these statements point to deep dysfunction in our political system which causes the majority of people to feel disenfranchised.

Approval voting returns your voice by increasing your ability to express your thoughts on all candidates and ensures the candidate who is truly the most representative is elected.

"I like them, but I don't think they can win."

Sound familiar?

With approval voting, you can always vote for your favorite without fearing helping your least favorite win or wasting your vote.

Approval voting offers a simple, clear reflection of community support, which helps us elect leaders who know how to represent us better.
