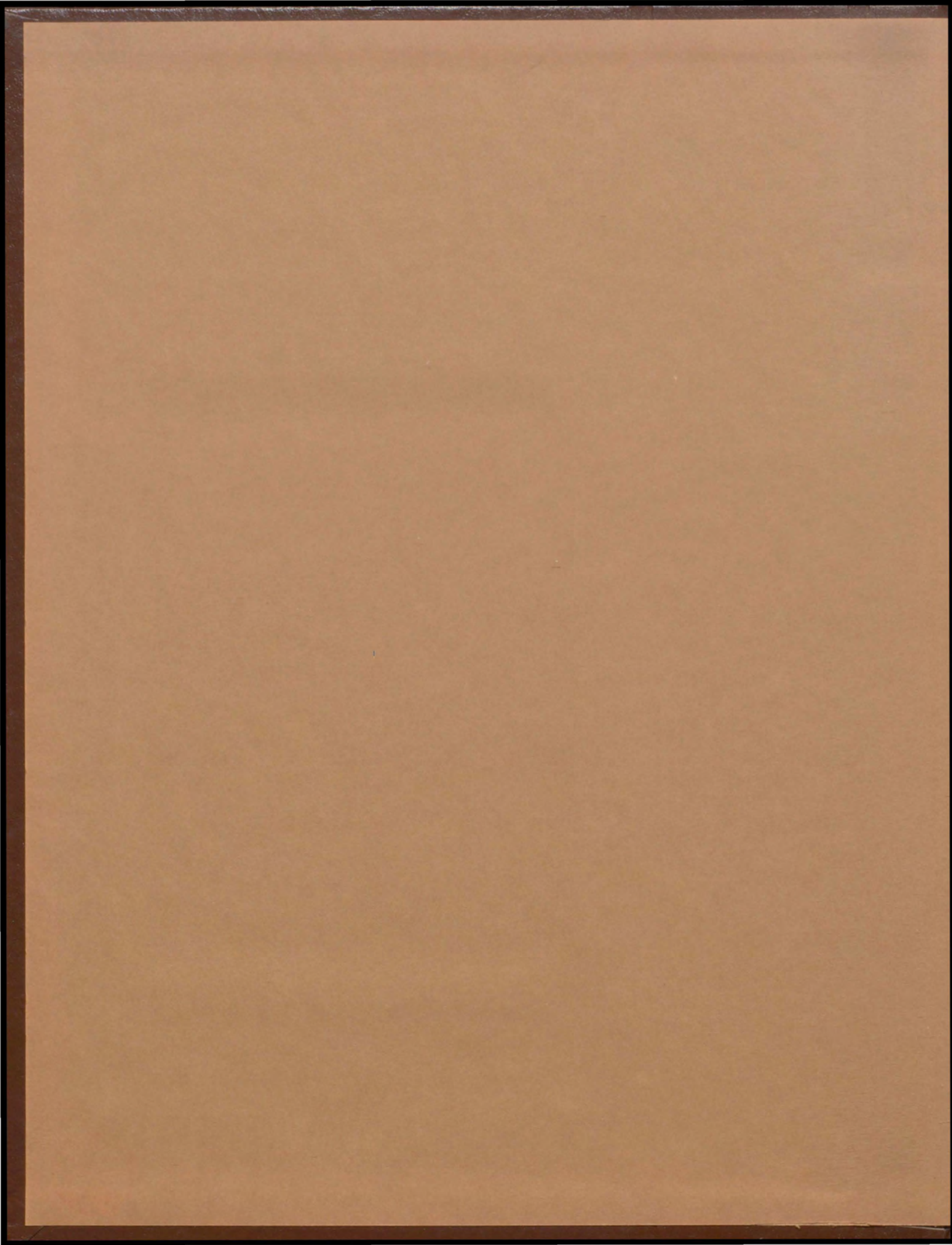

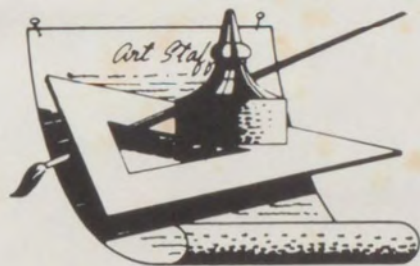

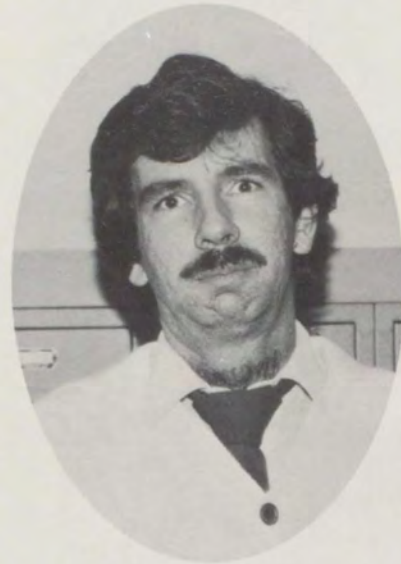

The Class of 1984 proudly dedicates this year's Corrian to Mr. Wojcicehowski.



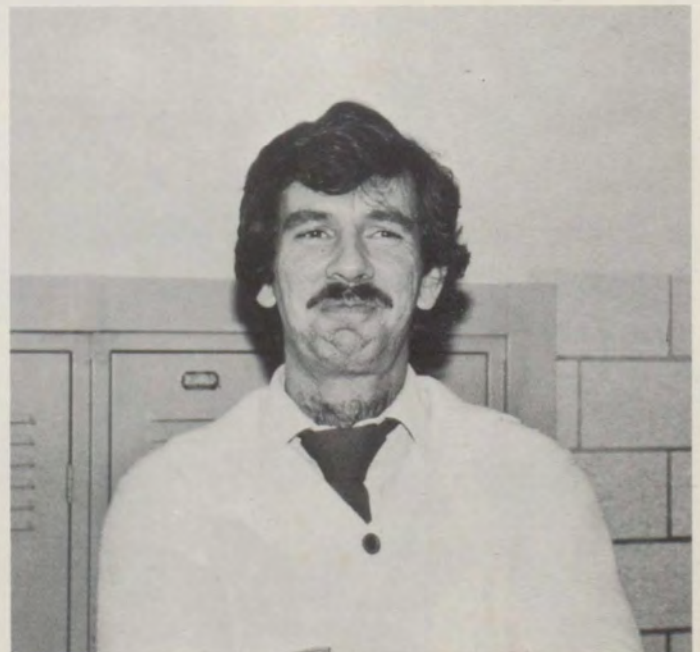

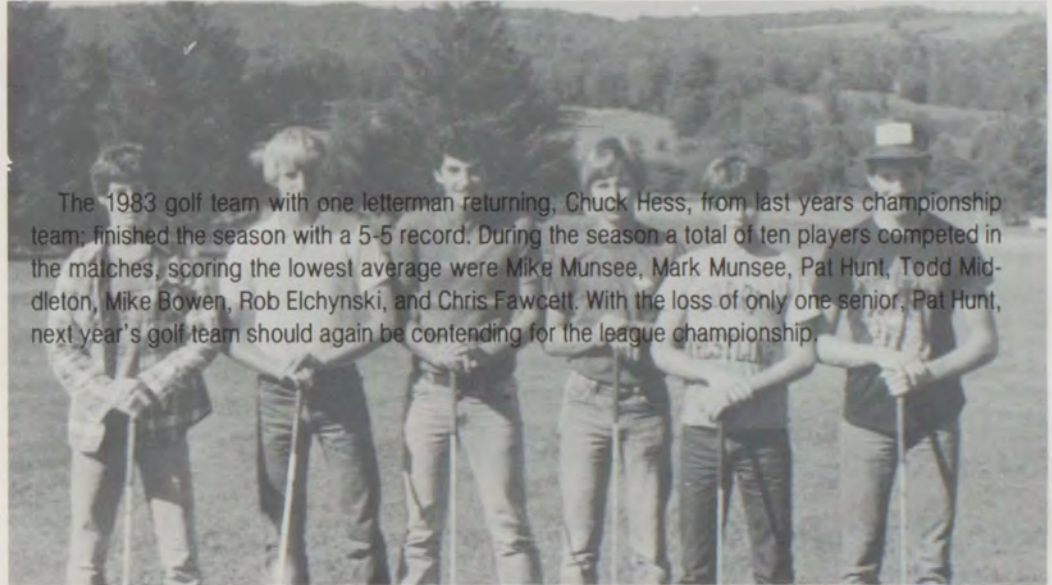

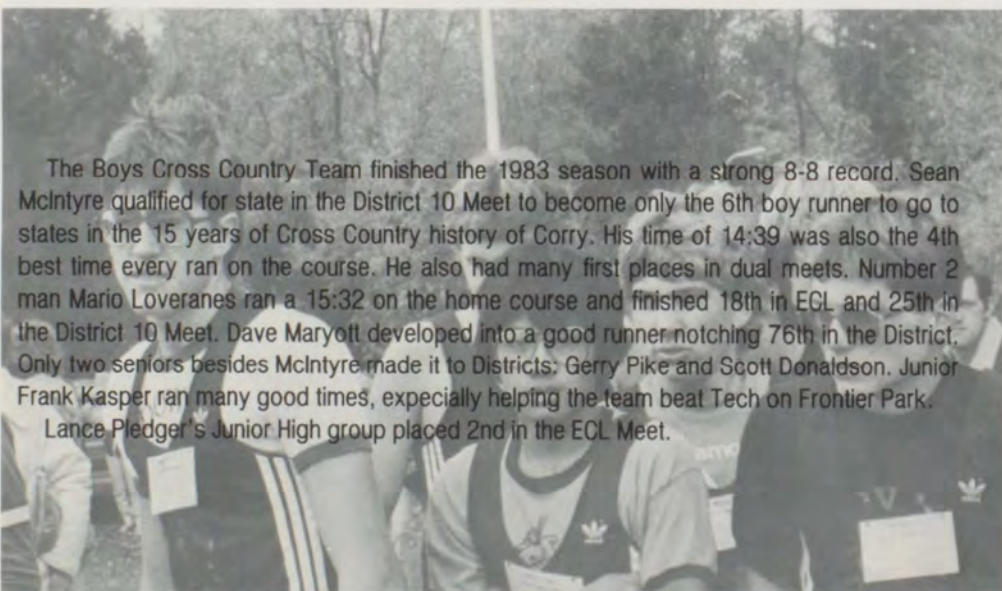

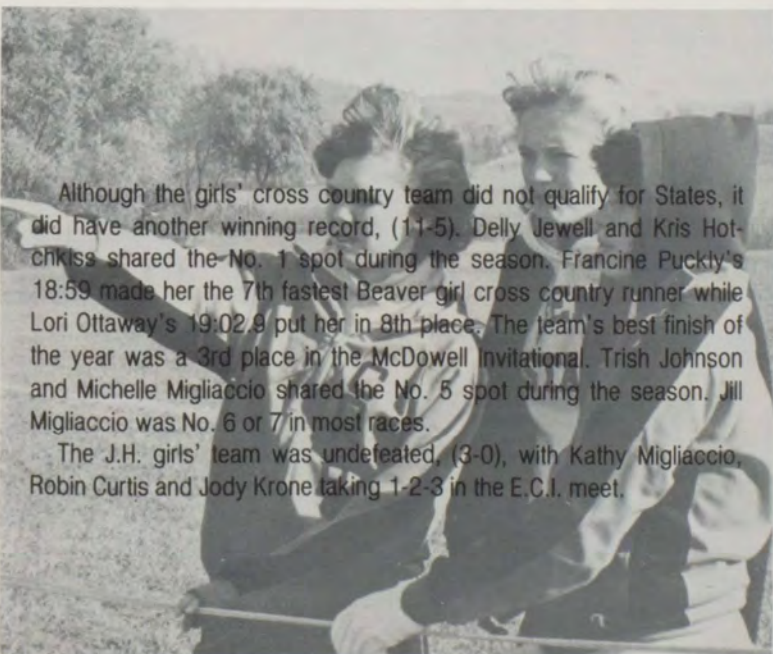

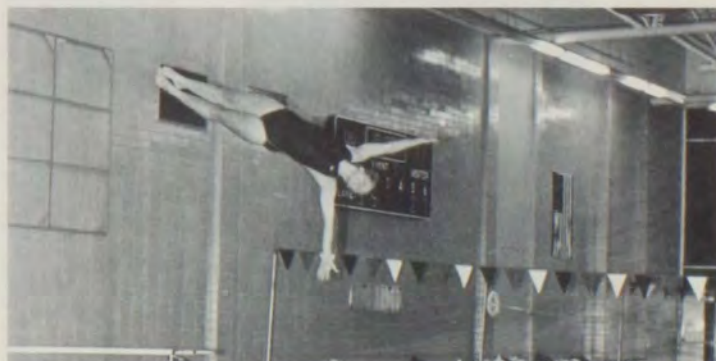

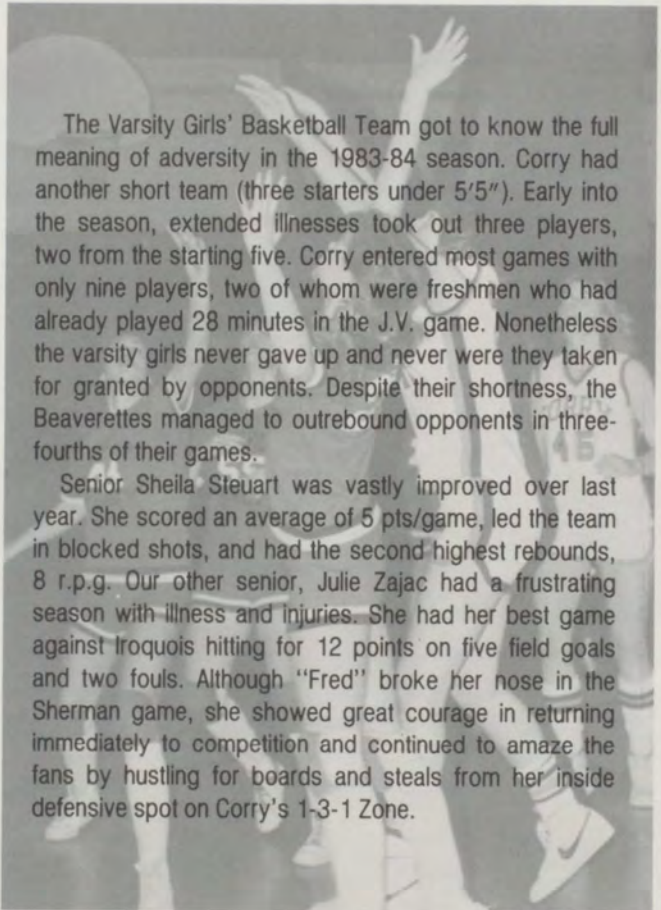

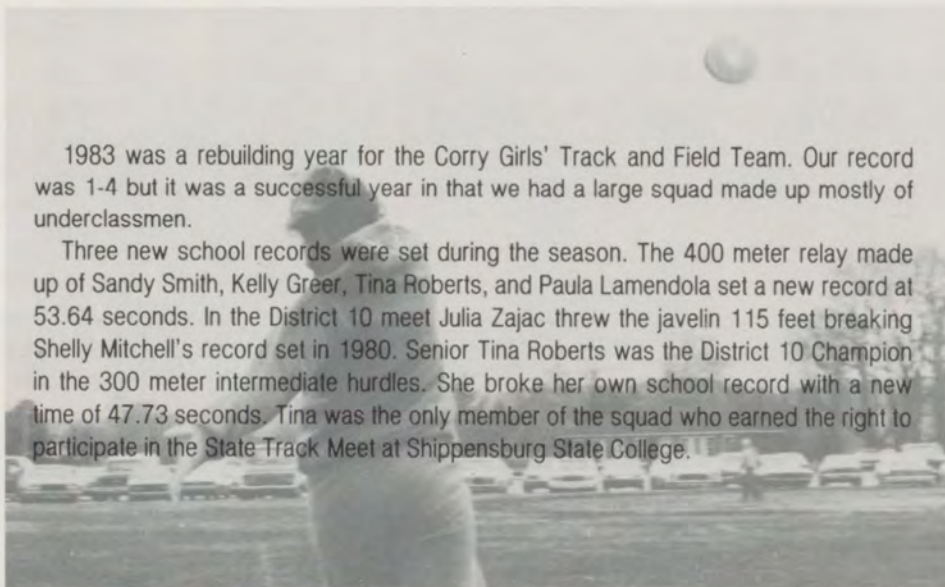

All of the athletes gave their best efforts. They can be proud of their accomplishments. Chip Nuzzo and Rob Coleman tied for the MVP honors.

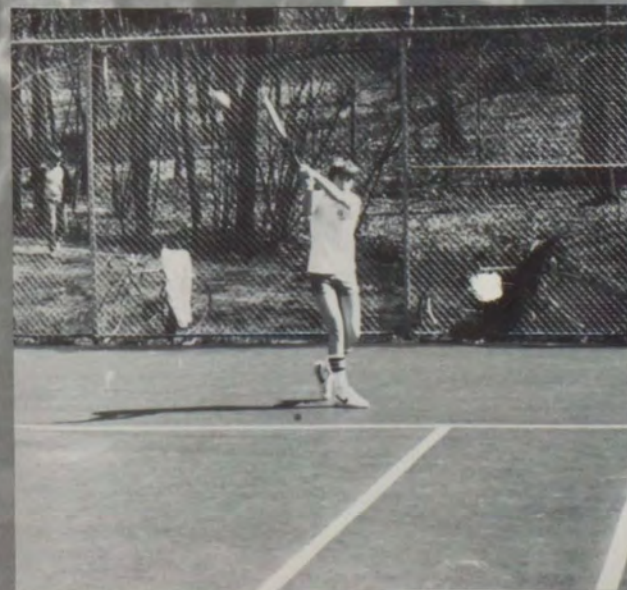
