



Botanical Name: *Justicia*
scheidweileri syn *Porphyrocoma*
lanceolata

Common Name: Purple Shrimp
Plant, Rose Pine Cone, Brazilian
Fireworks, Jade Magic

Origin: Brazil

Height/Width: 0.2m x 0.5

Habit: Small evergreen perennial;
performs well in pots.

Flower: Chubby spikes of burgundy
bracts enclosing small mauve
flowers. Flowers year round in
warmer districts and from spring to
autumn in temperate areas.



Leaves: Dark green, velvety broad
lanceolate leaves with silvery veins.

Climate:

Soil: Humus rich well drained soil.

Aspect. Dappled light under trees
although it is best in full shade

Prune: Very low maintenance and
pruning is not generally required but
old bract may be removed.

Drought/Frost: Low/Tender

Propagation: Cuttings or seeds.
