**Phylloscopus ruficapilla** [*Pogonocichla ruficapilla*, Sundevall 1850, Durban, South Africa].  
 [P.r. ruficapilla] E Northern Province S to KwaZulu-Natal (E South Africa), W Swaziland & E Lesotho.  
 [P.r. ochrogularis] Mahari Mts. (W Tanzania).  
 [P.r. minullus] Taita Hills (SE Kenya) and E & NE Tanzania.  
 [P.r. johnstonei] S Tanzania & Malawi S to NE Zambia & NW Mozambique.  
 [P.r. quelimanensis] Mt. Namule (N Mozambique).  
 [P.r. alacris] Manica e Sofala (Mozambique).  
 [P.r. voelckeri] S Western Cape E to E Eastern Cape (South Africa).

### **Laura's Woodland Warbler**

**Phylloscopus laurae** [*Seicercus laurae*, Boulton 1931, Mount Moco at 6,600', Benguela, Angola].  
 [P.l. laurae] Mt. Moco (W Angola).  
 [P.l. eustacei] SE DR Congo (formally known as Zaire), N & NW Zambia & extreme SW Tanzania.  
 Other name: Mrs Boulton's Woodland Warbler.  
 Treated by some as *Seicercus laurae*.  
 Laura Boulton (1889-1980), wife of Wolfrid Rudyerd Boulton, American ornithologist who wrote the first description and named it for his wife.

### **Red-faced Woodland Warbler**

**Phylloscopus laetus** [*Cryptolopha laeta*, Sharpe 1902, Ruwenzori Mountains, W Uganda].  
 [P.l. laetus] NE & E DR Congo (formally known as Zaire), SW Uganda, W Rwanda & W Burundi.  
 [P.l. schoutedeni] Mt. Kabobo (DR Congo).  
 Other names: Rusty-faced Warbler, Red-faced Leaf-warbler.  
 Treated by some as *Seicercus laetus*.

### **Black-capped Woodland Warbler**

**Phylloscopus herberti** [*Cryptolopha herberti*, Alexander 1903, Bakaki, Bioko Island].  
 [P.h. herberti] Bioko Island (aka Fernando Pó) & Mt. Alen (Equatorial Guinea).  
 [P.h. camerunensis] SE Nigeria & W Cameroon Mts.  
 Other name: Herbert's Woodland Warbler.  
 Treated by some as *Seicercus herberti*.  
 E. G. Herbert (1870-1951), English collector and naturalist.

### **Uganda Woodland Warbler**

 Scattered pops. in S Cameroon, N Equatorial Guinea, NE Gabon & NW PR Congo (Congo-Brazzaville) and E DR Congo (formally known as Zaire) E to Uganda & W Kenya.  
 Other names: Blackango Woodland-warbler, Budongo Woodland-warbler, Uganda Wood Warbler.  
 Treated by some as *Seicercus budongoensis*.

[*P.x. jerdoni*] Himalayas, from E Nepal, Darjeeling, Sikkim & Bhutan to Arunachal Pradesh (India).

[*P.x. flavogularis*] Abor & Mishmi Hills (Arunachal Pradesh) and N Myanmar.

[*P.x. tephrodiras*] Assam, Nagaland & Manipur (India) and Chin Hills (Myanmar).

Treated by some as *Seicercus xanthoschistos*.
