WIAA Provides Opportunities; Structure . . .

The Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) is a voluntary, unincorporated, and nonprofit organization. The Association membership has a diversified membership of public high schools, nonpublic high schools, public middle schools, and nonpublic middle schools. Its purpose is to organize, develop, direct and provide interscholastic athletics for member schools.

There are 515 senior high schools affiliated with the WIAA. The estimated number of student-athletes in athletics is 80,000-85,000 annually.

Governance of the WIAA is performed by the member schools. Rules and policies of the Association are developed, promulgated and implemented by the membership either through membership vote for constitutional issues or through a membership-elected committee structure for sport seasons regulations. Therefore, ownership of the membership's rules and regulations, as well as the responsibility of compliance with them, lies with each member school.

The Development of Rules . . .

As fans watch the games during the tournament, some wonder how the rules of the game and of the WIAA were created.

- ◆ The National Federation of State High School Associations is the authority of the competition rules for sport contests (i.e. uniforms, length of contest, game rules). As a member of the NFHS, the WIAA adheres to those rules as a member in good standing. The WIAA, as well as all state associations in the NFHS, has input with an advisory role in the review and promulgation of the playing rules. The NFHS office is located in Indianapolis, Indiana.
- ◆ For changes to the membership's Constitution, Bylaws and Rules of Eligibility, a vote of the entire membership is required at the Annual Meeting each spring. The Constitution contains information relating to the Association as an organization. The Bylaws encompass information relating to member high schools' responsibility concerning WIAA rules and regulations. The Rules of Eligibility embody information relating to the relationship of the student-athlete to the high school and the WIAA.
- ◆ The Board of Control has the ultimate authority in determining the outcome of sport seasons rule recommendations and regulations. Changes to the sport seasons regulations are advanced through the democratic committee structure. Among the advisory groups that provide input to the Board are the coaches advisory committees for each sport; the sports advisory committee, comprised of school athletic directors from each of the seven districts; the Advisory Council, consisting of school administrators from each elector district; and the executive staff. Other groups with advisory responsibilities include the Medical Advisory Committee, Sportsmanship Committee and the Officials Advisory Committee. The Season Regulations address, among other topics, definition of the sports seasons, participation, contest control and tournament procedures.



Currently, the Association sponsors 24 sports including baseball, basketball, cross country, 8-player, 11-player football, golf, hockey, soccer, swimming & diving, tennis, track & field, volleyball and wrestling for boys; and basketball, cross country, golf, gymnastics, hockey, soccer, softball, swimming & diving, tennis, track & field and volleyball for girls.

SCORING OPTIONAL ROUTINES

Difficulty 3.0

Eight skills of difficulty, including at least one high superior or advanced high superior are required in a routine in order to receive full difficulty. Missing skills of difficulty may be replaced with skills of higher value only.

Difficulty values are based on the difficulty of the skill with the more complex skill receiving a high superior/advanced high superior or superior value and the less complex skill receiving a medium value.

A routine must include:

- 1 high superior or
- advanced high superior skill at 0.3 each = 0.3
- 3 superior skills at 0.5 each = 1.5
- 4 medium skills at 0.3 each = 1.2
- full difficulty = 3.0

Event Requirements 1.0

This category includes a list of skills which are characteristic of each event and must be included in a gymnast's routine. A deduction of 0.2 is taken for each requirement that is missing from the routine, up to a maximum of 1.0.

Composition 1.0

Composition is the construction of an exercise. It includes how elements are distributed through various connections. There should be variety and balance in the types of skills included in a routine. All space, levels, and directions should be used. Originality and creativity in combining elements is encouraged and the quality of the gymnast's movement should reflect her personal style on beam and floor. The difficulty level of the routine should be maintained throughout with difficult elements being distributed throughout.

Bonus 0.8

This category is used to reward the gymnast whose performance reflects more than the minimum

requirements. Bonus (up to a maximum of 0.8) may be earned by including advanced high superiors or by connecting series of superiors, high superiors, or advanced high superiors. Different advanced high superiors that are successfully completed without a fall or a spot may earn 0.2 each up to a maximum of 0.6. Connected series may earn either 0.1 or 0.2 depending on the level of elements that are included in the series. At least one series must include high superiors and/or advanced high superiors.

Execution and Amplitude 4.2

This category is based upon the gymnast using the correct technique for each skill. When the gymnast fails to use the correct technique, errors in execution result. In conjunction with execution errors, the gymnast often displays errors in amplitude which is a lack of using the greatest range of movement allowed for a skill or combination of skills. Amplitude and execution errors are deducted according to the following guidelines: 0.05 - 0.1 small errors; 0.2 - 0.3 medium errors; and 0.4 - 0.5 serious errors. Insufficient Dynamics would result in a 1.-2 deduction.

Vaulting

Each girl performs 2 vaults. The 2 vaults may be the same or different with the better of the 2 vaults counted for scoring.

The vault consists of the following principle parts: 1st flight, repulsion phase, 2nd flight and landing. The 1st flight is the position of the suspended body up to the moment the hands contact the table. Considered in judging the 1st flight are incomplete twists and body position errors. The repulsion phase is the contact and repulsion from the table. The 2nd flight is the position of the body from the time the gymnast leaves the table up to the landing. Considered in judging the 2nd flight are body position errors, height, distance from the

table, incomplete twists, extension and dynamics. Upon landing, deductions are taken for balance errors and arm swings, steps, deep squats, and falls.

Each vault is assigned a value based on the difficulty of the vault with a 10.0 vault as the most difficult, down to a 7.0 vault as the least difficult.

Uneven Bars

The gymnast's routine should include several kips, swings, high casts, and circles. Routines of higher level should also include full and half twists, handstand positions, and releases. The routine should include quick, light grip changes from one bar to the other. The gymnast must work around both bars and in all directions without stops or pauses.

Balance Beam

The balance beam routine should move smoothly with many changes of level, direction, and rhythm. The gymnast must have at least one dance, one acro, and one combination dance/acro series in the routine. Skills showing balance, dance, flexibility, confidence, and sureness should be choreographed into the routine. The maximum time for the routine is 1 minute 30 seconds.

Floor Exercise

A well-composed floor exercise routine flows with creative expression, showing changes of level, direction, and dynamics. The selection of the music should personalize the gymnast and have rhythm changes. The gymnast should use the entire floor area and should pass through all quadrants of the floor area while creating an interesting pattern of movement. The floor exercise routine should show a balance of dance and acro. Each routine must have 3 acro passes moving in at least 2 of 3 directions: forward, backward, and sideward. The maximum time for the routine is 1 minute 30 seconds.



2021 State Preview

DIVISION 1 NOTEBOOK: There are three returning champions seeking to add to her gold medal count. Senior Miranda Knabe of Menomonee Falls/Germantown was last season's champion in the all-around. She returns to defend her title. Junior Araceli De Leo Lopez of Franklin/Muskego/Oak Creek/Whitnall returns in pursuit of back-to-back titles on the balance beam after setting the State Championships Division 1 record in the event last season. Junior Annie Murphy of the Wilmot Union/Union Grove/Williams Bay co-op attempts to repeat as the champion in the floor exercise. Knabe may challenge Murphy for the floor exercise title. She qualifies this season after her all-around performance at State last season would have tied for sixth if she had qualified in the event. Senior Maggie Losch of Kenosha Tremper/Bradford/Indian Trail/Westosha Central is also a contender in the floor exercise, having placed fifth in 2020 to go with a third-place finish in 2018. Others among last season's top performers on the beam returning to contend for the title are junior Drew Gersmeyer of Menomonee Falls/Germantown, who was runner-up last year, and Knabe, who was third. Senior Grace Corcoran of Kenosha Tremper/Bradford/Indian Trail/Westosha Central may also be among the top placers after finishing tied for sixth in 2020. Knabe is also expected to challenge for the championship on the uneven parallel bars after a runner-up finish on the apparatus last season. Among the other contenders on the bars are sophomore Clara Kenney of Hartford, who placed seventh last year, and junior Brielle Lauber of Franklin/Muskego/Oak Creek/Whitnall, who returns to the event after placing ninth last season. Junior Annie Murphy and senior Jadyn Pye of Wilmot Union/Union Grove/Williams Bay, who placed 10th and 11th on the bars, respectively, also have valuable experience at the State meet. Knabe is the top returning gymnast in the vault after last season's runner-up finish, and Losch is among the leading contenders as well with her fourth-place finish last season. Also expected to be in pursuit of the vaulting title are junior Olivia Rebout of Janesville Craig, who placed fifth last year, and Annie Murphy of Wilmot Union/Union Grove/Williams Bay, who placed in a tie for sixth a year ago. Other contenders for individual titles and the all-around championship this week based on sectional performances include sophomore Maggie Pokomy of Homestead, who won the all-around and uneven bars at her sectional; senior Caroline Erikson of Hudson, who won the all-around and floor exercise at the sectional meet; and sophomore Isabella Bins, who won the sectional all-around completion that included Knabe, who was last year's State all-around champion. Junior Anna Lauber of Franklin/Muskego/Oak Creek/Whitnall was a multiple-event champion at sectionals, winning the vault and floor exercise.

DIVISION 2 NOTEBOOK: Two former champions are returning to competition this season. Senior Addie Gallun of Whitefish Bay is a previous champion in three individual events and the all-around. She is a three-time champion in the uneven bars in pursuit of becoming just the second gymnast in State history to win four championships on the uneven bars. Gallun is attempting to win her third all-around title, which has been accomplished by only two other gymnasts. She is also the defending champion in the vault, and finished sixth last season in the floor exercise after winning gold in the event in 2019. Gallun could also contend for the balance beam crown after finishing runner-up the past two seasons. Junior Loris Shatravka of River Valley/Barneveld looks to return to championship form in the balance beam. She qualifies this year after winning the title in record-setting fashion in 2019 and slipping to 18th in the event last year. However, the event should be hotly contested with three of the top six finishers from last year returning for another shot at the title, including Gallun, and her junior teammate from Whitefish Bay, Anneh Britz, who placed third last year and fourth in 2019. Senior Autumn Tiede of River Falls is back after placing sixth in 2020. Tiede will contend with Gallun and a host of other experienced gymnasts for the crown in the floor exercise. She placed third last season in the event and 11th in 2019. Junior Lily Wiegand of Sparta placed fifth in the event last season and fourth in 2019. In addition, the event adds sophomore Cassi Hansen of Nicolet, who moves to Division 2 after finishing fourth in the floor exercise in Division 1 last year. Other top-10 finishers in the floor exercise back this year are Britz, who tied for eighth last year, and junior Savannah Clark of Sparta, who was 10th. The vault also has competitors with quality State experience returning to challenge Gallun. Among them is a trio of Sparta gymnasts, including Wiegand, who was runner-up last season and fourth in 2019; sophomore Ella Hemker, who was fifth; junior Savannah Clark, who was seventh; and Tiede, who fell to ninth last year after a fifth-place finish in 2019. Other top-10 placers from last season returning to the floor exercise include Tiede, who was third last year after placing 11th in 2019; senior Grace O'Neil of Mount Horeb, who was fourth; and senior Kynnedi Malone of Nicolet, who was ninth in Division 1 in 2020. Among those with State experience that will attempt to prevent Gallun from capturing her fourth title on the uneven bars are Shatravka, who tied for fourth in the event last season and was seventh in 2019; Tiede, who tied for eighth last year after a 12th-place finish in 2019; junior Kate Graham of Whitefish Bay, who was seventh last season; and O'Neil, who placed 10th in 2020. Other than the individuals already identified in the event review, Junior Catie McPherson will compete for the all-around title after winning the title at her sectional along with the floor exercise.
