



# **Program Evaluation Committee: Definition, Roles, Responsibilities Developmental and Behavioral Pediatrics Fellowship V1. February, 2021**

### Program Evaluation Committee ACGME Roles and Responsibilities:

- The PEC should participate actively in:
  - o planning, developing, implementing, and evaluating educational activities of the program
  - o reviewing and making recommendations for revision of competency-based curriculum goals and objectives
  - addressing areas of non-compliance with ACGME requirements
  - o annually reviewing the program using evaluations of faculty members, fellows, and others
- Some PECs review fellows' Milestones assessments to determine weak points in curricular elements of the program in order to make necessary changes.
- End product: Annual Program Evaluation

## **Program Evaluation Committee Membership**

- o Minimum of
  - 2 Fellows
  - 2 Faculty (one of whom needs to be a Core Faculty Member)
  - DBP Program Director(s)
    - o Appointment to Committee reviewed on an annual basis at the end of every academic year (June)

#### **Roles Program Evaluation Committee in DBP**

- Review ACGME Annual Survey results
- o Complete Annual Program Evaluation (June) utilize information gathered from semi-annual program evaluation
- o Complete Internal Review of Fellowship Program Semiannually (Use Semi-Annual Program Evaluation Template)
  - o Formal Meetings to review evaluation content semi-annually in November, May
  - o Semi-Annual Program Evaluation will be used for program improvement in the intervening six months
  - o Content to be used for completing Semi-Annual Evaluation
    - Electronic Evaluations distributed <u>April, October</u> to Fellows and Faculty (core and not core)
    - Feedback from Semi-annual meeting to discuss fellowship (to occur in April, October)
    - Electronic Evaluation Content: See Appendix 1
- o Plan, develop, and evaluate educational activities of the program (ad hoc meetings of members of committee may occur in ongoing quality improvement)
  - o Development of Fellowship AIMS See Appendix 2 goal to be complete by July 1, 2021
  - Clinical Educational Activities
    - Development of learning objectives for each clinical rotation Goal to be complete by December 2021



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## Roles Program Evaluation Committee in DBP (continued)

- Link each clinical rotation to <u>DBP Content Specifications</u> (Erika & Anisha did this for 1<sup>st</sup>-year of fellowship) goal to be complete by December, 2021
- Development of Expectations for Fellows for each clinical rotation Goal to be complete by July, 2022
- Share learning objectives with faculty and fellows in before each clinical rotation
- o Didactic/Formal Educational Activities
  - Development of learning objectives for each educational activity
  - Link to DBP Content Specifications
  - Educational activities could include the following:
- o NDV teaching rounds (in process) goal to be scheduled by December, 2021
  - Core DBP content lead by faculty
  - Adverse Event Analysis Case included at least annually within NDV teaching rounds
  - Include Workshops on race/bias in curriculum Consider:
    - Racism: MedEdPORTAL " 'I Didn't Know What to Say': Responding to Racism, Discrimination, & Microaggressions",
    - Sensitivity/Bias: SCH "CONNECT Program" Julia Mitzel & Zinner met w/Jane Gregg & Manuel Arambul 28 Jan. Likely workshop and/or small group (they'll provide select recommendations early Feb.)
    - Peace Circles: UW SOM Climate
    - Consider <u>Intro to Disability Justice</u> as group viewing or social event w/discussion (Sound Theatre Co. w/ChrisTiana ObeySumner, suggested by Erika following Sins Invalid viewing)
    - Wellness training: Module options (Sam's website): Maybe Rounds w/extended time:
      - > LIFE Curriculum
      - > AMA trainee burnout
      - ➤ Mayo's Fellow Well-Being Index
- o Fellow DBP Board Review (not yet developed) Discuss implementation July 1, 2021
- o Development of Annual Bootcamp
- o Annual fellowship orientation (in process) goal to be developed by July 1, 2021
- o Review wellness resources:
  - Wellness Corner: UW GME (all fellows & faculty should sign up for newsletter
  - Wellness Counseling: Ensure fellows are aware (UW GME)
