


## Marchandiomyces corallinus







Identification: Pink bulbils on bleached areas of lichen thalli. Bulbils can be spherical or merged into distorted shapes. Bottom right picture shows cells within a bulbil. Spores rarely found.

Similar species: Erythricium aurantiacum has pale orange bulbils. Illosporiopsis christensenii forms bright, shocking pink blobs composed of coiled spores. These appear to dissolve in water. Paranectria oropensis forms pale orange, fluffy, spherical perithecia on the surface of damaged lichens.

**Habitat:** Parasitic on a number of different lichen species, particularly species of *Parmelia*.

Distribution: Throughout the UK.
