GORE BAY SCENIC RESERVE

The following list of bryophytes is a list of the plants collected during a field trip with the Canterbury Botanical Society to Gore Bay Scenic Reserve 13th October, 1979. It is by no means a complete list of the bryophytes present in the reserve. The most interesting find was that of Desmatodon lingulatus which was previously known from the North Island and the Dunedin region in the South Island. It was quite abundant on damp clay exposed by a recent landslide. The find of Fissidens oblongifolius represents the first record from the South Island.

In the list the genera are arranged in systematic order, whereas the species are in alphabetical order. The specimens are kept in the herbarium at Botany Division, D.S.I.R.
