"The University of California's system wide finances are incredibly entangled with weapons manufacturers: complex are extensive. According to today's General Dynamics with a University of California investment of \$21,471,120, Northrop Grumman for \$16,125,200, Raytheon for \$16,818,200, TRW for \$8.327,650, and Lockheed Martin for a staggering \$33,046,370." The University of California is now in the position of managing, developing, proliferating, investing in, and profiting from Weapons of Mass Destruction. The fact that the University of California investments of \$33,046,370 in Lockheed Martin Marietta (70% owned by Carlyle which is 5.2% owned by the State of California employee pension fund), and \$21,471,120 in General Dynamics - one of the two biggest US manufacturers of DU weaponry which has been sold to 29 countries, make the University of California complicit in war crimes.

## Stay behind terrorism

The CIA and the British secret service MI6, in collaboration with the military alliance NATO and European military secret services set up a network of clandestine anticommunist armies in Western Europe after World War II. The secret soldiers were trained on remote islands in the Mediterranean and in unorthodox warfare centers in England and in the United States by the Green Berets and SAS Special Forces. Codenamed "Gladio" ('the sword'), the Italian secret army was exposed in 1990 by Italian Prime Minister Giulio Andreotti to the Italian Senate, whereupon the press spoke of "The best kept, and most damaging, political-military secret since World War II" (Observer, 18. November 1990)

Stay-behind' armies of NATO have also been discovered in France, Spain, Portugal, Germany, Belgium, the Netherlands, Luxemburg, Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Finland, Switzerland, Austria, Greece and Turkev.

They were internationally coordinated by the Pentagon and NATO and had their last known meeting in the NATO-linked Allied Clandestine Committee (ACC) in Brussels in October 1990.

## Operation Noble Eagle

On August 22, 2002, the Department of Defense and the National Guard Bureau in Washington, D.C. announced that the lowa Army National Guard's 1st Battalion, 194th Field Artillery, was being ordered to federal active duty to locations within the United States for homeland security missions as part of Operation Noble Eagle

This constitutes an illegal operation on the part of the Bush junta in scrapping the Posse Comitatus Act of 1878. In a nutshell, this act bans the use of the military against American civilians.
