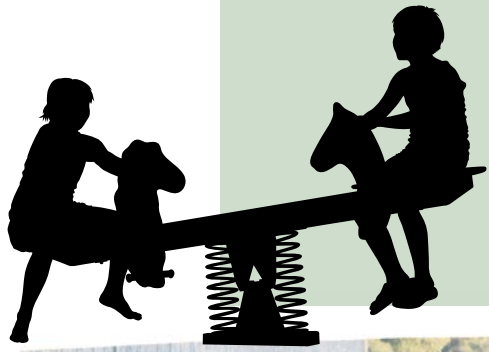

Balance sheet for year-end 2022

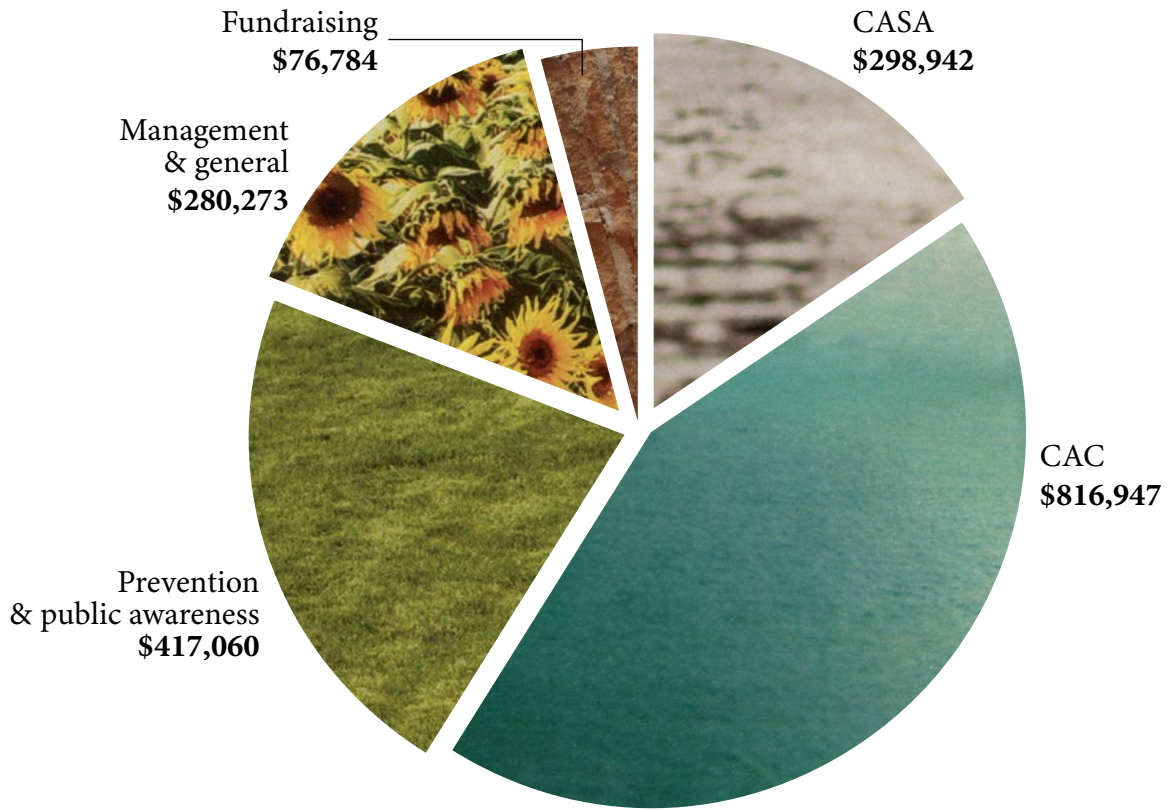
Total assets \$3,337,794

Total liabilities \$244,428

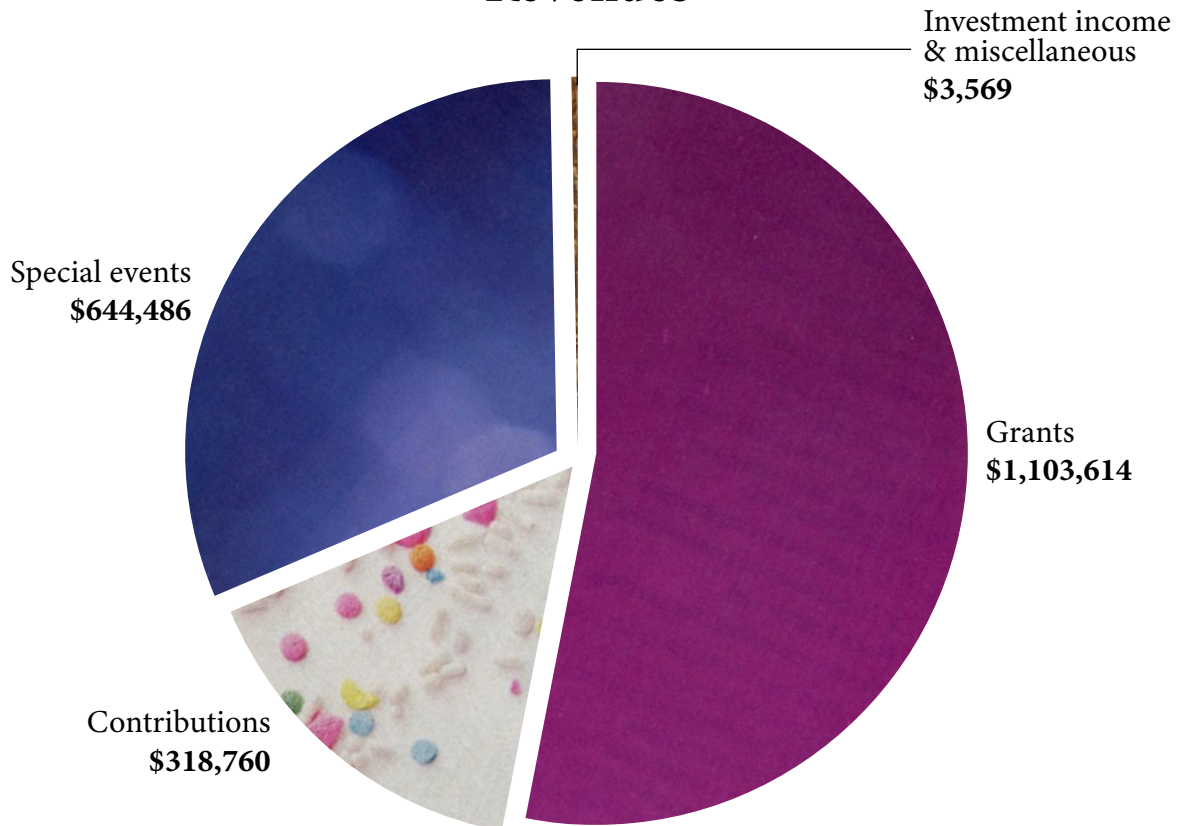
Net assets \$3,093,366

In 2022:

6,668 people attended **242 presentations, classes and events** in our four counties, totaling **861.5 hours** of prevention education programming

Baby Academy

1 event | 67 people

Saginaw County

A program for expectant parents and parents with babies up to 1 year old, this annual event offers a variety of helpful child-rearing resources in one place. Participants attend breakout sessions to gain valuable insight on parenting topics and how to be the best parent or caregiver possible. Those in attendance also can visit booths selling products or offering services for children and families.

Berenstain Bears Safety Lesson

13 presentations | 338 people

A 2-hour evidence-informed, award-winning training that teaches adults to prevent, recognize and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. Through interviews with child sexual abuse survivors, experts and treatment providers, *Stewards of Children®* teaches adults practical actions they can take to reduce instances of child sexual abuse in their organizations, families and communities. It is the only evidence-informed, adult-focused child sexual abuse prevention training in the U.S. that is proven to increase knowledge and change behavior.

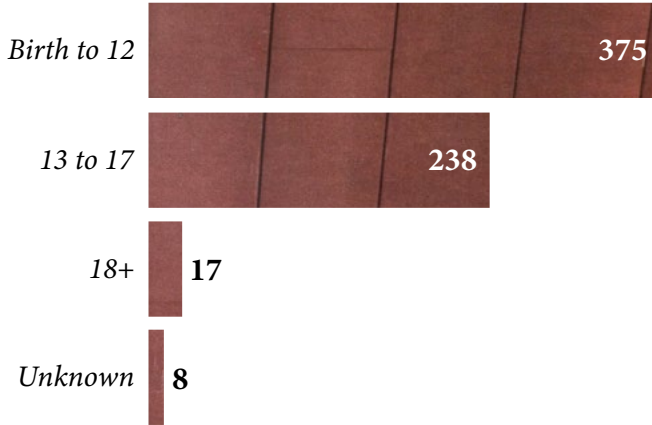

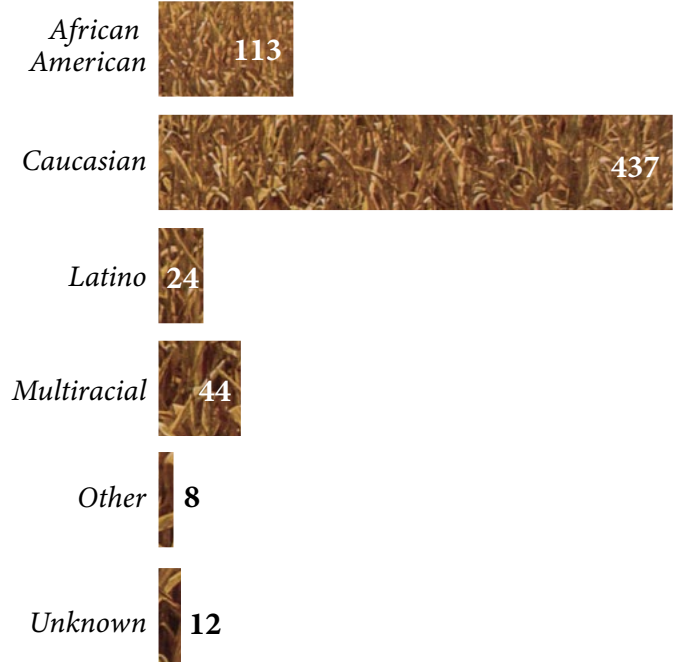

Race/ethnicity of victim



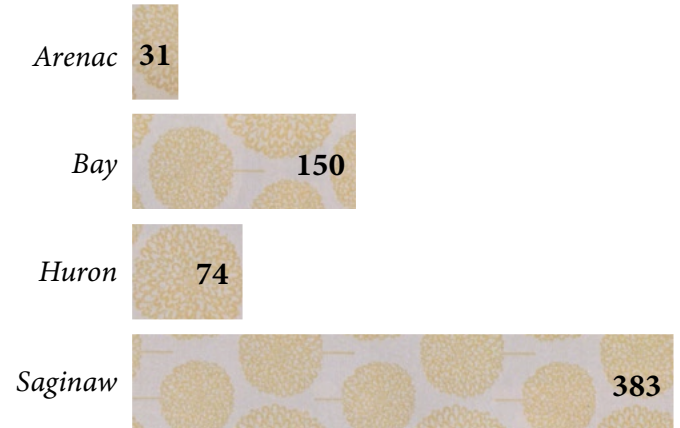
Gender of victim

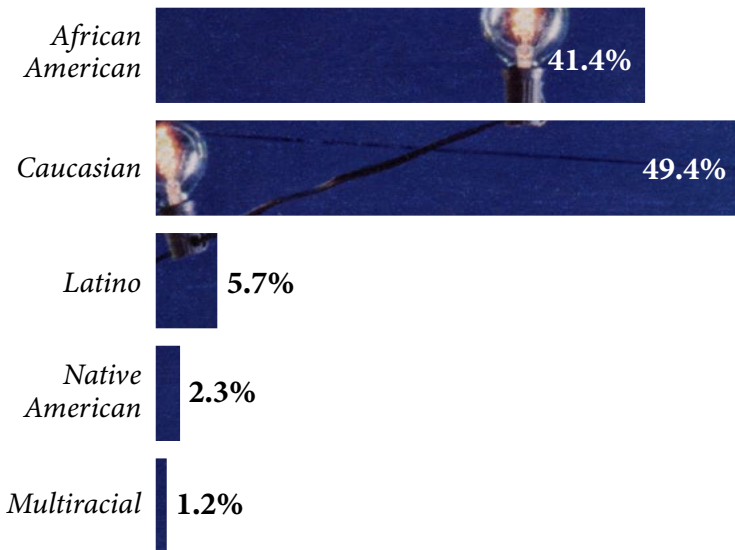

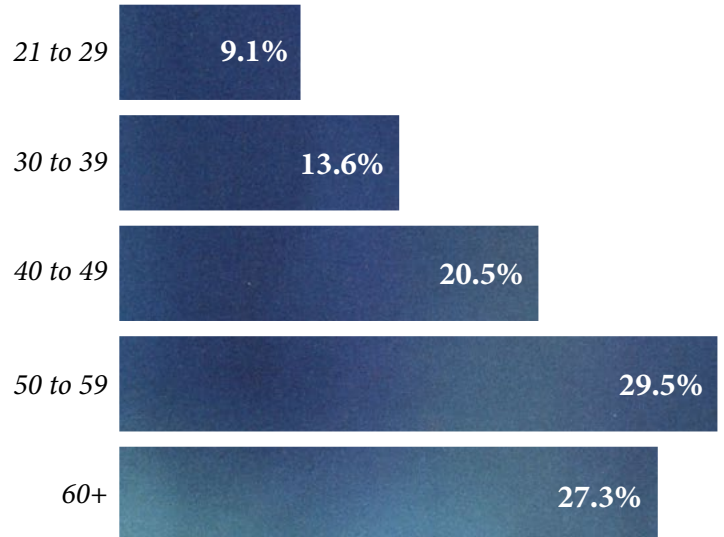

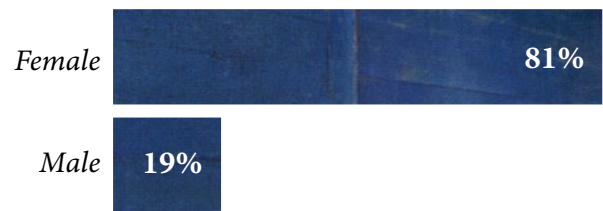

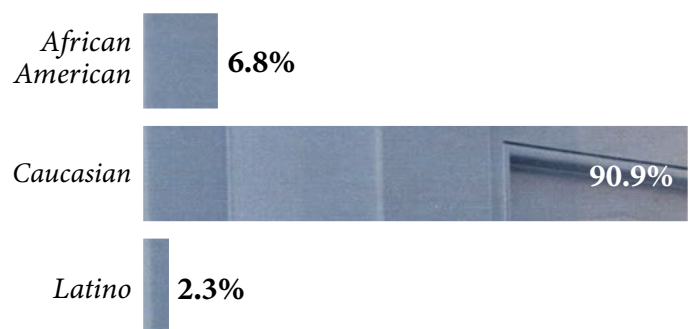

Court Appointed Special Advocates program established in Huron County



Huron County's first six-week CASA training began in May 2022, culminating in an August 4, 2022, swearing-in ceremony officiated by Judge Prill at the Huron County Courthouse. As of early 2023, the CAN Council had trained seven Huron County residents to serve as CASA volunteers.

"It is my belief that the CASA program is a trusted and valued organization working to improve outcomes for youth in the Bay and Saginaw County court systems," Judge Prill says. "The 52nd Judicial Circuit Court fully supports the program's expansion into Huron County. I look forward to having the CASA program serving our community's vulnerable children." ♦

Committed to meeting the needs of vulnerable children throughout our four counties, the CAN Council launched our Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) program in Huron County in 2022 at the request of The Honorable Gerald M. Prill of Huron County's 52nd Circuit Court.

This expansion marks a third location for the program, which began serving Saginaw County 20 years ago, with a Bay County program added in 2015.

CASAs are highly trained volunteers serving as the voice for children who are in the court system due to abuse or neglect. A CASA's advocacy helps ensure that services are provided for these youths, that their best interests are served and that their voices are heard.

CAN Council CACs prepare for changing funding landscape

Late in the summer of 2022, the CAN Council's Children's Advocacy Centers (CACs) were included in unexpected significant state funding cuts that impacted child abuse victim services across Michigan.

In response, citizens and community leaders around the state – including a great many of our own CAN Council donors and supporters – rose to the occasion and rallied, contacting legislators and signing petitions requesting reconsideration of the funding cuts. **As a result, funding was partially reinstated for fiscal year 2023 – a huge win!**

Our CACs in Arenac, Bay, Huron and Saginaw counties provide critical, life-changing services to children experiencing physical or sexual abuse, as well as children who have witnessed violence.

Each forensic interview at a CAC is observed through closed-circuit television by members of a multidisciplinary team that includes law enforcement, Department of Health and Human Services, medical and mental health professionals, prosecutors, and victim advocates. Based on their observation of the interview, the team collaboratively makes decisions about how best to protect the child and hold the perpetrator accountable. After their interviews, children and their non-offending caregivers receive medical exams, victim advocacy, criminal and civil justice support, referrals for counseling, and other critical services.

“Before CACs existed, a child could have been interviewed by as many as 13 different professionals in a variety of locations – in the back of a police car, at school or even in an emergency room,” says CAN Council President/CEO Emily Yeager. “With the creation of CACs, this all changed for

our communities. A child is now interviewed in *one place* – a child-friendly environment – *only one time*, by our specially trained forensic interviewer.”



While 2022's partial reprieve from funding cuts for fiscal year 2023 was a tremendous win for programs like our CACs, that temporary relief came with the knowledge that the government funding landscape for child abuse victim services will continue changing, and we must be proactive. Rest assured that the CAN Council is actively pursuing diversification in our funding sources to ensure that we are able to continue providing the highest level of caring, compassionate service for the young victims who need us most. And as a CAN Council supporter, there are so many ways you can help – attending and donating to our fundraising events, introducing family and friends to the CAN Council mission, letting us know when you learn of grant opportunities of all sizes, and writing to your state legislators and the governor about the important work being done by the CAN Council CACs and other child abuse victim services programs statewide. ✦

2022 Suzanne Greenberg Child Advocate of the Year



The late Gregory Causley
(1949-2021)

As President of Causley Trucking from 1979 until his passing in 2021, Greg passionately and earnestly led the company while also serving the industry through his involvement in the Michigan Trucking Association. He especially found joy in sharing his love for the trucking industry with youths as Chair of the Mid-Michigan Children's Museum's Touch-a-Truck event.

Greg's love for children and commitment to strengthening families extended well beyond the trucking industry. He was a strong supporter of and generous donor to the CAN Council, bringing friends, family and colleagues to our mission of saving children from abuse and neglect.

A visionary who actively engaged in efforts to benefit families and shine the light of the Lord in an otherwise dark world, Greg was one of the original founders of Rock the Island and Rock the

Schools, leading many initiatives to strengthen marriages, families and youth programming. He helped raise expansion funding for the Valley Lutheran High School Growth Campaign and was a Team Leader for the Via de Christo men's retreat. He worshipped regularly at Messiah Lutheran Church and was proud to support the church's His Hands Auto Repair mission work. He also was active with the Salvation Army Board of Directors and engaged in the organization's projects for youths in the community.

Greg's generosity truly reflected the kindness of his heart as he additionally made contributions to the American Legion, Compassion International (sponsoring five children over 15 years), Hockey Ministries International, Miracle Soldier, Mustard Seed, Released to Reign, the Saginaw Rescue Mission, Special Olympics, St. Jude Children's Hospital, Underground Railroad, Wellspring and the Wounded Warrior Project.

A family man first and foremost, Greg immensely loved his wife, his children, each of his nine grandchildren, his sisters and his extended family.

Greg served his faith, his family, his friends, his country, his company and his community with a humble, generous and happy heart. And his impact was vast, inspiring many to follow his path and continue his legacy of giving and caring for others – particularly for the benefit of children.

We are proud to honor Greg for demonstrating an outstanding commitment to making the Great Lakes Bay Region a better place for children and families. ♦

The Suzanne Greenberg Child Advocate of the Year award – established in the early 2000s and then renamed in 2020 in honor of the former longtime CAN Council President/CEO – annually honors an individual or organization for making a positive impact on the lives of children in the Great Lakes Bay Region. That individual or group is a strong advocate for child abuse prevention; is involved with the CAN Council; and is known and respected by a wide variety of people in the community for working to facilitate programs, activities and resources for children and families in harmony with the CAN Council mission of building communities where children are free from abuse and neglect.

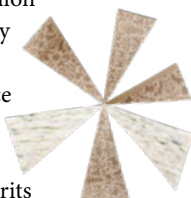

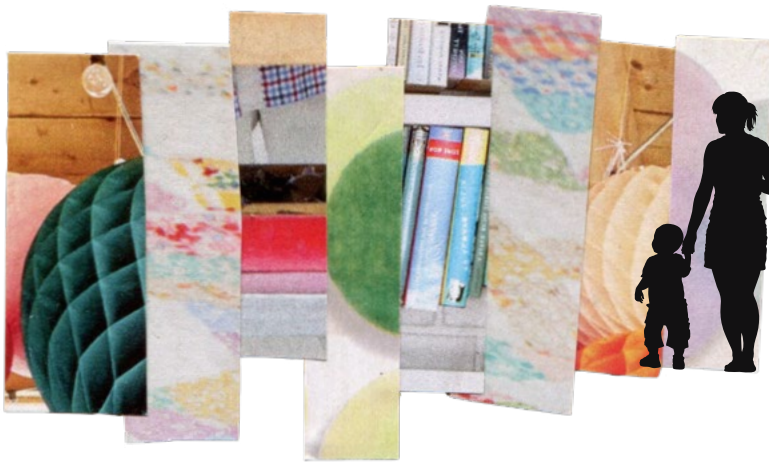
