## KCA-WL100 Firmware update Procedure



### Before you begin:

- An access point, is required to perform (download) the firmware update, Best to use home network (Wi-Fi) or use a friends phone as a Hotspot active
- To avoid update being interrupted keep your car on (i.e. engine running)

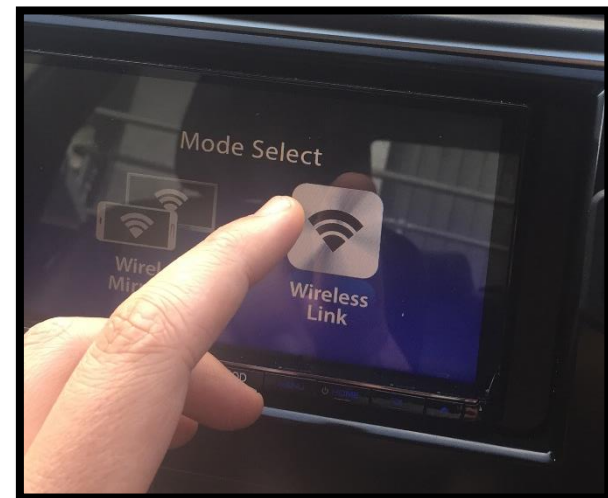
### Step 1:

- Go to HDMI Source on the Head Unit



### Step 2:

- In HDMI select mode “Wireless Link”.  
If in Wireless Mirroring Mode, press  
the on screen blue back button  to go to “Mode Select”



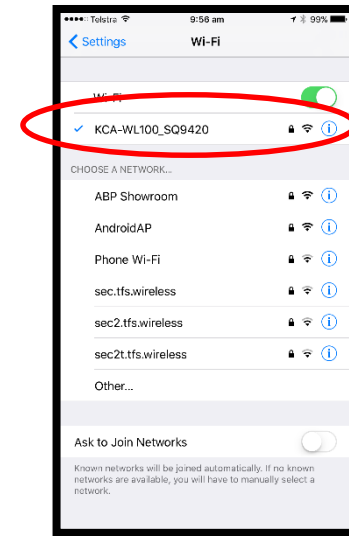
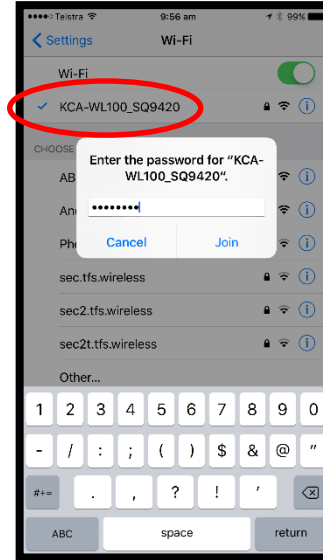

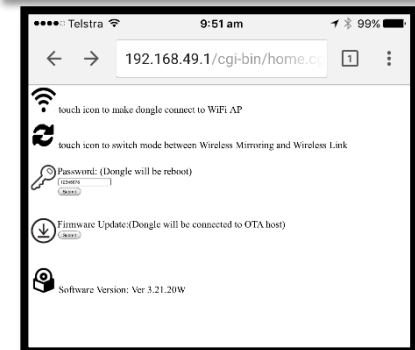
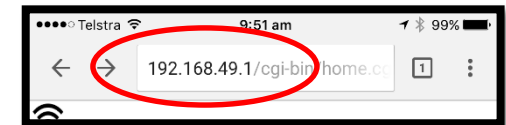
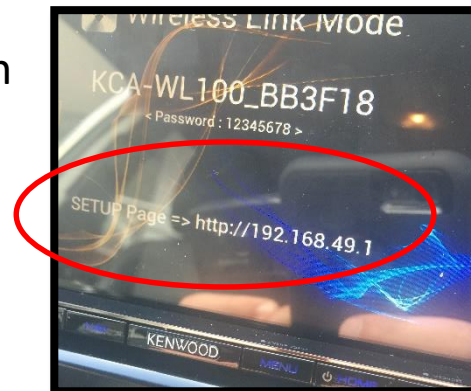
### Step 3:

- Only once in “Wireless Link” Mode in your iPhones Wi-Fi menu, connect to “KCA-WL100\_XXXXXX” Wi-Fi Network
- Password when prompted, unless changed by you is 12345678



### Step 4:

- On the “Wireless Link Mode” Screen you will see a setup page URL (Webpage address), Type this URL unto your Android Phone’s web browser and press the return/Enter key (Google Chrome Used in this image).



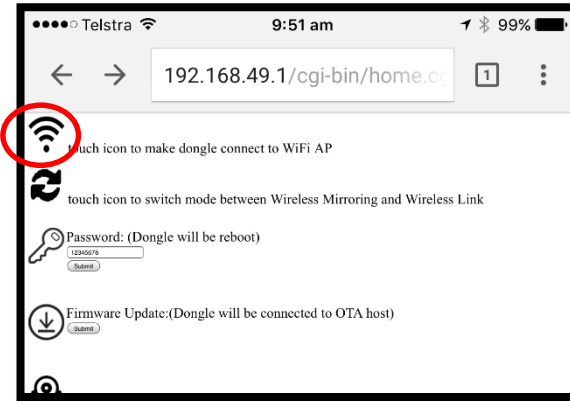

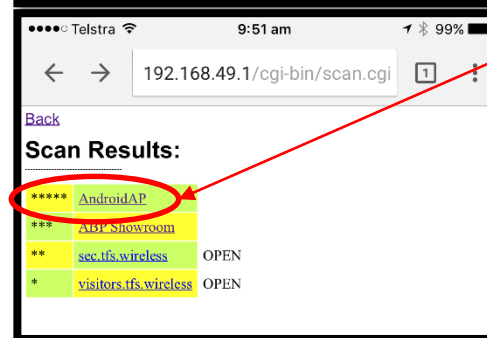
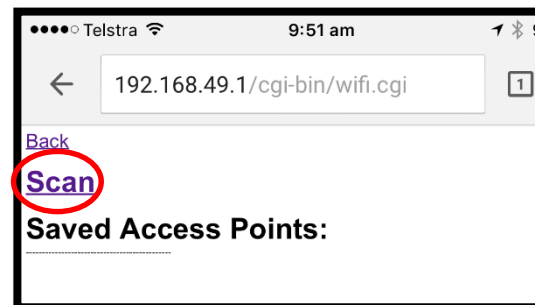
### Step 5:

- Once connected to the setup page, you will see a series of icons, tap the Wi-Fi icon with the text “Touch Icon to make dongle connect to WiFi AP”



### Step 6:

- Press “Scan”
- This will populate a list of nearby WiFi networks with Asterix “\*” indicating signal strength
- Note: \* Weak signal  
\*\*\*\*\* Strong signal



Known Network for me, which was a Android Phone hotspot. You can connect to any known Wi-Fi Networks

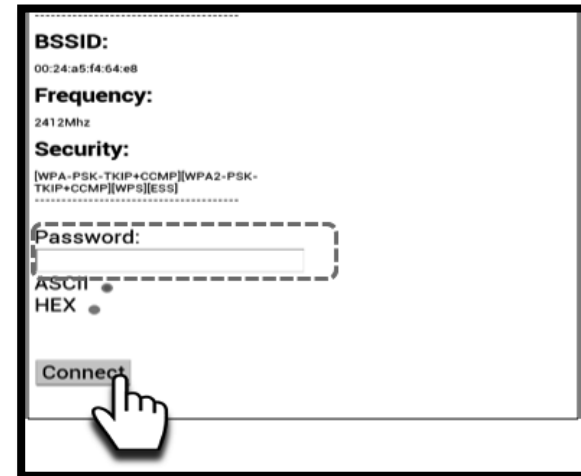

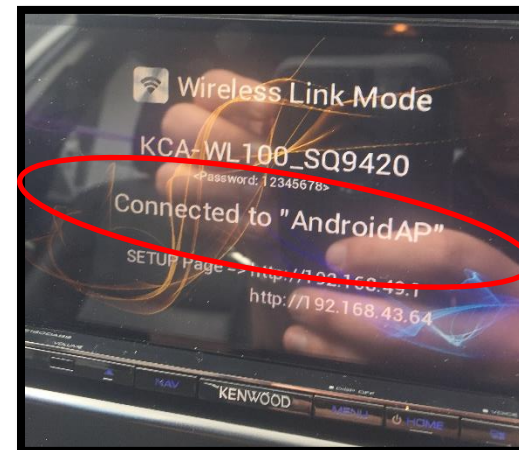
### Step 7:

- Tap on the WiFi Network you know the password to and have access to
- Tap on the box beneath Password and Type in your networks password should one be set and press connect.
- **Note:** in this instance, Android Phone Hotspot was used.



### Step 8:

- If connected successfully you will see Connected to "XXXXX" (XXXX indicates your network name, in this instance "AndroidAP" was the network/hotspot connected to.



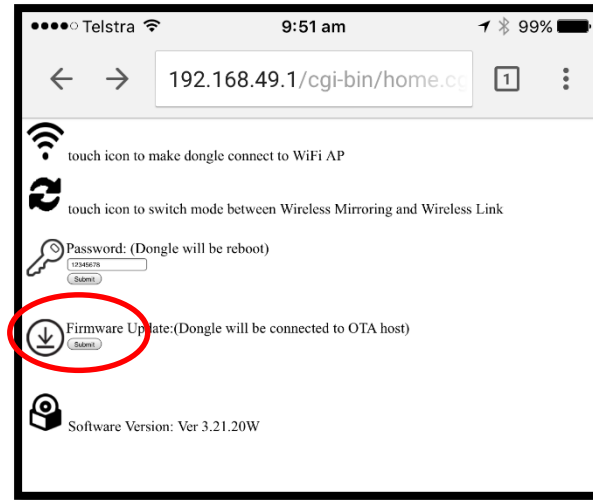

### Step 9:

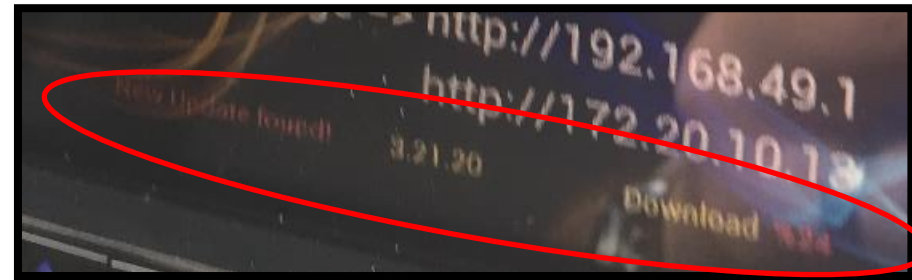
- On the Android Phone, press “back” to go to the main setup page
- Under “Firmware Update” press the “Submit” button to download the firmware file to the KCA-WL100



### Step 10:

- If done correctly, on the head unit on the bottom left of the screen will read “New Update Found 3.21.22”
- And the bottom Right “Download X%”

**Note:** (*X is in place is a number between 1 and 100 depending on download speed and download progress*)



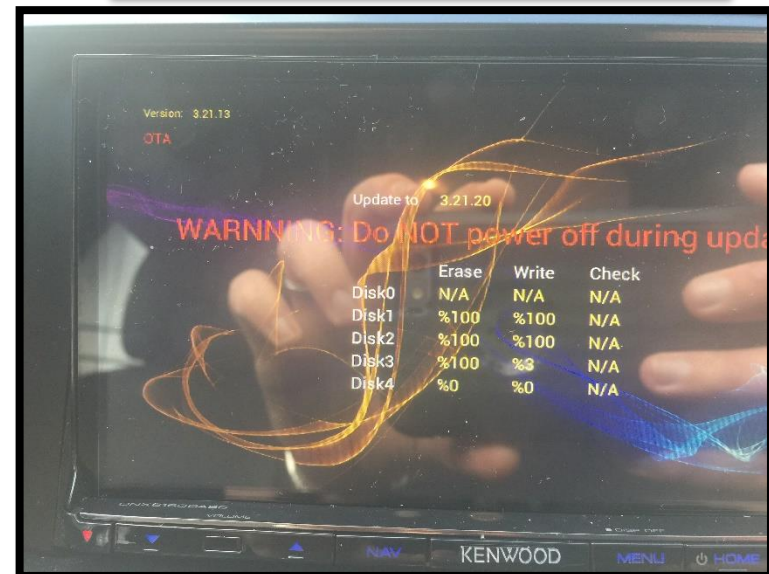

## KCA-WL100 Firmware update Procedure



### Step 11:

- This is completely Automated, **Do NOT power off during this update**
- Once “Download” per step 10 reaches 100% the update will begin to apply to Disk1, Disk2, Disc3 & Disc4 for both “Erase” and “Write”. All 4 Disks in both “Erase” and “Write” will need to reach 100% for the update to be complete.



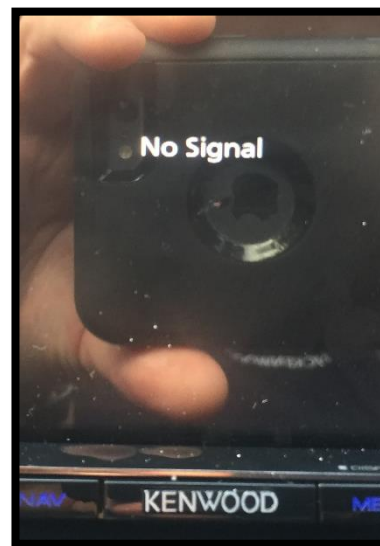

### Step 12:

- Once the update is complete, the screen will show “No Signal”, this is because the KCA-WL100 is rebooting and re-initialising

### Step 13: Connect your iOS Device

Tested: iOS Version 10.1.1 (14B100)

1. In HDMI Source
2. Select “Wireless Link” Mode
3. Connect to the KCA-WL100 in your iPhones WiFi settings.
4. Press the home button on your iPhone
5. Swipe up from the bottom of the screen and select KCA-WL100 Mirroring using the “AirPlay” function.
6. Done.
