#### PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE 2012


The Premier's Reading Challenge is on again! Last year was very successful with most of our students completing the challenge and receiving a certificate. The children need to read a set number of books from a given list. In our school library these books are colour coded. The books are also available in public libraries but are coded differently for recognition. The number of books needed to complete the challenge is:

K-2...30; Class 3 /4 ...20; Class 5 /6...20.

Kindergarten children can listen to a book, participate in a shared reading or read all or part of the book independently.

Children will be entering their books during their library lesson and they can also enter their books online themselves.

The Challenge finishes on 1 September 2012. It is hoped that everyone in the school will be able to complete the Challenge. Happy reading everyone!
