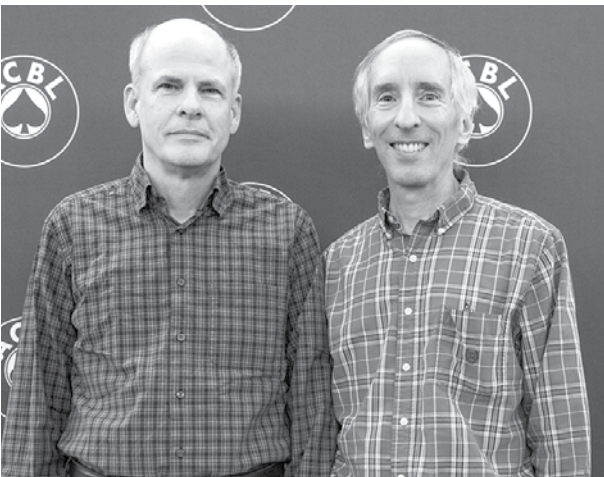

## Entry fees

A valid ACBL player number is required to play in all events at the NABC.

Players must be ACBL members whose service fees or dues are current in order to compete in any of the following nationally ranked events: Grand National Teams (Championship Flight), von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs, Spingold Knockout Teams, Wagar Women's Pairs, Truscott/USPC Senior Swiss Teams, Wernher Open Pairs, Freeman Mixed Board-A-Match Teams and the Roth Open Swiss Teams. The entry fees for these contests are \$30 per player per session. For team events, this means \$120 per team per session for four-person teams, \$150 per team per session for five-person teams, and \$180 per team per session for six-person teams. When screens are in use, there is an additional fee of \$10 per pair or \$20 per team per session.

Note: Only ACBL members are eligible to play in NABC+ events. \$1.50 per person per session benefits the International Fund.

Players must also be current ACBL members to play in the Grand National Teams (Flights A, B & C), the 0–6000 and 0–2500 Mini-Spingold Knockouts, the 0–10,000 NABC Pairs, the 0–10,000 Mixed Swiss Teams, the Bruce LM–6000 Pairs, the Young 0–2500 Pairs and the Bean Red Ribbon Pairs. The entry fee is \$22 per player per session. For the team events, this means \$88 per team per session for teams of four, \$110 per team per session for teams of five, and \$132 per team per session for teams of six. (The GNT Flights A, B & C have no fee the first two days of the contest.) When screens are in use, there is an additional fee of \$10 per pair or \$20 per team per session.

Regional events are \$20 per player per session for ACBL members, and \$24 for lapsed members. For multi-session team events of three sessions or more, the entry fee is \$80, \$100 or \$120 for teams of four, five or six, respectively. For team events of one or two sessions, the entry fee is \$80 per session.

Events with a masterpoint limit of 300 or lower are \$15 per player per session for ACBL members, \$19 for lapsed members.

## Parking

Parking is free for registered guests at The Cosmopolitan. For others, parking is \$15 per day for self-parking or \$20 per day for valet, or \$10 and \$15 for up to four hours. At Planet Hollywood, parking is free for everyone.

## Bridge Bucks and check cashing

Bridge Bucks and check-cashing services will be available outside the Gracia Ballroom on the third floor from 9:30 – 10 a.m. and noon to 1 p.m. Check-cashing limit is \$500.

Players may purchase Bridge Bucks using all major credit cards.

# JUST FOR NEW PLAYERS

## Take All Your Chances

**Eddie Kantar**

*North (Dummy)*

♠ A J 6 5 4  
♥ A Q  
♦ 3 2  
♣ J 8 3 2

*South (You)*

♠ K 3 2  
♥ 8  
♦ A 9 5  
♣ A K Q 10 9 5

After you open 1♣ and jump to 3♣ after partner's 1♠ response, partner leaps to 6♣. West leads the ♦Q. Clubs are 2-1. Plan the play.

You have two suits with finesse possibilities to play around with, spades and hearts, but be reminded, if the opponents get in they will cash a diamond!

If the heart finesse works, you can discard a spade on the ♥A, probably set up the spades for two diamond discards and chalk up an overtrick. If spades cannot be established for two discards, you will concede a diamond and ruff your remaining diamond. Easy enough if the heart finesse works, but what if doesn't? They cash a diamond and down you go, and maybe the spade finesse was right all along!

If the spade finesse works, and the suit breaks 3-2, you have 13 tricks; and if the suit breaks 4-1, you can concede a diamond, ruff a diamond and make your slam without worrying about who has the ♥K. But if the spade finesse loses, they take a diamond and down you go.

So which finesse should you take? Neither just yet, it was a trick question.

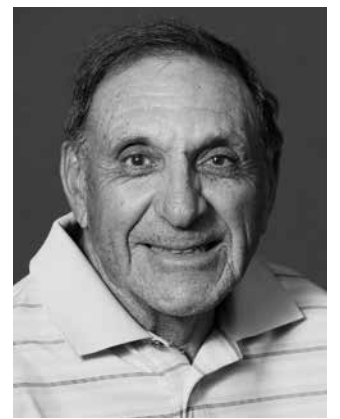
You can increase your chances dramatically by playing the ♠A K to see if the queen drops singleton or doubleton (33%). If it doesn't, take the heart finesse. This must be better than guessing which finesse to take. Besides, testing spades

keeps you alive for the heart finesse.

Your chance of making this hand by first playing the ♠A K and then taking the heart finesse, if necessary, is a bit more than 65%, better than a taking a spade finesse after cashing the king first. Tip: When you can't afford to give up the lead and you have two finesse suits, one missing a queen, the other a king, and if you pick the right one you will make your contract, don't try either! Play the ace-king of the suit missing the queen, and if the queen doesn't drop, try a finesse in the suit missing the king.

Incidentally, if the contract were 7♣, you should play the same.

## Convention card reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. The convention card must include the first and last name of each member of the partnership, and the cards must be identical.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the Standard American Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6-board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.

The objective of these warnings and penalties is the encouragement of full compliance with ACBL regulations.

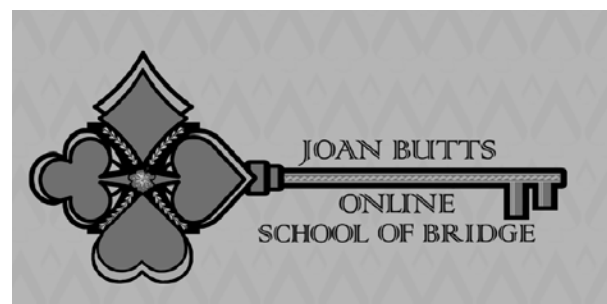
## NABC results by email/text

**Down one is good bridge?**

Glenn Milgrim reached 4♠ on a normal-enough sequence on this deal from the first semifinal session of the von Zedtwitz LM Pairs:

The defense was extremely unfriendly. South led the ♠A, ♣K and ♣9, North pitching a diamond, as declarer ruffed. Now the ♦A and a diamond ruff and overruff saw North endplayed into a trump return. When South showed out, the deal becomes a double-dummy problem: Win the ♠8 in hand, ruff a diamond with the ♠A, take the trump finesse, and cash the ♠K, leaving North with the last trump. Then cash the ♥A in this ending:

Now when you lead the ♦K, North can ruff and be endplayed, or he can pitch and let you take the ♥K for down one. Note that if you don't cash the ♥A, the endplay fails.

Down one was well above average.

**Appealing a ruling**

Players in NABC+ events who want to appeal a director's ruling initiate the process by speaking with the director who delivered the original ruling. The table director will fill out paperwork regarding the appeal, and the appellants will explain what they believe to be wrong with the initial ruling. From there, the case may be handled by a variety of means. When the appeals reviewer receives the case, the circumstances of that particular case will determine whether the case can be resolved by the original staff (in the case of misapplication of Law or regulation, for instance), a panel of directors, or even a committee-type hearing which could include bridge experts.

The Spingold Master Knockout Teams was originally known as the Masters Teams-of-Four, and it was first contested in September 1934 as a separate event held in conjunction with the Masters Individual. Although not played in 1935, it was again contested with the Masters Individual in 1936 and 1937. In 1938, the event became known as the Spingold Master Knockout Teams and was included in the summer schedule.

At one time the Spingold was a double elimination event scored by total points, usually lasting nine or ten sessions, restricted to players of Senior Master rank (100 or more masterpoints) and higher. Beginning in 1958, all matches were scored by IMPs (international matchpoints). In 1965, the double elimination method was replaced by three qualifying sessions (subsequently reduced to two), followed by single elimination knockout matches. The preliminary qualifying sessions were dropped in 1970.

The Spingold Trophy, donated by Nathan B. Spingold in 1934, is among the ACBL's most highly prized team trophies. Also in that category are the Vanderbilt Trophy, awarded to the winners of the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams at the Spring NABC, and the Reisinger Memorial Trophy, donated by the Greater New York Bridge Association in memory of Curt H. Reisinger and awarded to the winners of the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams.

Spingold (1886–1958), a New York publicist, motion picture executive and patron of the arts, was one of the most influential men in bridge administration from 1937 to 1943.

Born in Chicago, he became a reporter on The Chicago Examiner, The Chicago Record Herald and The Chicago Tribune. Spingold's interest in show business brought him to New York City in the 1930s.

In 1932 he joined Columbia Pictures in a public relations capacity. He was named to the board of directors in 1940 and three years later took charge of advertising, publicity and development. He became a vice president of the company in 1954.

Active in bridge from its earliest days, Spingold was named ABL Honorary Member in 1936. He was instrumental in effecting a peaceful merger between the American Bridge League and the United States Bridge Association in 1937 and became president of the newly formed American Contract Bridge League the following year.

He served for many years on the League's Board of Governors and Board of Directors. Spingold was also president of the Cavendish Club in New York.

## Wagar Pairs starts today

The Wagar Women's Pairs gets underway today. The event has been through several format and name changes; after decades as a knockout, it was run as a pairs contest for the first time in 2017. In some ways a relatively new event, it is tied to the history of the longest running women's event on the ACBL calendar.

Margaret Wagar (1902–1990), inducted into the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame in 1999, became Life Master #37 in 1943, the fifth woman to earn the rank. She and Kay Rhodes



share one of the most remarkable achievements in ACBL history – they won the Women's Pairs four consecutive years: 1955, 1956, 1957 and 1958.

Wagar and Rhodes share another record – one of frustration. They were second in the Women's Teams for seven consecutive years, 1952–1958.

Wagar's impressive record spans three decades and includes wins in women's and open competition. Her open wins include the Reisinger in 1941, the Open Pairs (the forerunner of the Blue Ribbon Pairs) in 1947 and 1948 and the Spingold in 1946 and 1948.

Wagar served on the ACBL Board of Directors from 1960 to 1972 and was named ACBL Honorary Member in 1979. She was non-playing captain of the U.S. World Women's Teams in 1968 and 1972.

Before being named for Wagar, the event was contested for the Coffin Trophy.

The inaugural Soloway Knockout Teams takes place at the Fall 2019 NABC in San Francisco. The new, top-tier ("NABC+") contest begins with a two-day Swiss qualifying round, reducing the field to 32 squads, followed by five days of head-to-head knockout matches to produce a single winner.

The contest awards platinum points, which are even available from match awards in the Swiss qualifier.

The Soloway KO will begin on the first Friday of the Fall NABC, Nov. 29., and concludes on Thursday, Dec. 5. The contest will not conflict with the venerable Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams, which begins Dec. 6, but teams who successfully advance to the quarterfinal round of the Soloway will be unable to play in the Kaplan Blue Ribbon Pairs, which runs Dec. 3-5.

The new contest is named in honor of late Hall of Famer Paul Soloway, a multiple world and NABC champion, as well as the all-time ACBL masterpoint leader until his death in 2007.

# When you have eliminated the impossible ...

These deals are from the second semifinal session of the von Zedtwitz LM Pairs.

Sitting there, minding your own business, you are confronted with a double decision in the bidding and play:

5♥ may or may not make. Your style tells you that South rates to have a singleton and 3–8 points at this vulnerability (he had 3NT available as a splinter, showing 9–12). Because partner rates to be short in diamonds, you could double. But if he is short in hearts, both 5♥ and 5♠ may make! You double and are relieved to see an opening diamond lead. How do you defend?

It may be unsatisfactory, but I really don't have an answer! If declarer is 2=6=2=3, you had better cash out and try for a trump promotion along the way in case partner has ♥J x x.

If, on the other hand, declarer has the more likely 2=5=2=4 pattern with partner holding the ♠K or the ♣A, you should shift to a club at trick two to give yourself a shot at down two.

Now if declarer draws only two rounds of trump and plays a diamond, he can still escape for down one.

I believe a club lead might allow you to get 300. Declarer draws two trumps to play a diamond. You win and underlead in spades for the third trump.

On the next deal, I missed the right line in embarrassing fashion. See if you can do better.

As East (a noted wise-ass) said after the deal, "The only reason partner doesn't lead a diamond is because he doesn't have one!"

Win the ♣A and play the ♦Q. East will cover and South ruffs. You can then play on spades and sit back for your two diamond tricks. Plus 1400 won't beat 1430, but it will beat 1370.

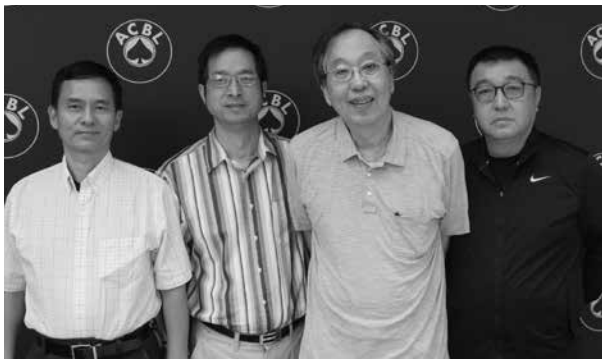

## Slow play

Slow play, especially habitual slow play, is a violation of law and subject to penalty. When a pair has fallen behind, it is incumbent on them to make up the time lost as quickly as possible whether at fault or not. All players are expected to make a concerted effort to catch up when they have fallen behind, regardless of the reason for their lateness.

In the absence of compelling evidence to the contrary, the director should presume that a pair finishing a round late by more than two or three minutes on more than one occasion during a session is responsible for the lateness. There is a strong expectation that the director will penalize such a pair. The size of a penalty will tend to increase for subsequent instances of slow play and for chronic or egregious slow play.

While warnings typically will be given before a penalty is assessed, failure to do so in no way limits the director's authority to issue a penalty.

Players are expected to be aware, in a general sense, of time used and remaining in a segment in which they are playing regardless of whether a clock is in use or a time announcement has been made. An excuse of "no announcement" or "no clock immediately visible" will not be considered persuasive.

In consultation with the DIC of the tournament, the TD may require that a particular pair not play in a specified segment, not play against a specified pair or not play together as a pair. The foregoing is expected to be applied only due to egregious circumstances or to unduly repetitious offenders.

An appeal of an action taken by a TD with regard to time may be taken to the Director in Charge of the tournament, and no further. For NABC+ KO events, the TD is charged with the responsibility to ensure that each KO match segment finishes within the allotted time. While a time monitor may be employed, the lack of a monitor in no way limits the TD's authority to apply one or more of the remedies listed below.

The TD may choose to ignore an occasional minor late finish. The TD may remove one or more boards from a segment. The TD may award no score (when neither team is more at fault), an assigned score (when a result already exists at one table which the TD wishes to preserve) or an artificial score in IMPs. Every effort should be made to remove boards before they can be played at either table, but not having done so does not preclude removing one or more later.

## Monitoring

ACBL monitors events at North American Bridge Championships with both visible and concealed real-time cameras in public spaces. The images are recorded and available for later inspection and review by ACBL management and tournament officials, among others, including members of the Anti-Cheating Commission. These recordings are also be uploaded to the internet following the NABC.

By general monitoring of the session and participants' behavior, ACBL has another source of information that may be useful in determining facts and settling issues or disputes arising from some types of ethical and behavioral complaints or actions. Please summon a director if a problem occurs at the table. This procedure is intended to assure everyone that the playing field is level and that misbehavior will not be tolerated."

A valid ACBL player number is required to play in all events at the NABC.

All North American championships with no upper masterpoint limit: \$30 per player per session (For team events, this means \$120 per team per session for four-person teams, \$150 per team per session for five-person teams, and \$180 per team per session for six-person teams. Only ACBL members current on their dues and service fees are eligible to play in NABC+ events. \$1.50 per person per session benefits the International Fund.)

Other North American championships: \$22 per player per session

(For the team events, this means \$88 per team per session for teams of four, \$110 per team per session for teams of five, and \$132 per team per session for teams of six. Only ACBL members current on their dues and service fees are eligible to play in these events.)

Regional championships: \$20 for ACBL members, \$24 for inactive members per player per session

(For multi-session team events of three sessions or more, the entry fee is \$80, \$100 or \$120 for teams of four, five or six, respectively. For team events of one or two sessions, the entry fee is \$80.)

Events with a masterpoint limit of 300 or lower: \$15 for ACBL members, \$19 for inactive members per player per session

Screen fees \$10 per session per pair and \$20 per session per team is added to events when screens are in use.


