Circuit issued opinion. Remanded back to FERC, without vacating the underlying FERC orders.            1/17/23 - MISO and MISO Transmission Owners requested rehearing from D.C. Circuit.  <b>1/27/23 – D.C. Circuit Court denied rehearing</b></p> <p><b>Commission action on remand is pending</b></p>
<b>ER21-2793</b>	<b>Multi-Party Facility Services Agreement</b>	<b>8/31/2021</b>	<p>MISO submitted a 205 filing to create a Multi-Party Facility Services Agreement (“MPFSA”). This is intended to increase efficiency and does not make material changes to self-funding. For example, this would allow a TO to enter into a single MPFSA with multiple ICs regarding a Common Use Upgrade as opposed to current practice which is multiple FSAs, one with each IC. MISO requested an effective date of October 31, 2021, but updated the effective date in the deficiency notice to be upon FERC acceptance.</p> <p>9/21/21 – Comments and Protests were filed.            10/06/21 – Answers to Protests were filed.            10/15/21 – FERC issued deficiency notice.            11/04/21 – MISO submitted a response to deficiency notice.</p> <p><b>Commission action is pending.</b></p>

MISO requested an effective date of February 2, 2022.</p> <p>4/29/2022 – Commission rejected Tariff changes.            5/27/2022 – MISO and MISO Transmission Owners submitted a Joint Rehearing Request            5/27/2022 – ITC submitted a Rehearing Request.            6/27/2022 – Commission issued a denial by ‘operation of law,’            8/26/2022 – MISO Transmission Owners filed a petition for review with D.C. Circuit Court.            12/16/2022 – Commission issued subsequent order that denied rehearing.            2/7/2023 – DC Circuit grants motion to hold matter in abeyance until the “final disposition of the proceedings remanded” in the self-fund (20-1453).</p> <p>All action is stayed.</p>

MISO requested an effective date of February 6, 2023.</p> <p>2/03/2023 – Commission issued a Letter Order accepting MISO’s filing.</p>
