Mission Statement

The Gospel of Jesus Christ calls us to be a welcoming community for all people growing in faith, love, and service.

These statements were developed by the Strategic Planning Team as our guide for who we are as a congregation. We live into our Vision Statement by welcoming all people to worship, to Holy Communion, and to all of our programs – no matter who they are or where they are in their faith journey.

For this program year, I am inviting us to delve more deeply into our Mission Statement. To explore what that means for us as individuals and what this statement means for us as a congregation. In particular, I would like to focus on the closing of the statement – "growing in faith, love, and service."

For the first few months of the program year (September – November), we will be exploring what it means to "grow in faith." This seems like the appropriate time to think about this part of our Mission Statement, as we begin a new year of Christian Education. The goal of our Sunday School and Confirmation programs is to pass on the faith to the youth of our congregation – to help them grow in faith.

However, formal Christian Education does not mark the end of growing in faith in our lives. Faith isn't something we achieve or get and then are done with. It is a lifelong commitment in building a deeper relationship with our Savior, Jesus Christ. We need to always be nurturing and feeding our faith to help it to grow. We remember Jesus' words from the Gospel of Matthew, *"For truly I tell you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you."*

When you plant a seed in the ground, it needs to be tended to, watered, and nurtured in order for it to grow into what it was intended to be. Our lives of faith are much the same – they need to be tended to and nurtured in order for us to grow into the disciples and people God wants us to be. Over the next couple months, in sermons and studies and activities, we will explore and challenge ourselves together to put into practice faith practices that will help us all "grow in faith."

Then in the winter, our focus will be on "growing in love," during our Advent and Christmas celebrations leading up to Ash Wednesday, which falls on Valentine's Day this year. Finally, we will close out the program year by "growing in service" as the focus of our Lenten and Easter Services.

Come and join us on this journey through our Mission Statement so that we can be the welcoming community for all people that the Gospel of Jesus Christ calls us to be!



This group meets most Wednesdays at 6:00 pm for rehearsal. They provide music for the worship service about once a month.








Homecoming Parade Float

One conversation that was brought up numerous times was to bring back Love In Action.

- 1) Liked having assigned months
- 2) People like to bake & bring food but did not want to, or were unable to, be in the baking group.

We heard you and we are going to implement something to that effect, but not exactly like, Love In Action.

SUNDAY WORSHIP VOLUNTEER SPOTS

We will continue with sign-up sheets on the Welcome Center counter. They will be there at least one month ahead of each assigned month. We hope that there are enough people willing to sign up and fill ALL of the spots EVERY month.

However, effective October 1, 2023, whatever spots do NOT get filled in will then be assigned to members according to the alphabet letter assigned to that month.

We know that many of you enjoy ushering, being a lector, serving communion, greeting and helping in the kitchen, You are encouraged to sign up WHENEVER it works for you, REGARDLESS of the letter your last name starts with. You can sign up as often as you like and for ANY month of the year.

Emails and/or letters will still go out to everyone that signed up or have been assigned by the committee.

We will do our best to keep to the alphabetical schedule when we (Worship/Evangelism Committee) need to assign. But there could be times we need to reach out to others.

This system is going to apply only to worship services (not to funerals, weddings, or special events).

BAKING FOR SUNDAY FELLOWSHIP HOUR

The ALC baking group gets together to bake items about once a month. They put these in the freezer.

We ask that you have your items to church by 8:00 am on Sunday morning (You can bring them in anytime during the week.) Please label them - marked for Sunday Fellowship - and put them on the counter or in the refrigerator.


When the volunteers come in on Sunday morning to get ready, they take whatever is marked for that Sunday, either from the counter or from the freezer.

During the summer months (mid May to mid Aug) approximately 4 dozen goodies are needed. During the school year approximately 12 dozen goodies are needed. Adults and Sunday School kids are offered the same thing. This does NOT mean you need to bring enough to serve everyone. We try to provide a variety each Sunday and there are always items in the freezer that can be used. We do ask that what you bring can be served on napkins only.
