The installation of a new Trump Administration following the results of the November 2016 General Election are likely to have substantial effects upon the nation’s policies and priorities, none more than potential impacts to the water sector. President Trump has made it clear that he plans to make major investments in the nation’s infrastructure, while rolling back many of the Obama Era environmental policies. The incoming 115th Congress will be pushing forward the Trump Agenda, but changes to leadership of key committees will likely mean changes to the legislative process. This lunch event will be an opportunity to discuss with the WEF Government Affairs Team, policy goals of the Trump Administration and Congress in 2017, the status of the administration change at the US EPA, and how that process will likely play out.
