ABOUT THE WILDCATS

Wildcats Storylines ...

A NEW BEGINNING: The foundation of Saint Ignatius Football was built over the last 40 seasons under legendary football coach Chuck Kyle '69. Since taking over in 1983, coach Kyle amassed 377 wins, 11 State Championships and four National Championships. Now, the reins are handed to his protege in Ryan Franzinger '02. August 18 at 7 p.m. will kick off a new era of Wildcat Football. Franzinger has been a part of the coaching staff since the 2007 season and has held the titles of Linebackers Coach, Defensive Coordinator and Associate Head Coach. Franzinger will look to join Al Gizzi as the last first-year head coach to win his first game. Gizzi achieved a 22-7 victory over Parma at Byers Field in his coaching debut in 1977.

THE STABLE: The running back group has reloaded and is back at full strength after a 2022 season that saw a fair share of injuries. Grant Washington had a promising sophomore season, splitting time with Steven Favazzo '22 and Sean Martin before being sidelined with an injury. Last season, Washington toted the rock 30 times for 211 yards. That included an 85-yard touchdown against Euclid at Byers Field. Washington has been named the number one back. Martin will begin the year primarily at his defensive back position. Max Ritt returns with experience in the backfield, carrying the ball 15 times for 65 yards and two touchdowns. He will see time at running back, despite starting in the slot for the Wildcat offense. Sophomore Owen Colwell and junior Trenton Latkovic round out the stable for the running backs.

BUILDING THE FOUNDATION: A unique situation for the Wildcats coming into 2023 is that four of the five starting offensive linemen are sophomores. Michael van der Oord and Will Conroy anchor the tackle position. Andy Todaro gets the start at right guard and Alex Miller will be the center. The lone lineman with starting varsity experience is junior Leo Rick, who will line up at left guard. Other linemen may see time, including junior Charles Glowe and sophomore Scottie Puhalsky. There may be growing pains early in the season, but the future for the Wildcat offensive line has a high ceiling.

THE NFL CONNECTION: Three coaches on the varsity roster bring NFL experience to Saint Ignatius. LeCharles Bentley '98 returns to his Alma Mater to coach the young offensive line. Bentley is a two-time Pro Bowl center that was drafted by the New Orleans Saints after a successful career at The Ohio State University and would wrap up his NFL career with the Cleveland Browns. Ike Charlton is a former second-round NFL draft pick who will lead the defensive backs. Charlton was a Seattle Seahawks and Jacksonville Jaguars member after a successful career at Virginia Tech. Kevin Spencer leads the special teams unit for the Wildcats after many years of NFL coaching, including stops with the Cleveland Browns, Arizona Cardinals, San Diego Chargers and the Super Bowl XL Champion Pittsburgh Steelers.

ONE-TWO PUNCH: The senior leaders of the defensive line will be Garrett Butchko and Greg Hanson Jr. Butchko will look to have a big season off the edge, while Hanson will cause havoc at his nose guard position. On the other side of the line is junior Jacob Papesh. The D-Line has the potential to dominate the trenches in 2023.

LEARNING ABOUT THE WILDCATS ...

ABOUT SPRINGFIELD: The Wildcats of Springfield are coming off back-to-back State Runner-Up seasons and are still seeking the first OHSAA Football State Title in Clark County. Last season, the Wildcats were dominant, achieving a 13-2 record and a rematch against St. Edward in the State Championship at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium. Springfield fell just short, losing to the Eagles 28-14. Led by former Chicago Bear and New York Giant Maurice Douglass enters his 10th season with the Wildcats and has a career record of 73-34 as the Head Football Coach at Springfield. Douglass has turned Springfield into a premier powerhouse in Ohio and they look to make it a third straight season with a State Championship berth.

SWITCHING OF THE GUARD: Springfield graduated with a tremendous quarterback in Bryce Schondelmyer, who finished his high school career 5th all-time in passing yards in Ohio High School Football, passing now Cincinnati Bengal quarterback Joe Burrow on that list. This season, the quarterback reins are handed to junior Brent Upshaw. Upshaw is the projected starter for the Wildcats and is listed at 6'2, 175-pounds and backed up Schondelmyer in 2022.

GOLDEN FLASH: Headlining the receiving core for Springfield in 2023 is senior Da'Shawn Martin. Martin verbally committed to Kent State University this summer and will be the primary target for the Wildcats. In a loaded receiving group last season, Martin hauled in 41 passes for 622 yards and seven touchdowns. He finished his junior season third on the team in yards but was ninth overall in the Greater Western Ohio Conference. After the graduation of Anthony Brown, now at the University of Kentucky and Shawn Thigpen, Martin looks to take the lead of the receiving room in 2023.

A FUTURE BUCKEYE: A key returner for the Wildcat defense in 2023 is senior cornerback Aaron Scott. The Ohio State Buckeye commit is a four-star recruit coming off a phenomenal junior season. Scott is ranked the number 34 prospect in the Nation and number 3 in his position for the class of 2024. In 2022, Scott intercepted five passes, returning two for a pick-six. He also added seven pass breakups and a fumble recovery. A true lock-down corner, Scott is on the radar for the Saint Ignatius offense coming into Friday night.

QB JOSHUA PAPESH '24



The Wildcats return their starting quarterback from a season ago, Joshua Papesh. Papesh, last season, completed 61.5% of his passes, tossing for 1,541 yards and 13 touchdowns, appearing in all 12 games. Decision-making will be critical for Papesh in week one as he goes against a stifling defense that features a lock-down corner in Aaron Scott. Papesh was named a team captain for the 2023 season.

DL GARRETT BUTCHKO '24



One of the key returners on defense this season is defensive end Garrett Butchko. The 6'1, 240-pound edge rusher enters his senior season looking to dominate and lock up a football scholarship. In his junior year, Butchko totaled 22 tackles, four for a loss, three sacks and a forced fumble. Butchko mainly played at the nose guard position in 2022 but will primarily be used on the edge for Dave Cicetti's defense this season. He was named a team captain in 2023.

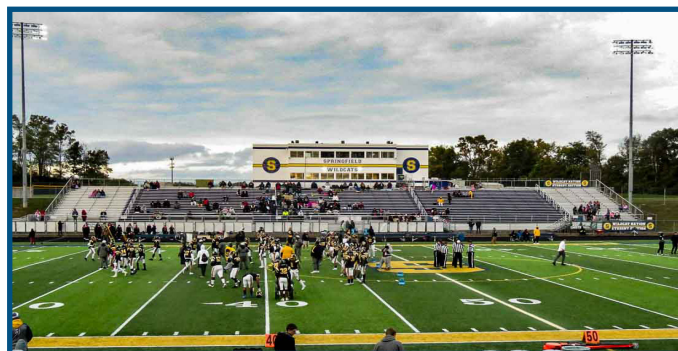

Originally the Wildcats played at Evans Stadium for their home football games. Before the 2019-2020 school year, there was significant water damage in the press box of Evans Stadium. Along with the press box being removed, the visitor bleachers on the stadium's north side was removed due to deterioration.

Evans Stadium was named after Dr. Charles Wesley Evans, who practiced in Springfield for 64 years. He served on the school board for 16 years and is reported to have delivered 4500 babies.

Due to the safety of their players and fans, the Wildcats began playing their games on campus in 2019 and currently play at Springfield Wildcat Stadium.

The Wildcats would go 5-1 in the first season playing inside Springfield Wildcat Stadium in 2019.

In 2017 the field received a new turf that features the Springfield logo at midfield, with the SPRINGFIELD name in the south end zone and WILDCATS in the north end zone.

Springfield Wildcat Stadium can seat 5,241 and features a track outside the field. There are stands on both sides of the field, with the home side, press box on the west side, and visitor seating on the east side. There are added bleachers behind both endzones that can hold the home and visiting marching bands.

Saint Ignatius first played at Springfield Wildcat Stadium in 2021 when they traveled three hours south to Springfield, a city just outside Dayton, Ohio. Springfield won the first-ever meeting against Saint Ignatius with a 24-20 comeback victory.

The two schools were scheduled to meet at Byers Field in 2022, but due to weather, was cancelled. The battle flips back to Springfield Wildcat Stadium, where the Wildcats will open the 2023 season on August 18.



GAME PREVIEW

CATS BEGIN SEASON WITH A ROAD TRIP TO SPRINGFIELD

It has been 280 days since the Wildcats took to the gridiron and for the first time since the 1983 season, will be under the direction of a new head coach in Ryan Franzinger '02.

Last season, the Wildcats finished the season with an 8-4 record and for the third consecutive season fell in the OHSAA Regional Semifinal. Now a new era of Wildcat football begins when Saint Ignatius takes on the Springfield Wildcats.

Springfield is coming off a 13-2 season which ended for the second straight season with a State Championship run in Division I. Springfield Head Football Coach Maurice Douglass Sr. has turned the Wildcats into a Ohio Powerhouse with back-to-back berths into the State Championship, but have fallen both times to the St. Edward Eagles.

A season ago, the Battle of the Wildcats did not happen due to the power of Mother Nature. The teams were ready to begin the 2022 season, but because of persistent thunderstorms, the game was cancelled.

Saint Ignatius and Springfield will look to have better luck with the weather and square off against each other for the first time since 2021.

A major storyline for the Wildcats in week one is that they will start eight sophomores against Springfield, but return 51 letter award winners.

SAINT IGNATIUS OFFENSE VS. SPRINGFIELD DEFENSE

Most sophomore starters against Springfield will come from the offensive line. Four sophomores will gain their first start at the varsity level on Friday night.

"If you are a sophomore, you're eligible for varsity and eligible to play. You're not boosted because you are a senior," says Franzinger. "The offensive line has four sophomores, but the linemen are LeCharles' [Bentley 98] guys. Our men have learned great technique and approach to the game. With a great technique, you can overcome some of the other team's advantages against you."

The run game will go as far as the offensive line will take and that is what the Wildcats will look to establish in week one against Springfield with a rotational of backs including Grant Washington and Max Ritt.

"Running and protecting the ball are the universal keys to victory. Since May, we have done ball security circuits. I hope that translates," explains Franzinger.

"From the quarterback standpoint, that means making good decisions and not forcing anything."

Springfield's defense features a four-star cornerback and is one of the best in the nation at his position for the Class of 2024 in Aaron Scott. Scott will continue his career at The Ohio State University. Scott picked off five passes a season ago and scored twice on a pick-six.

Another name to watch out for on the Springfield defense is linebacker Kyron Dolby. The junior is on the game plan for the Wildcat offense in week one, as Dolby is a player who can fly all over the field and cause havoc for an offense.

"We think we will be able to move their guys; they run a similar defense to ours where they roll out three down linemen," "But their corner and linebacker are outstanding players."

SAINT IGNATIUS DEFENSE VS. SPRINGFIELD OFFENSE

Saint Ignatius will, unfortunately, be without standout junior Cody Haddad in week one and for an extended period as he went down with an injury against Canton McKinley in the annual Jamboree scrimmage.

With the absence of Haddad, the secondary will need to step up in a big way against a potent Springfield offense. Max Woidke and Sean Martin will start at the cornerback spot, with the safeties featuring Leo Ference and Ryan Roche. Rounding out the secondary will be the Wildcats' leading receiver a season ago in Jonathan Merimee.

Merimee will begin the season on the defensive side of the football at free safety. The 6'4, 215-pound senior captain could be just what the Wildcat secondary needs to dominate.

"With Springfield, they haven't committed to running the football. Limiting the big play will be key for our defense this week; Springfield has that capability," Franzinger says. "They have had some outstanding quarterbacks the past couple of years. Unfortunately, we couldn't play them last year because we had this game plan that we could not use."

Brent Upshaw is the expected starter for Springfield and was the backup to Bryce Schondelmyer in 2022. Springfield also features a decent size offensive line and will be the defensive line technique that needs to pave the way in the trenches.

Garrett Butchko and Greg Hanson Jr. return for the defensive front in 2023 and are complimented by junior Jacob Papesch at the other end position.

The Wildcats regain Martin, Ryan Ardire and Patrick Cooney, all returning from injury. Due to an injury to Michael Krebs, sophomore Nick Rivera will receive his first varsity start at middle linebacker.

SPECIAL TEAMS

A negative from the Canton McKinley scrimmage was the number of penalties accumulated by the special teams unit with the confusion of personnel on the field. "We change the depth chart daily on special teams," Franzinger says. "I can't stand penalties on special teams. We had some problems against Canton McKinley but addressed them and hope not to make those mistakes again."

Senior Tommy Kilbane is headlining the kicking game; he was a perfect 16-16 with his PAT kicks a season ago.

"Tommy makes my job a lot easier. He responds well to competition and his mental game is sound," explains Franzinger. "You are comforted by a kid who approaches the game like Tommy. He is accurate and we feel good about field goals close to 50 yards."

Kilbane is unique in that he is ambidextrous with the kicking game, as he developed that skill with the rugby team in the spring. That could significantly help the Wildcats in the kicking game this season.

The scene is set as high school football returns to Ohio and it will be the Battle of the Wildcats from Springfield Wildcat Stadium on Friday at 7 p.m. The Cats look to begin the season on a high note in 2023.
