### Autodesk Mechanical Desktop 2008 (Inventor Series 2008)

Customers who have an annual support plan with Origin International should have received the Inventor Series 2008 direct to their location from Autodesk. CheckMate 12 will be installed with this version of Mechanical Desktop (Autodesk Mechanical Desktop 2008).

Note that Autodesk Mechanical Desktop 2009 has also shipped to customers who have an annual support plan with Origin International. CheckMate will NOT run in Autodesk Mechanical Desktop 2009.

Origin will only be shipping a CheckMate 12 DVD to install with your existing Autodesk Mechanical Desktop 2008. If desired, your Mechanical Desktop 2008 can be installed at anytime so you are prepared when CheckMate 12 is released. You DO NOT have to uninstall any of your existing software.

Origin International has purposely skipped the Mechanical Desktop 2007 and gone directly to Mechanical Desktop 2008 because of all the changes in this release.

CheckMate 12 will be released in the near future starting with beta sites. This webinar will cover some very important issues of getting started with installation, new dialog boxes, new toolbars, multi-document interface, where to add your custom toolbars (custom menu included for this) and many more things.
