Wrth osod chwyddwydr ar fywydau criw o ddynion cyffredin sy'n gwneud pethau anghyffredin, mae **The Pitmen Painters** yn bortread hynod ddoniol, gwefreiddiol ac amserol o gelf, dosbarth a gwleidyddiaeth.






