### Cage (bigger = better)

Min	18" x 18" x 36"
Ideal	24" x 24" x 48" or 36" x 18" x 36" or greater

- One chameleon per cage
- Screen, hybrid, or glass cages can be used depending on how much environmental control is necessary
- "Forest Edge" Style with live plants
- MUST have suitable perching area behind plants where chameleon can hide entire body from view and block UVB light from above



### Temperature

Day time	68-75°F / 20-24°C
Night time	50-65°F / 10-18°C
Basking	80-85°F / 26-29°C

### Humidity

Day time	30% - 50% RH <sup>1</sup>
Night time	80% to 100% RH <sup>2</sup>


<sup>1</sup>Ensure that branches and surfaces dry daily

<sup>2</sup>Provide air movement to avoid stagnant air

### Feeding

Age	Frequency	Food Items
0-9 months or Gravid	Every Day	Unrestricted
Adult	Every Other Day	2-3

### UVB Bulb & Reflector




Tech	Bulb	Reflector	X"
T5	6%	Arcadia ProT5, 6%	6"
T5	12%	Arcadia ProT5, 12%	12"

X" distance is from UVB bulb to back of chameleon through a 70% penetration screen top panel of the cage.

X" distance is average compromise over bulb lifetime. Use Solarmeter 6.5 for exact measurements.

### Lighting & Hydration Cycle

\*Mister is 1-2 minutes each cycle
