Taita Blade-horned (or Böhme's Two-horned) Chameleon Kinyongia boehmei







Min	18" x 18" x 36"
Ideal	24" x 24" x 48" or 36" x 18" x 36" or greater

- One chameleon per cage
- Screen, hybrid, or glass cages can be used depending on how much environmental control is necessary
- "Forest Edge" Style with live plants
- MUST have suitable perching area behind plants where chameleon can hide entire body from view and block UVB light from above

Tech Bulb Reflector T5 6% Arcadia ProT5, 6% 6" T5 12% Arcadia ProT5, 12% 12" X" distance is from UVB bulb to back of chameleon

through a 70% penetration screen top panel of the cage.

X" distance is average compromise over bulb lifetime. Use Solarmeter 6.5 for exact measurements.
