Salted, dried or cooked fish, used as a condiment to other food or as a pickled relish

Musht


Musht
Includes the popular *Tilapia Galilea*, commonly called **Saint Peter's fish** (cp Lk 24v35, Jn 21v11)
Good for broiling and frying.

Biny


Biny (Barbels)
 Consists of three species of the Carp family. The two most common species are the *Barbus longiceps* and the *Barbus Canis*. Both are used by Jews for Sabbath meals and feasts.

Sardines

Kinneret Sardine
 Usually salted, pickled or smoked, and often processed at the extensive fish processing plant in old Magdala, *Magdila Nuniyen*, the tower of fish.
