



Some Words from the Pastor

This weekend we are celebrating the Feast of St. Lorenzo Ruiz de Manila. Novena masses are being celebrated all over the archdiocese, and likewise in a lot of dioceses and parishes around the world. In our San Fernando Pastoral Region, we started the celebration of the novena masses at St. Genevieve Church. The culmination will be on September 23, 2023 at St. Elizabeth of Hungary Church. The mass will be presided by Archbishop Socrates Villegas, the archbishop of Lingayen-Dagupan in the Philippines. He is a popular bishop in the Philippines, being once the president of the Catholic Bishop's Conference of the Philippines. He was a protegee of the late Cardinal Jaime Sin of Manila, who was instrumental in ending a dictatorship in Philippines. He is in the archdiocese to celebrate the faith with the Filipino community, as we honor St. Lorenzo Ruiz and also the Virgen de los Remedios. The Filipino Priests will have an opportunity to interact with him through a dinner on September 22, and listen to him talk about church and politics in the Philippines.

Back to St. Lorenzo Ruiz de Manila, Filipinos all over the world are certainly celebrating his feast, reflecting about his influence and relevance in the lives of people especially in our times. His martyrdom will truly inspire us continually in living our faith amidst the difficulties and challenges that we face as a church today. He did not denounce his faith inspite of the horrible tortures that he endured under the hands of his executioners at Nagasaki. His

famous words continue to reverberate as we hear him cry and moan in anguish: "If I have a thousand lives, I will offer all of them to the Lord." He was filled with grace by the Lord that enabled him to remain steadfast and firm in his faith.

St. Lorenzo Ruiz is also seen as a missionary. The circumstances that surrounded his escape and journey to Japan were all within the will and plan of God. That as he travelled away from his home and country, he brought with him his faith. He shared and showed his profound faith to the world through his martyrdom. Indeed he offered his life for the sake of his faith. He is an icon to be emulated as we continue to take part in the mission of the church in bringing the faith to all peoples. We face a lot of challenges during these times. But they should not deter us from fulfilling our mission. As we celebrate his feast in our parish this weekend, let us ask for his prayers and intercessions, that we may remain steadfast in our faith. St. Lorenzo Ruiz de Manila. Pray for us!

*STEWARDSHIP OF TREASURE

Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Reading: Is 55:6-9/Ps 145:2-3, 8-9, 17-18 (18a)/Phil 1:20c-24, 27a/Mt 20:1-16a

Once I gave my three-year-old niece a certain toy for Christmas. When she opened it, she was happy. Shortly thereafter her five-year old sister opened another present from me: the same toy, along with some play jewelry. The three-year-old cried out: "That's not fair! Why'd she get the jewelry, too?!"

Let's face it: there's something about God's grace in our religion which bugs us. We love to look at others' blessings and cry out: "That's not fair!" Catholicism is not fair in the sense that it is a religion founded on God's grace which is unmerited favor. God pours his mercy, love, and divine life upon us not because we're good but because He is infinitely good.

If you think the "not fair" quality of grace is easy to accept, consider how typically angry we get when we hear the parable of the workers who get paid way more than they deserve. The hyper-generous landowner says to the indignant hard workers, "Are you envious because I am generous?" Well, yes, they are, and so are we! Therefore, we have to reckon with this painful truth in order to move into the divine sphere of gifts, which is the world of Christ and his Church. Then we are able to move beyond a tit-for-tat world and into one where gifts are poured forth on those who don't deserve it — namely, upon us.

Becoming Catholic

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults [OCIA, formerly RCIA] is the faith-stirring process by which adults seek a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ and decide whether to commit themselves to Jesus' mission and his Church. The OCIA can best be described as a process of coming to know Jesus Christ on a personal level. Coming to know Jesus is a process of ever-deepening growth and commitment - a process that continues long after you are initiated into the Catholic Church. We will try to help you discover your readiness to make that commitment to Christ in and through the Church. We will celebrate your journey to Christ in various rituals. Finally, the OCIA is very much a public process that takes place in the context of the community of St. Genevieve. The ceremonies or rites that we celebrate usually take place at the Sunday liturgies, when our community comes together to worship. In summary, the OCIA is a faith journey. Each of us has a unique path for our faith development. Therefore, there is no obligation on the part of anyone to "join the church." We stand ready to assist you in reflecting upon whether God is calling you at this time to follow him as a member of the Catholic Church.

RCIA is for adults from 18 years of age who are unbaptized, from other faith traditions and for those who are baptized but have not received the sacraments of the Eucharist (First Communion) and Confirmation. St. Genevieve OCIA classes are offered in English and Spanish. We continue to hold hybrid classes with in person and online classes.

Did you Know?

Why it is important not to dismiss a child's everyday emotions?

A key part of creating a safe environment is being a trusted adult to the children in your care. Children who have been abused are more likely to confide in a trusted adult whom they know will listen to and believe them. For this reason, it is important to affirm a child's everyday emotions, including anger or fear. Far too often, adults tell children "you're fine," or "get over it," in response to what a child perceives as a true emotional problem, but an adult may see as an inconvenience or insignificant event. Affirming a child's feelings while still helping them work through their issue productively will help create a bond of trust. Una parte clave de la creación de un entorno seguro es ser un adulto de confianza para los niños bajo su cuidado. Por esta razón, es importante afirmar las emociones cotidianas de un niño, incluido el enojo o el miedo. Con demasiada frecuencia, los les dicen a los niños “estarás bien” o “supéralo”, es respuesta a lo que un niño percibe como un verdadero problema emocional, pero un adulto puede verlo como un inconveniente o un evento insignificante. Afirmando los sentimientos de un niño y al mismo tiempo ayudarlo a resolver su problema de manera productiva ayudará a crear un vínculo de confianza.
