

A NOTE FROM FR. STEVE

OLP

Dear Parishioners,

I want to let you know about the work being done in church on the tile floor, as you will be seeing areas of repair in the coming weeks. The floor was installed during the major renovation of the church in late 1990's. Over the last two years, and increasing within the last year, we have been noticing cracks developing in the tile and the loosening of tile in some areas. We asked Henninger's Church Goods Company to look into the problem, and they asked several tile companies to take a look and suggest a solution. Unfortunately what was discovered is that in several areas the tile has come loose from the cement below, causing it to move and crack under foot pressure. Also there are areas where there is cracking of the cement below and corresponding cracking of the tile above that. The solution is to remove the broken tiles, apply a repair epoxy to the cement below, then glue down a material that the tile is adhered to. This will allow the cement below to move, but keep the tile above secure.

Although we desired to match the color of the tile exactly, this is not possible as the exact tile that we have is no longer manufactured. We are using a tile that is as close as possible to the original, but is slightly lighter. This will darken over time, but the difference will still be noticeable. Repair will take place in the aisle areas first, and then under the pews during the summer months. Please be cautious as you walk about the church, especially in areas where you notice caution tape on the floor. This indicates an area that has been newly repaired, and may still not be grouted. The tile company is working around our Mass and adoration schedule so this will take some time, but we hope to be finished within a few weeks!

For those of you who light candles at our shrines of Mary, Joseph, and the Divine Mercy, you will notice in the coming days that the size of the candles has been reduced. We are doing this because for the last year I have received increasing complaints from parishioners that there are never any candles available for them to light on the weekends. The old candles burned for 7 days. Thus there was a long time between candle change outs. We will be moving to 5 day candles to help with this concern. Hopefully this will result in more candles being available to light on the weekends. The price per candle will remain \$3.00 as we have not had an increase in the price for over 15 years, and the cost to us from A. I. Root has increased in that time. What little we do make on the price per candle does go to offset the cost of our hosts, wine, and altar candles that we use for Mass! Please be reminded of Candle Etiquette: Lighted Candles should never be removed from their holders and placed on the floor to make room for new candles. New candles should never be lit and placed on the floor. All of this has been happening on a regular basis, and is a fire hazard! Thanks for your understanding!


RESCHEDULED: UNBOUND CONFERENCE

RAHAB MINOR MENTORING PROGRAM

Minor Mentoring is committed to providing a transformational relationship to the mentees that we serve where youth can become healed and restored. A Transformational Relationship is a relationship that focuses more on the message, rather that the task. Through trauma-informed mentoring, consistency, prayer, and acceptance without expectations, youth become empowered and confident. This confidence and empowerment allow the youth to view themselves as worthy and valuable, this transformational relationship is one of the primary interventions in sex trafficking. RAHAB's Minor Mentoring programs pair a mentor with a minor survivor of human trafficking. We hope for this relationship to be an opportunity to demonstrate the love of Jesus to your mentee. Your role is to be a positive support in her life that she can trust and turn to in times of need. This relationship will develop through activities that create a space for her to learn new skills that she may have which would build self-worth and value, understand what healthy relationships look like, and grow in healing by being loved unconditionally.

What mentoring looks like: Minimum one year commitment (though we hope that you would maintain a friend-ship past that time); Plan to meet once a week for 2-3 hours; Interested persons must go through a process to determine eligibility; Volunteers are paired with a specific youth and the goal is to build a transformational relationship with the mentee

Minor Mentoring Center – Selah's Place" Selah's Place serves as a safe and fun environment for girls to come and find rest and a judgement-free space during the week. Activities available at Selah's Place include crafts, games, a clothing closet, and different weekly activities. Volunteers are needed between the hours of 2pm-6 pm during the school year and 1 pm- 5 pm during the summer.




