

Dear Parishioners,

If you haven't had a chance to check out our Church of the Resurrection Livestream in the past couple of weeks, I encourage you to do so. Whether it's for our Music in a Sacred Space concert with ART Trio from this past Monday evening, a weekend liturgy, a funeral or a prayer service, like our Lenten Taizé prayer around the cross coming up on Monday, March 7th. Whenever you may tune in, you'll notice that we have been able to begin upgrades to the audio and also added a second PTZ (pan/tilt/zoom) camera which is located above the ambulatory in the area between the Baptismal font and the work sacristy.

While we are SO grateful for the slow but steady return of our community to worship and fellowship in person, we are also mindful of the really gift that this newfound understanding and use of technology can be for our community and for many around the country and around the world who are able to join us via Livestream and to whom we are able to share the Mission of our parish as we proclaim the Good News and build the Kingdom of God.

Looking ahead, I would like to ask ANYONE who may be interested in training to become a livestream camera operator (*high schoolers to adults*) to see me after Mass, or send me an email jtragon@churchofresurrection.org.

In the coming weeks we will be adding even more features, including overlays that give the Scripture citation and display certain text to the Universal Prayer or hymn lyrics. The possibilities are endless and I'm excited to continue to learn and to grow our use of technology in service of our community.

I, of course, would be remiss if I didn't extend our gratitude to ALL of you who have SO generously in our Giving Tuesday campaign that is allowing us to make all these changes and upgrades possible. We raised over \$13,000 in that 24 hour period and on behalf of the entire staff and all those whom our livestream reaches, I offer our heartfelt THANK YOU! I am always so blown away by the remarkable generosity of our Resurrection community.

As we turn the corner and set our eyes on Lent, Holy Week and Easter, I look forward to more and more of us coming together to lift our hearts and voices in worship. I also look forward to making our livestream liturgy and prayer experiences even more engaging and uplifting to those who are unable to be with us in person.




