## **Dark Matrix Soil Breccia 3.50 g, 1.9 x 1.5 x 1.0 cm**

## INTRODUCTION

Sample 78565 is a very friable soil breccia that was collected as part of a large rake sample at Station 8 (Fig. 1).

## **PETROGRAPHY**

Butler (1973) described 78565 as friable, dark grey, matrix-rich breccia with clasts generally of millimeter size composing less than 5%. Small clasts are generally white plagio-

clase, mare basalt, black aphanite, and orange glass.

This sample has not been studied. It appears to be similar to 78555 (Keil et al., 1974).
