I am writing to urge good faith negotiations such that a collective bargaining agreement can be reached which provides fair compensation, a living wage and benefits for Envoy agents, as well as an opportunity for American Airlines to reach the goals set by their Board and shareholders.

Envoy Agents represented by CWA can and do serve as an economic backbone for communities across the country.
