Francis Yuen (AB 75'), was a former Chief Executive of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (1988-1991). Currently vice chair (nonexecutive) of Pacific Century Regional Developments Limited, an independent nonexecutive director of the Agricultural Bank of China, he was previously the vice chair of the Pacific Century Group, a vice chair of PCCW Limited and executive chairman of Pacific Century Insurance Holdings Limited. He is a founding member of the Chicago Economics Society, a global University of Chicago alumni group devoted to economics. A University trustee since 1999, Francis Yuen is also a trustee of Fudan University in Shanghai.

Francis and Rose Yuen were instrumental in bringing Ngô Bao Châu to the University in 2010, shortly before he won the Fields Medal, by establishing the Francis and Rose Yuen Distinguished Service Professorship in Mathematics. They have also supported scholarships and fellowships for international and graduate students, and the University's Centers in Beijing, Hong Kong, and Paris. They established the Anthony C. Yu Dissertation Fellowship, which supports the work of a student in comparative religion and literature in the Divinity School or the Division of the Humanities, in memory of Yu, PhD'69, the Carl Darling Buck Distinguished Service Professor Emeritus in the Humanities and the Divinity School.
