PRESIDENT'S REPORT

It has been my pleasure to have served on your Board for three years. As your president for 1984 - 1985, it has indeed been a full and interesting year, and I can think of no way I would rather choose to fulfill my civic responsibilities.

The year's activities began in September with a reception honoring Mr. Patrick O'Brien, the new Director of Libraries. A DGS project was adopted in the fall to purchase Union Service Records for the border states. Many donations were made during the year, and the Society designated \$1000 toward this project. A second project was announced in the spring -- Dallas County Deed Records 1846 - ca 1900 (130 rolls) with Grantee/Grantor Indexes 1846 - 1913 (ten rolls). This project was completed with \$2000 designated by the Society. Mr. O'Brien accepted these gifts in behalf of the Library at the Annual Meeting, as well as a \$100 memorial in honor of deceased DGS members.

Two workshops were sponsored by the Society, both of which were well-received. The first was an all-day Beginners' Workshop held in November, 1984, with DGS Board Members presenting the various subjects. Our Annual Spring Workshop in April, 1985, featured Lloyd DeWitt Bockstruck, who spoke to a "sold-out" house on "Research in Virginia and the Carolinas." The consensus was that Lloyd's topic was well chosen and his presentation outstanding.

Early in the year a DGS committee redesigned Census Charts and Group Sheets bearing the familiar DGS Logo, which the Society published and made available to members and library patrons at nominal cost.

Members of our Society enjoyed special treats beginning in January, 1985, when in recognition of the approaching Texas Sesquicentennial, 1836 - 1986, each month a Texas vignette was presented by one of our own authorities on Texas, each of which was an inspiration to both native Texans and "Texans-by-choice."

By May, 1985, the Society had a membership of 551, with 90 on our Exchange List. Over 10,000 mailings (e.g., quarterlies, newsletters, dues notices, etc.) were sent out during the year.

The Dallas Quarterly included 104 pages of acquisitions, 35 pages of Dallas County Deed Records, and 40 pages of Commissioners' Court Minutes.

Financial Records of DGS for 1984-85 have been inspected by our Audit Committee and all accounts found to be correct and in order.

Adrienne Bird Jamieson was awarded a life membership for her outstanding contributions to our Society at our Annual Meeting in May. Adrienne has served as President, Executive Vice-President, and as the Director in charge of mailings for five years. She has also served on all the committees for DGS publications and on the Cemetery Inventory and book publication since its inception. Now she has graciously agreed to serve as your President for the coming year. Her continuing dedicated service certainly warrants such special commendation.

I am grateful to the membership, the DGS Board, and the staff of the genealogical section of the library for their support and assistance, and thank each for helping to make this a successful year.

EDITOR'S HALF-PAGE

Also, I would like to present a proposal to you which will either prove that I am indeed a "glutton for punishment," or that I may be "just a bit tetchy"! My proposal is as follows:

A few years ago, DGS published in its quarterly the Ancestor Charts of a number of its members. Since that time we have received other members' charts for an anticipated future publication of "ANCESTOR CHARTS II." This is not something that we can prepare and publish overnight. It will take a year -- or perhaps even two years, to assemble and prepare the materials. If you have submitted a chart or charts that have not been published and you feel that revision is necessary, send in your revised chart, and we will see that it is used rather than the earlier chart. If you have not sent in your ancestor charts, and wish to do so, if we are to go ahead with such project, we should have your charts within the next few months, if possible. If you wish to see how these will be published, you may refer to our earlier publication of Ancestor Charts which is on file at the Dallas Public Library (please refer to inside back cover if you wish to purchase a copy). Although publication would be in the compressed chart form, as mentioned, charts should be submitted on the 5-generation charts. Is there sufficient interest in such a future publication that we should include it in our planning? A number of those charts submitted earlier are from persons no longer members of our society. While the information they have submitted would still be just as valuable, if we are unable today to contact those persons at the addresses given, we will have to determine whether their charts should be used. What is your wish?

THOMAS of Dallas County, Texas, for \$250, 250 acres, East bank of White Rock Creek at Morris FERRIS's south corner, lower boundary of Survey No. 17 of 1280 acres. Deed signed 27 Oct 1849, acknowledged 9 Feb 1850 by Chas H. DURGIN, NPDC, recorded 13 Feb 1850 by A. HARWOOD, DCC.

p. 251 & 252: James J. and Mary E. MOONEYHAM of Dallas County, Texas, convey by Title Bond to Benjamin MERRELL, of Dallas County, Texas, for \$1,050 of which \$520 was paid, 640 acres of land in Dallas Co., being Section One of Township One North of First Baseline and Range One West of First Principal Meridian of surveys of W. 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THE HUGUENOTS

"The Connecticut Nutmegger," quarterly publication of the Connecticut Society of Genealogists, Inc., carries in its June, 1985 issue (Vol. No. 18, No. 1), a very interesting and informative article by Mrs. Andrew Ross on this subject, which explains that although the "Huguenots" name given to French Protestants has been supposed to come from the German word "Eidgenossen," i.e., Confederate, this is no longer accepted as correct by most students of history. Mrs. Ross writes, "A more likely explanation of the word is that given as early as the 16th century by the learned scholar, Stephanus (Henri Estienne), who regarded it as a nickname which originated in the ancient French Province of Touraine, based on a medieval romance about a certain King Hugo, or Huguet, a wicked and cruel King, whose ghost was supposed to run about in the streets of the city of Tours at night, a truly diabolical apparition. One of the gates of the city was named after this King. Since Protestants met in the neighborhood, they were given the nickname of "Huguenot," which soon became general....during colonial days more than 15,000 French Huguenots emigrated to America. The effect these dedicated people had in molding American Civil laws and Culture was tremendous. Many of the "Dutch" who settled new Amsterdam and Pennsylvania were French Huguenots. Governor Peter Minuit was a Huguenot. So was Jacques Tiphaine, forefather of the famous Tiffany jewelers of New York. France gave the United States the Statue of Liberty in New York Harbor, but how many know that the Huguenot Bedloe once used the land for grazing his cattle?....

Editor's Note: Dallas County Marriages, 1846 - 1877, Books "A" through "E," published by DGS in 1978, are available for purchase from the Society (See inside back cover). Publication of continuing marriage records was commenced in June, 1979; but convinced of the need to recheck accuracy in transcription from Courthouse Records, Mrs. Clytes W. Cullar, then our Research Director, with the help of Adrienne Jamieson, who is now our resident, undertook this task. In this issue we resume publication of Dallas County Marriages, including in this issue only the years 1877 and 1878 (as well as as any earlier listings contained in Book "F") which, with the assistance of our member, Mrs. Pat Hatcher, have been alphabetized in two sections, first by the names of the grooms, and then by the names of the brides. In succeeding months, as space allows, we will publish additional records from Marriage Books "F" through "H," alphabetized in like manner. These records were prepared by one team of our members working at the Courthouse, checked and rechecked by another team, and now typed and alphabetized by another team. In time to come, if it is deemed practical and feasible, these alphabetized lists may be combined to publish a second book of Dallas County Marriages.

Your editor has already recommended this book to several individuals feeling that it could help solve some of their puzzles regarding European research. It claims to give the most comprehensive coverage yet published of genealogical sources in Europe to meet the needs of people of European descent who are starting to trace their ancestors. This book can offer invaluable assistance to the searcher for his European roots, particularly in some countries in which it has been difficult to search.

MASTER CARD and VISA orders, as well as personal checks/money orders accepted. This book is reprinted to mark the Third Centenary of the Revocation of the Edict of Nantes. Although originally published 100 years ago Library Journal said about it in 1967, "Since much of the work came from unpublished documents and has never been superseded, this is needed in large and medium public libraries and in college and university libraries." J. M. Larned, one of the most distinguished historians of this century, termed Professor Baird's achievement, "Indispensable to the student of American history." For millions of Americans of mixed Huguenot ancestry, there is still no higher authority in print than Charles Baird.

This collection of Georgia Bible records contains an itemized list of the births, marriages, and deaths found in approximately 1,000 family Bibles, including those of some of Georgia's first settlers and prominent figures, as well as of ordinary individuals, some of whom migrated to or from other states. The collection spans a period stretching from the early 1700s to the 1900s, which have been compiled over a period of twenty years. It is nicely printed, indexed for easy use, and should be an excellent research tool. This collection is highly recommended for the use of our members and readers.
