BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

"Act of 1908".

1.—In this Act "the Act of 1908" means the Punishment of Incest 10 Act, 1908.

2.—(1) Subject to section 3 of this Act, notwithstanding section 5 of the Act of 1908, in any proceedings under that Act, the verdict or decision, and the sentence (if any), concerned shall be announced in public but anything likely to lead members of the public to identify a 15 person involved in the proceedings shall not be otherwise published.
