


1. *LIBINIA MEXICANA*. (PAGE 328.) 2. *LEPTECES ORNATUS*. (PAGE 292)



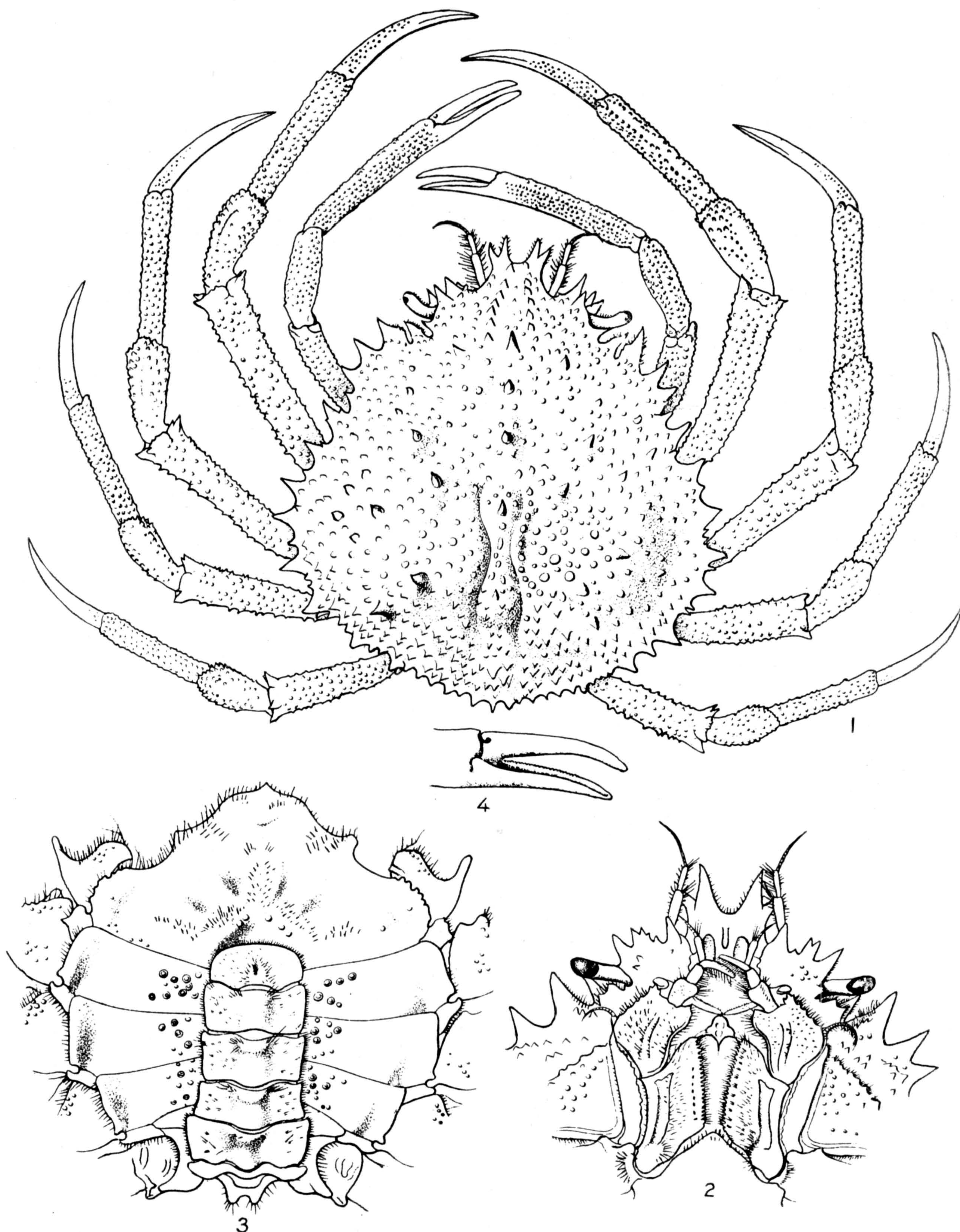

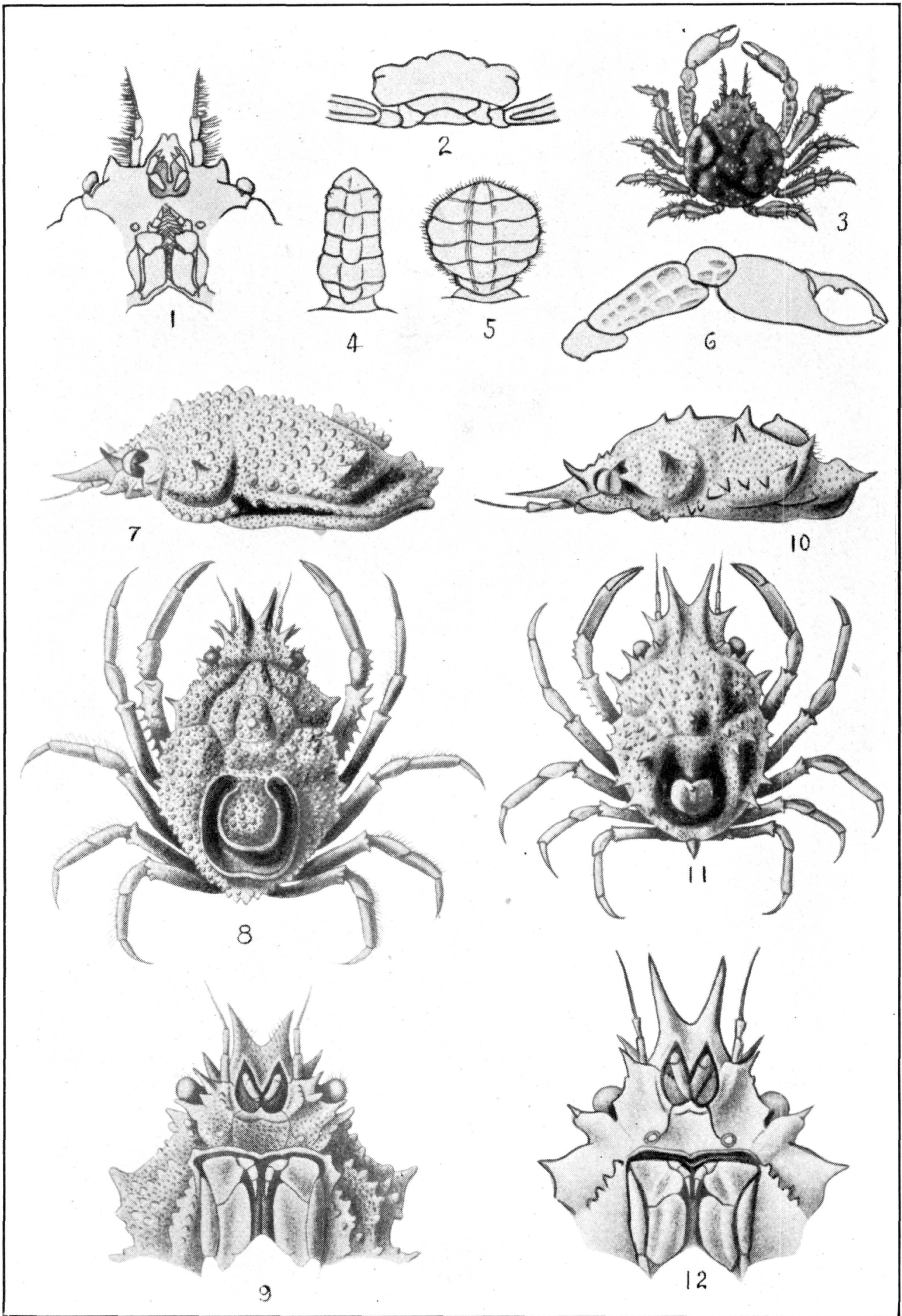

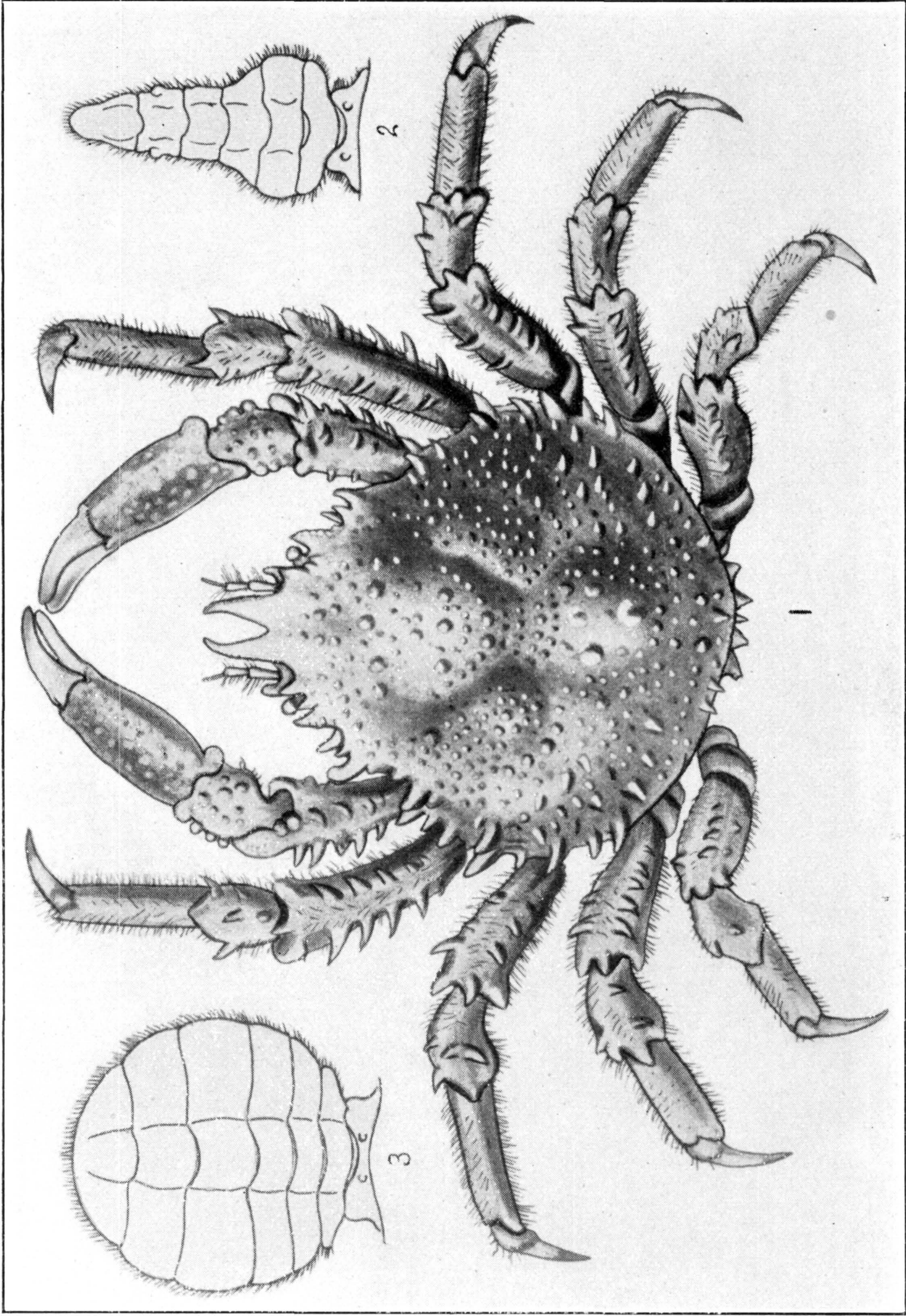

1. PITHO MIRABILIS. (PAGE 366.) 2. LEPTOPISA SETIROSTRIS. (PAGE 375)

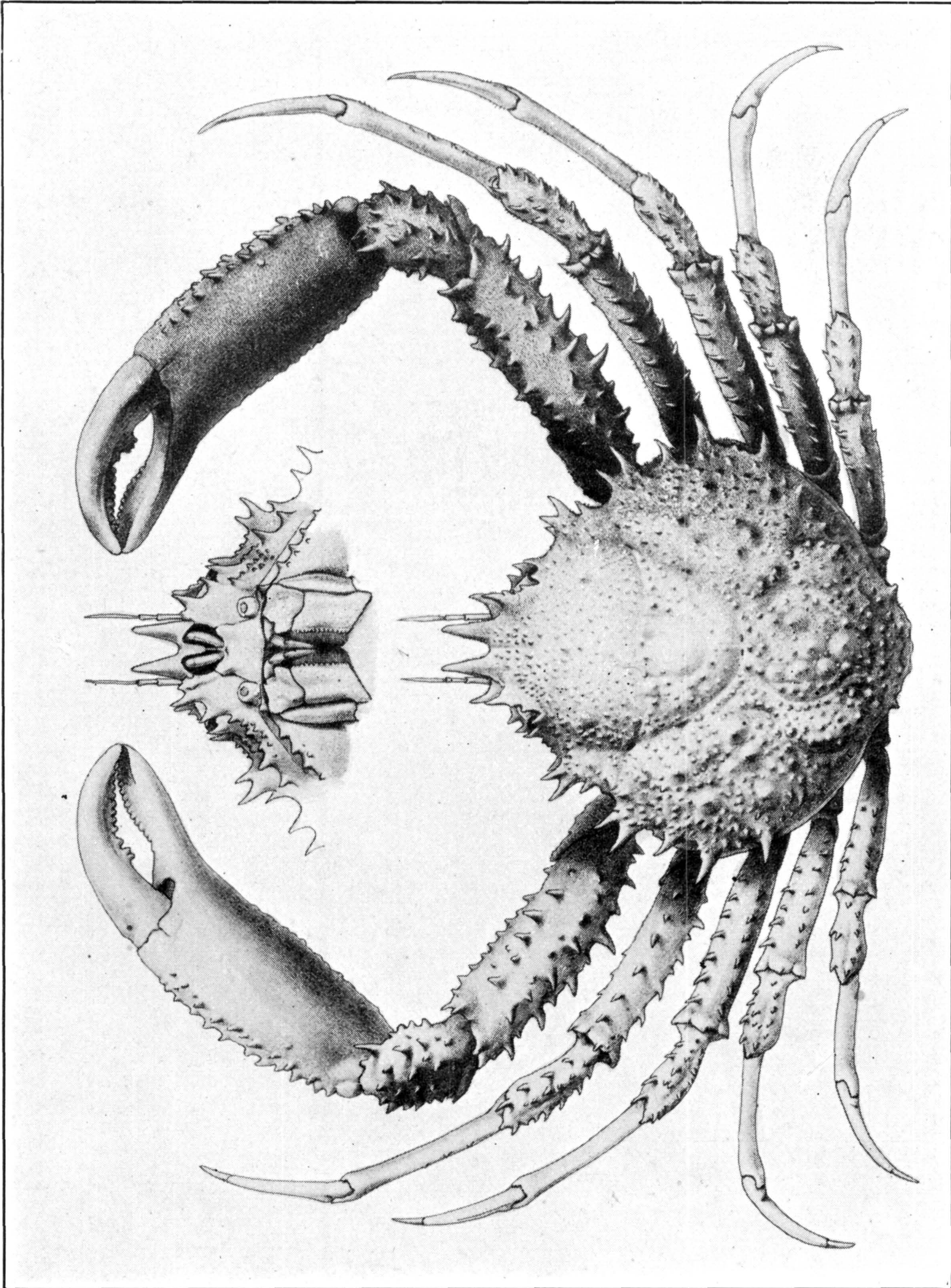


1. ANAPTYCHUS CORNUTUS. (PAGE 378.) 2-5. PICROCEROIDES TUBULARIS. (PAGE 354)



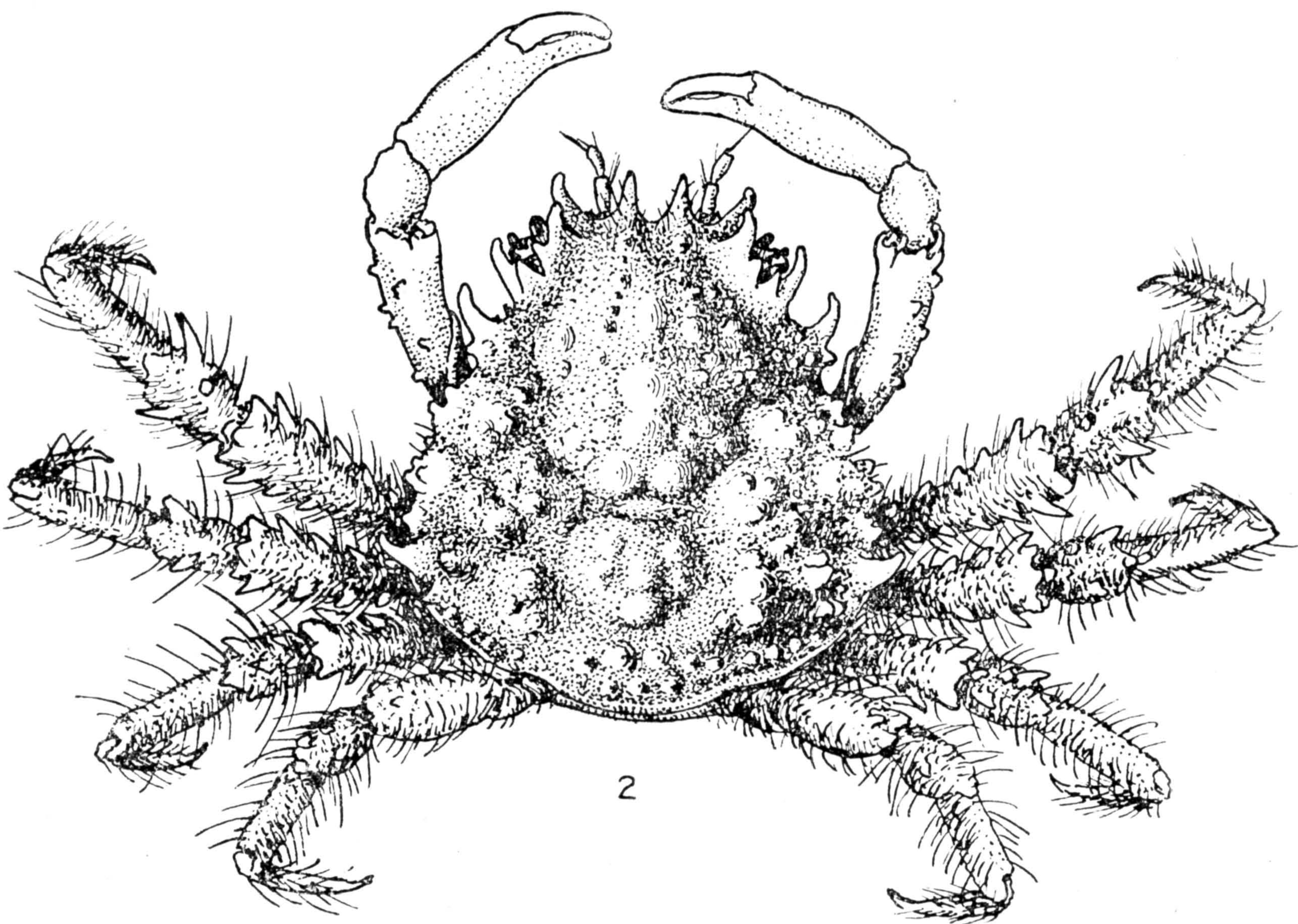
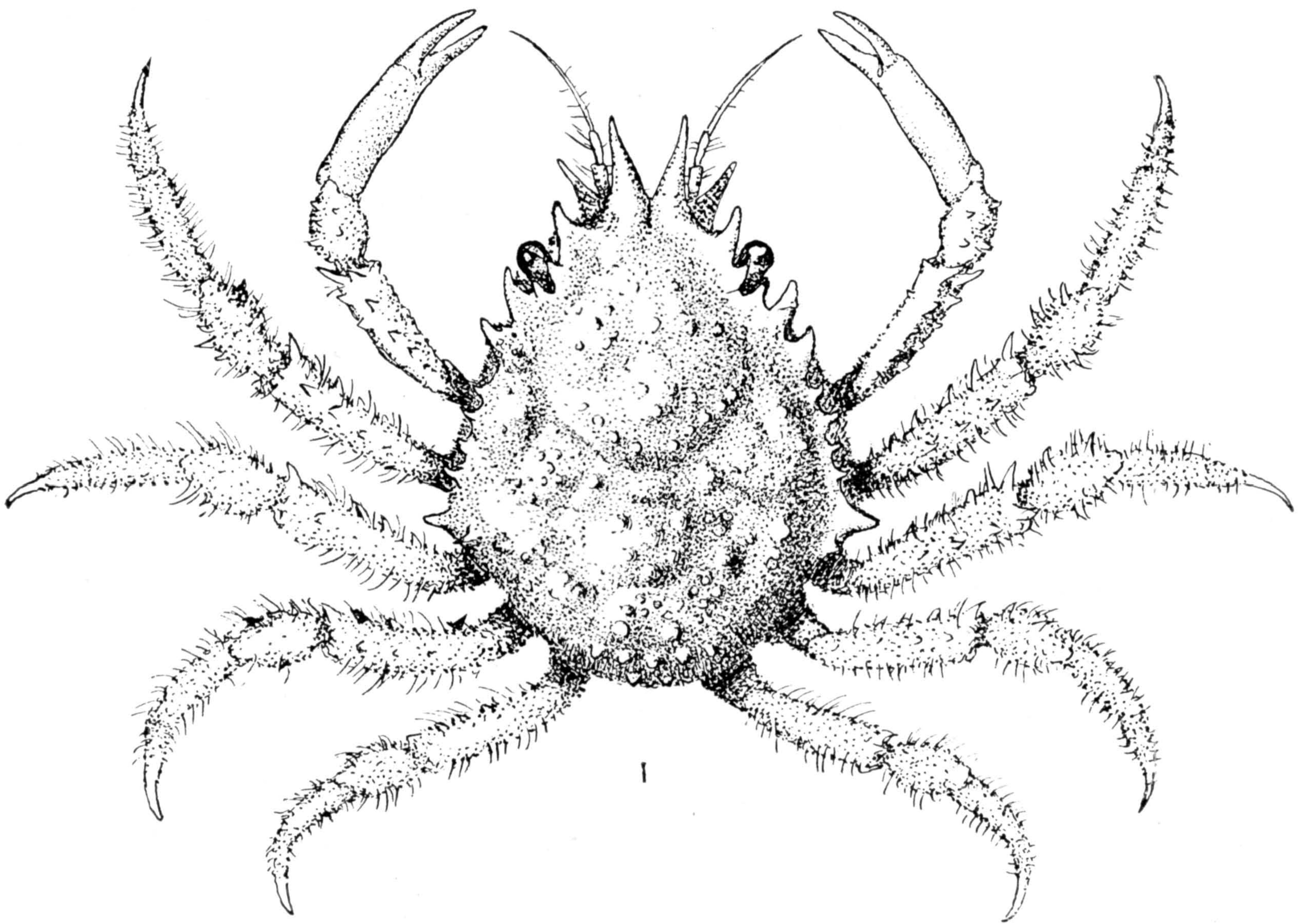

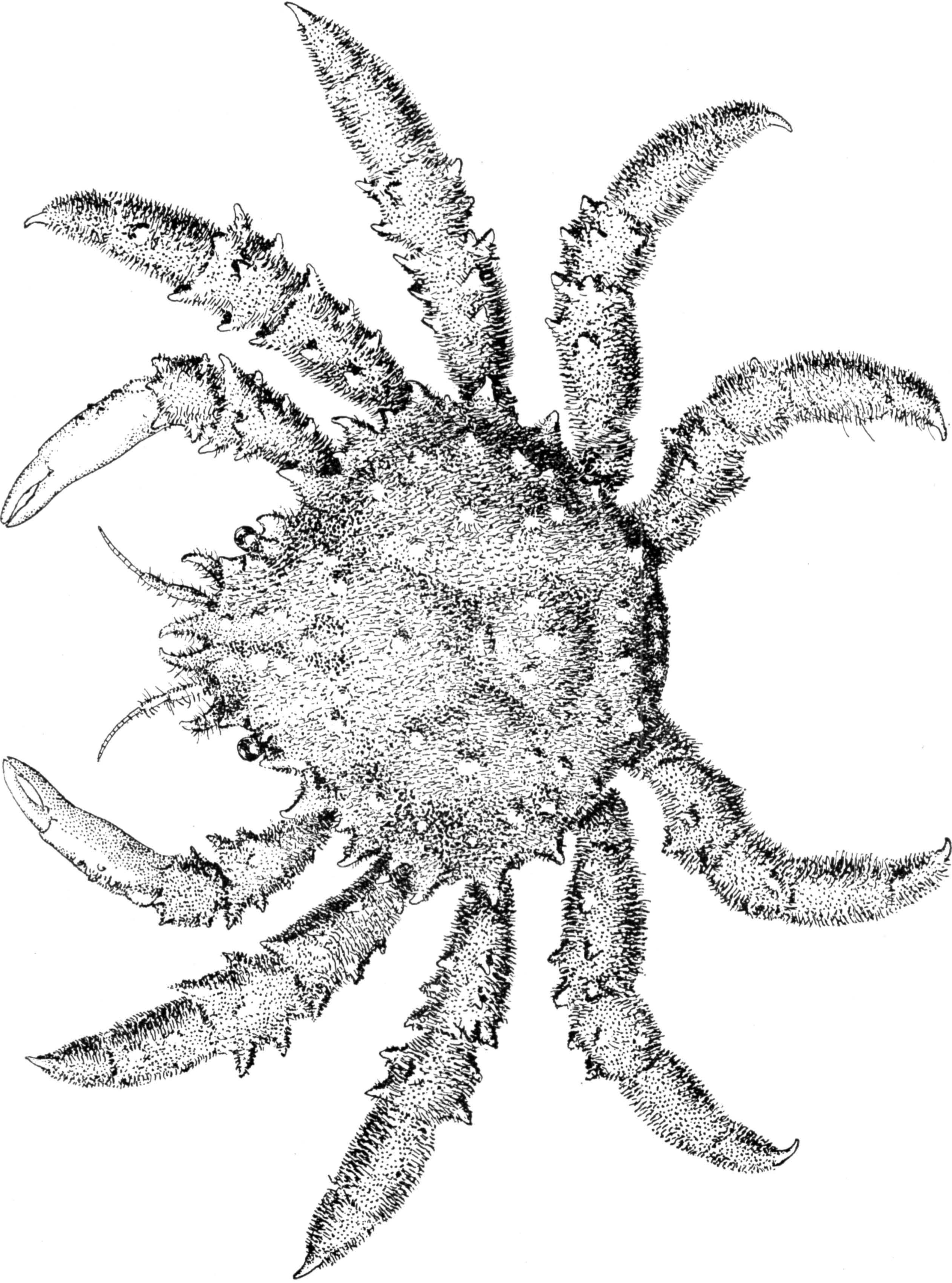
