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



The §362 stay is hereby modified as to HOUSEHOLD AUTOMOTIVE FINANCE CORP., and the 1997 Nissan with the 1997 Nissan released to HOUSEHOLD AUTOMOTIVE FINANCE CORP., for liquidation. HOUSEHOLD AUTOMOTIVE FINANCE CORP., is allowed 120 days from entry of the order confirming the plan to liquidate the 1997 Nissan and file a documented deficiency claim or to release the lien against the title and forward the title to the Chapter 13 office to participate as an unsecured general claimant. Any timely filed deficiency shall be scheduled as an unsecured general claim due to no evidence of a perfected lien against other personal property of the estate. Failure of HOUSEHOLD AUTOMOTIVE FINANCE CORP., to either liquidate the 1997 Nissan and file a documented deficiency claim within said time or release the lien against the title and forward the title to the Chapter 13 office within said time shall result in the release of the 1997 Nissan being in full satisfaction of the debtors' liability under the contract. The warranty coverage is cancelled under the contract and any deficiency claim required to reflect cancellation of said item and rebate to the account.

The debtors hereby assume the business lease with GARY KEPLEY on property located at 2512 Randleman Road, Greensboro, North Carolina, and shall continue direct payments.

COUNTRYWIDE HOME LOANS, INC., is secured by a deed of trust against real estate and the regular monthly payment and arrearage shall be paid through the disbursements by the Trustee with the debtors resuming direct payments upon completion of plan payments. A regular monthly payment shall be disbursed on the continuing long term debt effective with the payment for March 2003 forward. The arrearage on the account through February 2003 shall be paid with no interest at the rate of \$450.00 per month, increasing to \$500.00 per month in April 2004, increasing to all funds available in April 2005. COUNTRYWIDE HOME LOANS, INC., has filed an arrearage claim through February 2003 of \$37,909.70. COUNTRYWIDE HOME LOANS, INC., should amend the claim on record for arrearage not later than April 30, 2003, if the figure indicated herein is incorrect for arrearage through February 2003.

CITIFINANCIAL, INC., is secured by a deed of trust against real estate. The claim filed in the amount of \$11,555.62 shall be paid in full over the life of the plan at the rate of \$260.00 per month, increasing to all funds available in May 2005, with interest at the contract rate.

5. The Debtors will pay THE GREATER OF the amount necessary to pay all allowed costs of administration, priority and secured claims in full, with the exception of continuing long term debts, and 25% to allowed unsecured general claims OR 54 monthly plan payments with the plan to be reviewed periodically for plan payment adjustments;

6. Payments to priority, secured and specially classified creditors will be prorated according to the balance of their claims except where a specific monthly payment is indicated herein;

7. There will be no separate payment on arrearage claims unless indicated herein;

8. The Debtors will be responsible for payment of continuing long term nondischargeable debts after completion of plan payments;

9. The estimated return to unsecured creditors is 25%; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Court that (a) the plan complies with the provisions of Chapter 13, and with other applicable provisions of Title 11 of the United States Code; (b) any fee, charge, or amount required under Chapter 123 of Title 28 of the United States Code, or by the plan, to be paid before confirmation has been paid; (c) the plan has been proposed in good faith and not by any means forbidden by law; (d) the value, as of the effective date of the plan, of property to be distributed under the plan on account of each allowed unsecured claim is not less than the amount that would be paid on such claim if the estate of the Debtors were liquidated under Chapter 7 on such date; (e) with respect to each allowed claim provided for by the plan: (i) the holder of such claim has accepted the plan; or (ii) the plan provides that the holder of such claim retain the lien securing such claim and the value, as of the effective date of the plan, of property to be distributed under the plan on account of such claim is not less than the allowed amount of such claim or (iii) the Debtors surrenders the property securing such claim to such holder; (f) to the extent that the plan calls for payments for a period

8. The Debtors are required to segregate all money which has been withheld from employees or collected from third parties for payment of taxes as required by federal and state law. The Debtors are to deposit the collected funds, together with the Debtors share of payroll taxes, in a separate bank account immediately upon collection and is to pay the taxes when due.

9. The Debtors shall file with the Trustee by the tenth day of each month a report and summary of operations of the business during the preceding calendar month. This report must include an accounting of receipts and disbursements, debts incurred, credit extended, contractual obligations assumed, a profit and loss statement, the dates and amounts of all deposits and any other information required by the Trustee.

10. The Debtors shall maintain collision insurance on any vehicle on which there is a lien. If insurance is not maintained, the Debtors are ordered to store the vehicle as directed by the Trustee.

11. The employer of the Debtors shall deduct and remit funds from the wages, salary or commissions of the Debtors as directed by the Trustee.

12. Providing for a claim under this plan does not bar objections to the claim.

13. Notwithstanding any provision of the plan to the contrary, all property of the estate, as specified by 11 U.S.C. §§541 and 1306, shall continue to be property of the estate following confirmation.

14. The property serving as collateral for secured claims is valued at the amounts allowed herein with the exception of fully secured claims for which the value is deemed to be equal to or greater than the allowed secured claim. The property serving as collateral for secured claims is required by the Debtors for successful completion of the plan.

15. Notwithstanding the allowance of a claim as secured, all rights under Title 11 to avoid liens are reserved and confirmation of the plan is without res judicata effect as to any action to avoid a lien.

16. Any continuing long term debt claimant being paid through disbursements by the Trustee is required to report any change in the monthly payment amount to the Trustee within 30 days from the effective date of the change. Any continuing long term debt claimant being paid directly by the Debtors is required to report any change in the monthly payment amount to the Debtors within 30 days from the effective date of the change.

17. All insurance and warranty coverage on unsecured general claims is canceled and the claim must reflect cancellation and rebate to the account unless provided otherwise herein.

18. The Internal Revenue Service and the North Carolina Department of Revenue are authorized to offset any refund due the Debtors against any allowed secured or priority claim and to issue refunds directly to the Debtors unless otherwise ordered by this Court or instructed by the Trustee.

19. All creditors during the pendency of this case are restrained from commencing or continuing any civil action or attempting in any manner whatsoever to collect all or any part of a consumer debt proposed to be paid under this plan from any individual that is liable on such debt with the Debtors as endorser, guarantor or co-maker unless further ordered by the Court.

20. The Trustee is authorized to record on the public records such documents as the Trustee may deem advisable for the purpose of giving all persons notice of this case.

# MOTION TO COMPEL DEBTOR TO FILE TAX RETURNS OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE

The United States of America, by its counsel, the United States Attorney for the Middle District of North Carolina, respectfully moves the Bankruptcy Court for an order compelling debtor Mark Keith Robinson to furnish to the Internal Revenue Service individual income tax returns for the taxable years 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001, and 2002 or, in the alternative, for an order dismissing this case with prejudice. As grounds for this motion, the United States of America states the following:

1. By filing a voluntary Chapter 13 petition in this case, debtor Mark Keith Robinson has voluntarily submitted to the jurisdiction of this Court. In this proceeding, the debtor is obligated to proceed in good faith.

2. On January 21, 2003, the debtors filed a petition in bankruptcy under Chapter 13 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Internal Revenue Service filed a proof of claim on or about February 11, 2003, in the total amount of \$15,799.98. The amounts claimed for individual income taxes for the taxable years 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001, and 2002 were estimated because he did not file his federal income tax returns for those years.

3. All taxpayers, including debtors in bankruptcy, are required to file federal income tax returns if they meet minimum gross income requirements. I.R.C. § 6012.

4. Due to Mr. Robinson's failure to file federal individual income tax returns for those years, the Internal Revenue Service is unable to file an accurate proof of claim and to determine whether he is remaining current with respect to unpaid taxes. As a creditor, the Internal Revenue Service is materially prejudiced in this matter.

5. A party in interest may move for dismissal of a Chapter 13 case, for cause, including unreasonable delay by debtors that is prejudicial to creditors. 11 U.S.C. § 1307(c)(1). The failure to file federal individual income tax returns constitutes an unreasonable delay that is prejudicial to the rights of the Internal Revenue Service.

6. Should Mr. Robinson file the required federal income tax returns, which are subject to audit, in this matter, the Internal Revenue Service will be able to file an amended proof of claim reflecting the correct tax liability for each of the relevant years and to determine if he is remaining current with his post-petition taxes. Should the debtor Mark Keith Robinson refuse to file said

returns, he should be dismissed from this case in accordance with 11 U.S.C. § 1307(c)(1).

7. Further, the failure to file tax returns indicate a lack of good faith and warrants dismissal of the case for cause under Bankruptcy Code § 105 and § 349(a), such that the debtor should be barred from refiling another bankruptcy petition for a period of at least 180 days from entry of the dismissal order.

Wherefore, the United States of America, for cause, prays for an order compelling debtor to furnish the Internal Revenue Service federal income tax returns for each of the taxable years 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001, and 2002, or, in the alternative, for dismissal of him from this case with prejudice.


