## BORDEAUX

The finest wines of the Bordeaux region are those of the Médoc, Graves, Sauternes and Saint-Emilion districts. They are usually kept in the cask for three years and then bottled at the Château or in Bordeaux.

White wines of the first growth Graves are extremely delicate, have a light bouquet and much vigor. They are comparatively dry, with the exception of those which come from the Cérons and Podensac districts.

Sauternes are sweet, ranging from simple district growths to the inimitable Château d'Yquem, the finest of all naturally sweet wines and in a class by itself.

In 1855, the greatest growths of clarets were classified as to quality by an official committee and this classification still holds good. Most of the wines in this list are *mis en bouteilles au château*, or château-bottled, which simply means that the wine was bottled where it was made and by the people who made it.

## BURGUNDY

This ancient province of France boasts an equally ancient fame for its great wines, and in the opinion of many connoisseurs, they have no equal. Characterized by a full-bodied, rich flavor, fragrant bouquet and a deep ruby color, the red wines are highly prized and sought after by gourmets the world over. The white wines are dry, vigorous and acknowledged as the finest in France.

The great difficulty confronting the buyer of Burgundies is the bewildering array of wines bearing the same name, but having no resemblance to each other in quality. This is due to the fact that the vineyards of Burgundy are parcelled out among many owners, some of them growers, others traders, and not all of these make the wine which carries the name of their vineyard. Therefore in Burgundy, the important factor is the integrity of the grower and the dealer from whom the wine is obtained.

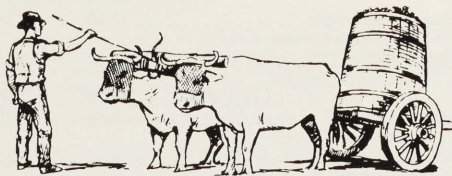

## GERMAN WINES

The beautiful valley of the Rhine produces unexcelled white wines, inimitable and famous since the days of antiquity. The valley is divided into three important wine-producing districts, the Rheingau, the Rheinhesse, and the Palatinate, a little to the south of the left bank. Wines of the Rheingau are the most celebrated, although the Rheinhesse produces some very noteworthy wines, and those of the Palatinate are distinctive with perhaps slightly more character.

The label of an especially fine wine will bear one of the following terms: "Auslese", a wine made from selected bunches of grapes; "Spätlese", a wine made from grapes gathered late in their period of ripening.

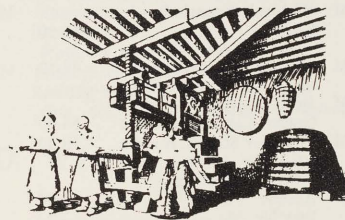

## VINS DIVERS

The white wines of the Loire Valley are celebrated for their fresh, fruity flavor with their most notable characteristic—a sweetness held in check. Vouvray and Saumur are two most agreeable table wines, particularly at luncheon, and are becoming increasingly popular in America. The sparkling varieties have a delicacy which makes them analogous to Champagne, though for most cultivated tastes, they are a trifle too sweet.

Wines from Alsace and Lorraine are noteworthy and are commonly grouped together as Alsatian wines. These generally resemble the Rhine wines of Germany and make pleasant dry luncheon wines, especially with seafood.

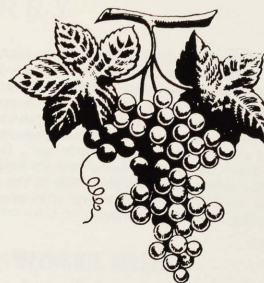

ROSE WINES

Rose wines have become increasingly popular on American tables. Their charming color, fruity flavor and pleasant bouquet are familiar to most of us. ## GIN

Gin is a distilled product of neutral grain spirits and produced, according to many varying "private formulas", after an infusion of several botanicals among which are juniper, angelica root, coriander, cardamon and cassia. The vapors of the heated grain spirit pass through the berry-head and retain the flavor of its contents when they are condensed. The type and proportion of these determine the flavor. "London" or "dry" gins are the kind most generally made and sold in America and are used in innumerable drinks where a gin base is essential.

A few "sweetened" or "Old Tom" gins are available and these are made after the English fashion by the addition of a small amount of simple syrup.

"Holland Gin" or "Geneva Gin", as it is very often called, is a Dutch product distilled at a relatively low proof and most always taken "neat" or with a dash of bitters added. Geneva gin should never be used in mixed drinks.

## AMERICAN WHISKEY

Much has been written about whiskey but it is always interesting to know that this popular distillation was unknown in America during early Colonial days. Mention of the word "whiskey" was not recorded until the Revolution and prior to that our ancestors drank rum which was made in New England. It is controversial whether the whiskey referred to had been brought from England by traders or distilled here with the "know how" of Scotch and Irish settlers.

**BONDED**—a guarantee that the whiskey is straight, is aged for a minimum of four years, bottled at 100 proof and has been aged, stored and bottled under Government supervision and in strict conformance with Government regulations. Pure alcohol is 200 proof, therefore, bonded whiskeys are half alcohol by volume. (Based on a temperature of 60 degrees Fahrenheit.)

**STRAIGHT**—any type whiskey made from a fermented mash of grain containing not less than 51% of rye, corn, etc., and which has been distilled at not more than 160 proof. It must be aged for at least two years in new charred oak casks and cannot contain or be blended with neutral spirits.

**BLEND OF STRAIGHTS**—these are merely what the term implies—two or more straight whiskeys, of either the same or various ages, blended together according to various formulas.

**SPIRIT BLEND**—a minimum of 20% straight whiskey by volume blended with neutral spirits, preferably grain, that have been distilled to 190 proof making them almost tasteless, colorless or "neutral" in character.
