PETITICN FROM THE SOMALI COMMUNIST PARTY CONCERNING SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

(Circulated in accordance with rule 85 and supplementary rule D of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council)

Note by the Secretariat: This communication was transmitted to the Secretary-General by the United Nations Advisory Council for the Trust Territory of Somaliland under Italian administration.

Mogadiscio, 20 August 1956

To: The United Nations Advisory Council in Somalia - Mogadiscio

The signatories of this statement are the applicants for the foundation of the new political party known as the SOMALI COMMUNIST PARTY. They submit this appeal to the United Nations Advisory Council to explain the following:

On 28 May 1956 we submitted to the District Commissioner of Mogadiscio an application for an authorization to set up the SOMALI COMMUNIST PARTY¹ and we forwarded also various requests to AFIS with a view to obtaining this authorization according to the law. Up to the present the undersigned have not received any reply. We beg the United Nations Advisory Council to inform us whether this Human Right has been annulled (that is to express myself and to found the party one chooses) in other words the freedom to form parties and associations. Finally we want to stress that up to the present our request was in accordance with the laws and regulations as shown by the attached copies of all the requests we have submitted to the various offices of AFIS. Now we beg you honestly to give careful consideration to the contents of the attached copies of the request submitted by us to AFIS. Therefore we confidently await for the just and supreme

decision of the United Nations Advisory Council for Somalia in Mogadiscio to advise AFIS in view of the fact that the Italian Government has accepted the responsibility of Administering Authority in this Territory.

And also in view of the fact that the Governments of Colombia, Egypt and the Philippines have accepted to aid and advise the Administering Authority in their capacity as members of the United Nations Advisory Council.

THE CHAIRMAN HUSSEN HAGI MOHÀMED

The signatories of this statement, the applicants for the foundation of the new political party named Somali Communist Party, deem it advisable to draw the attention of the above-mentioned authorities to their situation. Some months ago the signatories had the idea of founding in Somalia the above-mentioned party.

In accordance with the provisions in force they have presented their application for the foundation of the party to the District Commissioner Mr. Giama Ganni in order to obtain the authorization for opening the office of the party's A few weeks after they have been invited by the District Commissioner headquarters. to forward the programme of the new party which they subsequently did submit. Moreover, the Commissioner had requested them to submit the names of the leaders of the party and they forwarded a list of names indicating in writing the functions Moreover, the Commissioner had asked to visit the premises where of each member. the headquarters was to be established, which were visited. Subsequently, the Commissioner recently said that the question did not come within his competence but within that of the superior Authorities. Moreover, the Commissioner tried to convince the signatories to abandon this idea, adding that there are in Sozalia other political parties opposed to the formation of a communist party. Since individual and social freedom exists today throughout the world, the undersigned have the right to enjoy this freedom individually and socially. If it is true that there is an international law that nobody should be prevented, the undersigned desire to obtain from the Authorities the permission to found the new party.

In view of what is said above we beg the Authorities to request the District Commissioner to issue the prescribed permit.

We, the undersigned, residents of Mogadiscio, submit this request and make the following statement.

We submitted to the Secretary-General Franca a request for obtaining the authorization for founding the SOMALI COMMUNIST PARTY. After a few days we were instructed to call at the Internal Affairs Office. We called at the office of Mr. Gennaro who told us that our application was undergoing examination in the hands of Minister Mussa Bogor. Up to now we have not received any answer from you.

We want to point out that we intend to found the <u>Somali Communist Party</u> according to the International Constitutions, and according to the Trusteeship Agreements and the Administrator's Decree of 1951/52.

Moreover, we declare that our Somali Communist Party is not based on the BOLSHEVICK doctrine; nor are we miscreants, but we intend to constitute a <u>MOSLEM</u> Somali Communist Party.

We beg you earnestly to send us promptly the prescribed reply.
