Agastache 'Kudos Coral' | giant hyssop

Coral Pink blooms. Long blooming. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Ajuga 'Cordial Canary' | bugleweed

The world's FIRST-EVER GOLD foliated version of everyone's favorite Ajuga 'Chocolate Chip'! Brilliant gold foliage in the spring and summer is topped with cobalt-blue flowers on this vigorous groundcover. H: 4" W: 18" Photo reproduced with permission from Garden Solutions.



Ajuga 'Fancy Finch' | bugleweed

Ajuga 'Noble Nightingale' | bugleweed

Allium x 'Big Beauty' | ornamental onion  
\$15.50 | 1 Gallon

Wide grey-green foliage stands out early in the season on this robust growing allium. In July silvered pink buds open to soft pink 2.5" flower balls. This plant grows a bit taller to around 24" plus. Full sun, most any soil but wet. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.



Allium 'Chivette' | ornamental onion  
\$13.50 | 1 Gallon

A mostly sterile chive with edible foliage. Initially upright but then more relaxed reaching 12-15" + long. Easy to grow. Lavender purple flowers with a purple stripe down the middle of the pedal are edible and held on 12" + stems. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

Allium 'Windy City' | chive  
\$15.50 | 1 Gallon

Dark green glossy foliage reaches 15" tall and wide. Dark rose purple flower clusters begin to color in June and open in July on 18-20" stems. Full sun is best. Average well drained to dry soil. Very drought tolerant. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.



Allium schenoprasum 'Rising Star' | chive  
\$8 | 4.2 Inch

Extra dwarf pink chives reaching only 10-12" tall and wide, bloom in May. Fine grey, green, grassy foliage looks nice all season long. Easy to grow. Plants prefer full sun and average to well drained soil. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

Amsonia 'Halfway to Arkansas' | blue star  
\$13 | 1 Gallon

The foliage is a glossy deep green and uniformly needle-like. Pale blue flowers cluster in May. Rounded mounds top out just over 48" tall and wide. Yellow fall color comes a bit later than the other Amsonias. Full sun to light shade in well drained to moist soil. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.



Amsonia tabernaemontana 'Fontana' | blue star

\$13 | 1 Gallon

This red stem selection has slightly darker blue flower clusters at the end of May into June on 36" + plants. In August the red seedheads are showy too. Zone 4-9. Full sun to light shade. Well drained to dry soil. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.







Andropogon gerardii 'Blackhawks' | big bluestem  
\$15.50 | 1 Gallon

Deeper green foliage takes AWARD WINNER on a deep purple background in mid-summer deepening to dark purple and near black in some parts of the plant. Upright 5'+ tall plants will stand out in the landscape, especially with other tall grasses. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

Andropogon gerardii 'Dancing Wind' | big bluestem  
\$15.50 | 1 Gallon

Late summer color of green and red deepening to dark red in September and scarlet after frost. Heavy blooming plants begin in August with the entire plant becoming mostly red by the end of September. Grows to 6' tall and almost 2' wide. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.



Andropogon gerardii 'Red October' | big bluestem  
\$15.50 | 1 Gallon

Has a nice upright habit to 6'. Foliage emerges deep green usually having some red tips from spring on. Starting in August the red highlights increase and deepen to a rich burgundy red. After the first frost, the foliage turns a scarlet red. Red flowers begin in August. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

Andropogon gerardii 'Holy Smoke' | big bluestem  
\$15.50 | 1 Gallon

Silvered foliage has highlights nearly all season long from May-October. A blend of smoky purple and red add dimension over the silvered foliage. Substantial plants reach 6-7' tall. Full sun, most any soil. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.



Anemone 'Fantasy Cinderella' | anemone  
\$10 | 1 Quart

Compact, mounding plants with delicate pink flowers mid-late summer held above the foliage on slender stalks. H: 18" W: 18" Photo compliments of Ball Seed. Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

Aquilegia 'Biedermeier' | columbine

Densely clustered bouquets in mixed colors including pink, purple, light blue, and white. Excellent, dwarf rockery plants; good in containers. H: 12" W: 12-18" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

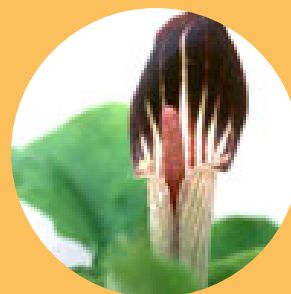

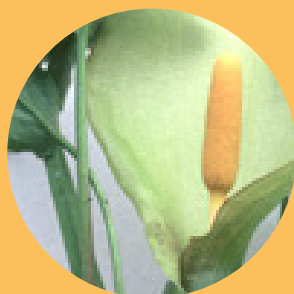
Artemisia ludoviciana 'Valerie Finnis' | wormwood

*Arum italicum* | Italian arum

\$5 | 2.5 Inch

Greenish-white spathes followed by clusters of vivid red-orange fruits giving early winter interest. Tuberos, stemless, with showy, arrow-shaped leaves. Goes dormant mid-June; resumes growth in early fall. H:6-10" W: 8-10" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

*Aruncus dioicus* 'Kneiffii' | goatsbeard

\$11 | 1 Quart

Creamy-white flowers. Finely cut foliage looks like a giant fern. Exciting selection. H: 2-3' W: 2' Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



*Aster* 'Arrested Development' | aster

\$13.50 | 1 Gallon

New for 2022 Bushy plants grow 12-15" tall in maturity. Deep lavender blue flowers begin in mid- September over greyed green foliage. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

*Astilbe chinensis* 'Pumila' | dwarf Chinese astilbe

RHS Award of Garde Merit. Masses of lavender-pink plumes in July-August. Outstanding, late summer color; fine ground cover for shade. Tolerant of dry soils. H: 10-12" W: 12" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

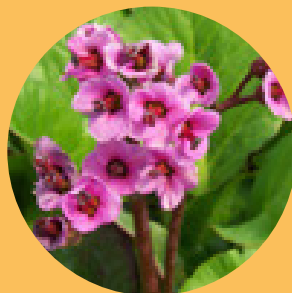


*Athyrium niponicum* 'Pictum' | Japanese painted fern

**Berginia cordifolia | heartleaf berginia**

**\$4 | 2.5 Inch**

Outstanding, tough, rich-looking ground cover with large, glossy, dark green leaves. Clusters of showy, rose-pink flowers in spring. H: 15" W: 15" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

**Bouteloua gracilis 'Honeycomb' | blue grama**

**\$13.50 | 1 Gallon**

Hardy and adaptable plants with good vigor. Upright wire like stems stand 30" plus and begin blooming with eyelash like flowers, holding yellow pollen, in June. The tan color lightens with age, holding on for a long time and into winter. Full sun, average to well-drained soil. Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



**Buddleia 'SMNBDB' | Pugster Pinker® butterfly bush**

**\$10.50 | 1 Quart**

Bigger, bolder blooms: that's why Pugster Pinker buddleia is replacing the original Pugster Pink. It boasts the same huge blooms on a compact, tidy plant, but with deeper, richer color. H: 2' W: 2-2.5' Bloom: Summer Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.

**Buddleja davidii 'Black Knight' | butterfly bush**

**\$9 | 1 Quart**

RHS Award of Garden Merit. Deep violet, almost black flowers from summer to fall. H: 6-8' W: 5' Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



**Callicarpa dichotoma | purple beautyberry**

**\$9 | 1 Quart**

Long, slender branches that arch to the ground. Clusters of lilac-violet fruits September-October. All bloom on current year's wood, can be cut down to 6" in late winter. H:3-5' W: 4-6" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

**Callicarpa 'NCCX2' | Pearl Glam® beauty berry**

**\$11 | 1 Quart**

This hybrid cultivar boasts dark purple foliage, white flowers, and bright purple-pink berries. Vigorous, upright plant offers a space-saving vertical habit and a unique look in the landscape or in containers. H: 4-5' W: 2-3' Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.

Calycanthus floridus 'SMNCAF' | Simply Scentsational® sweetshrub  
\$13 | 1 Quart  
The blooms of this North American native are a deep maroon and appear through late spring and summer. The blooms are powerfully fragrant, even when wilted. H: 6' W: 4-5' Bloom: Spring-Summer. Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.

Campanula carpatica 'Pearl Deep Blue' | bellflower  
\$3.50 | 2.5 Inch  
Great variety covered with sky-blue bells June-October. Choice rock garden plant! H:8" W: 12-24" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



Carex pennsylvanica 'Straw Hat' | sedge  
\$10 | 4.5 Inch  
This rhizomatous and vegetative form of penn sedge has a vigorous habit. It also has more substantial flower clusters than the species with reliable heavy spring bloom in April-May. It makes a good groundcover for dry shade. The bright green foliage reaches only 5-6". Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

Centaurea montana | bachelor's button  
\$3.50 | 2.5 Inch  
Large, spidery, violet-blue cornflower with reddish highlight in center. Flowers in June-July H: 24" W: 18" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



Clematis 'Gipsy Queen' | clematis

RHS Award of Garden Merit. Deep, rich plum-purple flowers. Extra vigorous grower. Long flowering season. PG3. H: 10-12' W: 3-4" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

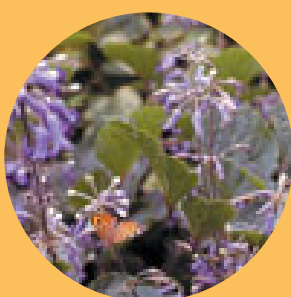


Clematis 'Sweet Summer Love' | clematis

Clematis x 'Zostiwa' | Still Waters™ clematis

Clematis heracleifolia | tube clematis

Clematis integrifolia 'Rouguchi' | solitary clematis

Clematis terniflora | sweet autumn clematis

Clethra alnifolia 'Caleb' | vanilla spice summer sweet  
\$11 | 1 Quart

A delightful, deer resistant native plant that attracts butterflies and hummingbirds. Dark green leaves set off the pure white summer flowers, which emit a sweet fragrance reminiscent of root beer. Individual florets are roughly double the size of other varieties. H: 3-6' W: 3-6' Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.



Convallaria majalis | Lily of the Valley  
\$4 | 2.5 Inch

RHS Award of Garden Merit. Fragrant, white, nodding bells in spring. Ground cover tolerant of dry shade. H: 6-8" W: 12" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

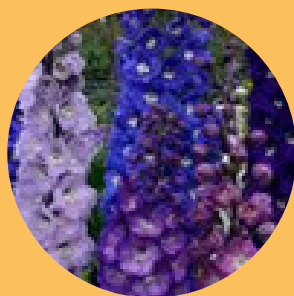
Cotinus coggygia 'MINCOJAU3' | Winecraft Gold® smokebush  
\$12 | 1 Quart

This improved gold smokebush is a more vigorous production plant with good burn resistance. Better branching creates a fuller shrub for better presentation in the container and the landscape. Green flowers in early summer age to the pink smoke-like puffs. H: 4-6' W: 4' Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.



Cotinus coggygia 'NCC01' | Winecraft Black® smokebush  
\$11 | 1 Quart

Starts season with rich purple foliage, becoming deeper until it's nearly black; fall then turns it brilliant orange. Early summer brings wispy red flowers that become the beautiful, hazy-violet "smoke." R H: 4-6' W: 4-6' Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.

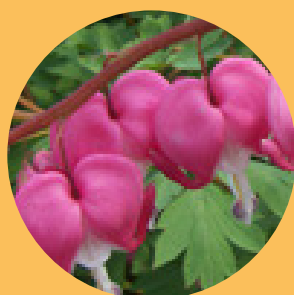


Delphinium Millennium Series 'Dwarf Stars' | larkspur  
\$4 | 2.5 Inch

This delphinium is heat and drought tolerant and a mixture of many colors that don't need staking. Flowers June-September. Excellent cut flower! H: 30" W: 12-18" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

Dianthus x 'Fuchsia Fire' | cheddar pink  
\$12.50 | 1 Gallon

This hybrid with 'Firewitch' has nearly the same color but the stems are half the size. Reaching 5-6" tall above silver and mat forming foliage the fragrant flowers begin in June, with some re-bloom sporadically throughout the season. Clean foliage is needlelike and silver and blue. Dicentra spectabilis | old fashioned bleeding heart

Favorite, with arching stems of large, pink hearts. Often summer dormant in hot climates. H: 2' W: 2' Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

Diervilla x 'G2X88544' | Kodiak® Orange diervilla

Eco-friendly alternative to burning bush! It pushes fall color to the limits with its transformation to glowing orange. New growth emerges russet, accompanied by yellow flowers in summer. This fast growing, vigorous North American native is unbothered by pests or diseases. H: 3-4' W: 3-4'. Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.



Diervilla x splendens | Kodiak® Fresh diervilla

*Dryopteris erythrosora* | autumn fern

RHS Award of Garden Merit. Showy, coppery-pink, new fronds continuously until fall; frost turns it a pleasing bronze. Attractive evergreen through winter if protected from drying winds. Mature leaves make excellent cut greens. H: 30" W: 18-30" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

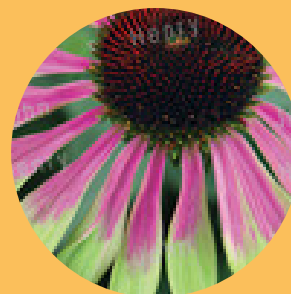


*Echinacea purpurea* | purple coneflower

\$11 | 1 Gallon  
Selected for the extra wide and long drooping pink petals and extra showy orange cones, this seed strain stands out at a distance, especially when compared to the new upright petaled forms. Full sun well drained soil. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

*Echinacea purpurea* 'Green Twister' | coneflower  
\$4 | 2.5 Inch

Green Twister is a lovely green colored Echinacea with a carmine red center. Makes a bright and cheery addition to the landscape. H: 3-4' W: 2-3" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



*Epimedium x versicolor* 'Sulphureum' | bishop's hat  
\$10 | 1 Quart

One of the toughest cultivars of epimedium available today for dry shade. Light yellow flowers in the spring on reddish tinged foliage that turns all green in the summer months. H: 12" W: 12-24" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

*Eragrostis spectabilis* | purple lovegrass

\$11 | 2.5 Inch

Soft bronze-red inflorescences are soft and subtle in the sunlight appearing in August. Light green foliage in summer turns to a bronzy-red in fall. Irresistible texture plant for the late summer garden. Tolerates sandy and poor soil. H: 18-24" W: 24-36" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

*Eryngium planum* | sea holly

\$4 | 2.5 Inch

Bright blue flowers from late June to September.

Outstanding in the garden for cuts and dried arrangements. H: 36" W: 12-18" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



*Eryngium yuccifolium* 'Prairie Moon' | rattlesnake master

\$14.50 | 1 Gallon

This short seed strain was selected for its shorter statured 3'+ stems compared to the species which grows to 5' and tends to flop. The foliage is also thinner and bluer. White flowers begin in June or July. In fall the seedheads turn brown and hold on into winter. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.



*Euonymus fortunei* 'Harlequin' | harlequin wintercreeper

\$3.50 | 2.5 Inch

Unusual ground cover. Dark green foliage mottled with cream. Needs partial shade. H: 18" W: 24" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



*Euonymus fortunei* 'Kewensis' | kewensis wintercreeper

\$3.50 | 2.5 Inch

Tiny, evergreen foliage on spreading, flat stems. Superb, small, delicate ground cover. H: 2-4" W: 24" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

Eupatorium x 'Polished Brass' | Joe-pye weed  
\$13.50 | 1 Gallon

In spring the foliage emerges chocolate red, a trait that comes from the seed parent, Eupatorium perfoliatum 'Milk and Cookies'. The difference is the leaves are glossy and the whole plant is larger, growing 4' plus on sturdy stems. If you want pollinators and butterflies, this is your plant! Eupatorium perfoliatum 'Blind Date' | Joe-pye weed

This native wetland species tolerates average soil. This NEW for 2022 selection has chocolate red foliage with milky white flowers in July on 3' stems. Full sun, moist to average soil. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.



Filipendula rubra 'Venusta' | Queen of the Prairie

2013 GreatPlants™ Perennial of the Year. RHS Award of Garden Merit. Very large, pink flower heads from summer until fall. Showy, vigorous plants. H: 4-6' W: 3' Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.

Fothergilla x intermedia 'Alice' | Legend of the Fall® bottlebrush  
\$8.50 | 1 Quart

Fothergilla has always been appreciated for its spectacular autumn color, but Legend of the Fall® fothergilla sets a new standard for the species with brilliant, glowing hues of orange, yellow, and red. Spring brings a crop of fragrant white flowers. H: 4--5' W: 4-5' Bloom: Spring Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.



Fothergilla x intermedia 'NCF17' | Legend of the Small® bottlebrush

It produces an abundance of bottle brush-like white flowers, has a well-branched mounded habit, and small bluish-green leaves that turn an attractive blend of yellow, orange, and red in autumn. H: 2-2.5' W: 2-4' Photo reproduced with permission from Spring Meadow Nursery.

Geranium pratense 'MixTape' | meadow geranium

Blue flowering plants in June are grown from seed which gives a wide range of foliage colors and plant sizes. From green to purple and some reddish-purple foliage and plants reaching 15-24" tall and wide. Full sun to light shade. Average soil. Geum 'Champagne' | avens

\$12.50 | 1 Gallon

Creamy white nodding to side facing flowers on substantial plants reaching 24" tall and wide sometimes taller. Vigorous plants. Rich moist soil is best. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.



Geum 'Cosmopolitan' | avens

Creamy petals flushed and edged with a rosy pink on semi double flowers that look like miniature roses, appear on 18" burgundy stems in May. Semi evergreen foliage on 10" x 12-15" clumps. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.







Geum 'Top Shelf Margarita' | avens  
\$12.50 | 1 Gallon

This clear and bright yellow is nearly semi-double and stands out against the deep green foliage. Upright habit of red stems 15-18" tall. Makes great presentation in pots. Reliable rebloom on almost half of the plants. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

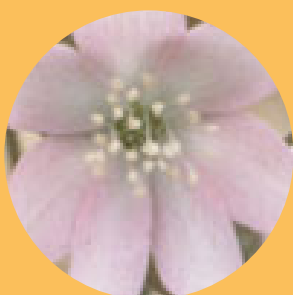
Geum 'Citronge' | avens  
\$12.50 | 1 Gallon

Creamy orange flowers emerge in May from red stem and buds on 18" stems. Wide folded petals overlap giving a nice full effect. Heavy blooming plants have some rebloom too. Full sun, moist rich soil. Photo reproduced with permission from Intrinsic.



Hepatica americana | liverleaf  
\$5.50 | 2.5 Inch

White, lavender, pink, or blue flowers in spring. Evergreen, heart-shaped leaves with three, pointed lobes. Shady, woodland native, usually dormant by June 1. H: 6" W: 12" Photo reproduced with permission from Bluebird Nursery.



Heptacodium miconioides 'SMNHMRF' | Temple of Bloom®  
Seven Son Flower

Herniaria glabra | rupturewort

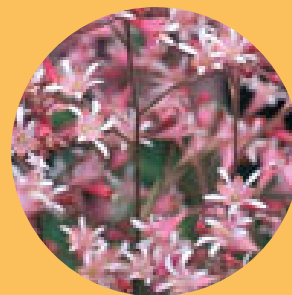
