



Private Duty Nursing

MO HealthNet private duty nurses (PDNs) are either registered nurses (RNs) or licensed practical nurses (LPNs) who provide long-term, comprehensive hourly nursing care to children (under the age of 21) who are receiving MO HealthNet (Medicaid) benefits. These patients often have complex medical conditions that require skilled nursing care on a daily basis.

Benefits

Relationships	Flexibility
PDNs form meaningful relationships with their patients and their families. They are able to see the impact of their care by working with patients over a long period of time, creating job satisfaction and a sense of accomplishment.	Compared to facility-based nurses, PDNs are less likely to work weekends and holidays and are not subject to a hospital's rigid shift schedule. PDNs may also be able to work part-time while furthering their education.
Autonomy	Job Security/High Demand
As the primary caregiver for a patient, PDNs enjoy more autonomy in decision-making and can use their knowledge to transform a patient's life. PDNs are serving the whole person, moving beyond just their basic medical needs.	Job security comes with a feeling of protection against things like layoffs, economic downfalls and other factors that can impact employment. The relationships PDNs build, and the high demand for their services provide safety and security.
