

An annotated checklist of the Trichoptera (Insecta) of British Columbia

This paper presents an annotated checklist of the caddisflies (Trichoptera) of British Columbia. A total of 248 species is reported from the Province, 43 for the first time. Three species previously recorded from British Columbia are excluded.

Introduction

Over the years, there have been a number of scattered records of Trichoptera from British Columbia. In 1952 the various records were brought together by Ross & Spencer (1952), while Schmid & Guppy (1952) also reported on the Trichoptera from southern Vancouver Island. Since then, there has been considerable accumulation of material and study. In particular, the fauna of the southeastern parts of British Columbia has been investigated by Nimmo (1971, 1974, 1977).

This paper presents an annotated checklist of the known caddisfly fauna of British Columbia. It records 248 species from the Province, 43 for the first time. Although a large number of new locality records are included, the distribution of most species is still very poorly known. There has been no concerted Trichoptera collecting in British Columbia as a whole, so the fauna must still be regarded as incompletely known. We estimate that probably about 75 per cent of the actual Trichoptera fauna is presented in the following list.

The arrangement of families, genera within families, and species within genera is alphabetical, and hence is consistent with the recent publication on the larvae of caddisflies by Wiggins (1977). For the most part, the nomenclature follows that in Fischer (1960-73), with appropriate modifications where more recent study has indicated that this is necessary.

Collection abbreviations used in the text are as follows: *CNC*, Canadian National Collection, Ottawa; *INHS*, Illinois Natural History Survey, Urbana; *ROM*, Royal Ontario Museum, Toronto; *UA*, University of Alberta, Edmonton; *UBC*, University of British Columbia, Vancouver. Full data on all material examined in the course of this study are on file in the Spencer Entomological Museum, Department of Zoology, University of British Columbia.

Species of Trichoptera Removed From the British Columbia List

Banksiola concatenata (Walker)

This species has been recorded from Quamichan L. (Anon 1907). However, this is an eastern species, with no other reports from the west. The earlier record thus is probably a misidentification.

Limnephilus fuscoradiatus Schmid

Schmid and Guppy (1952) report this from Forbidden Plateau. However, this is a manuscript name and is not valid. The specimens belong to the species now called *L. lopho* Ross, and were in fact also listed under this species in Schmid and Guppy (1952).

Platycentropus radiatus (Say)

Recorded from Wellington as *Limnephilus* (Anon 1906). Wiggins (1977) says that the three Nearctic species of *Platycentropus*, including *radiatus*, are confined to the eastern half of the continent. Hence, this record would appear to be an error, and so this species is excluded from the British Columbia list.
