

## **Brailler Repair**

Perkins Braillers may be repaired at APH or by volunteers coordinated by CISAM. Volunteers provide the labor for repairs and CISAM pays for parts if funds are available.

## Perkins Braillers under warranty:

- APH warrants braillers for twelve months from the date of shipment.
- Brailler misuse or abuse, such as dropping the brailler voids the warranty.
- If you are not sure of the warranty status, contact APH for information.

## Perkins Braillers not under warranty:

- Send braillers to Michael Tillis at the address below: 4492 Reymond Court Columbus, OH 43220
- Send in original packaging if available.
- Braillers can be sent FREE MATTER FOR THE BLIND; write in black marker on the upper right hand corner of the box and send by regular mail.
- Enclosé a detailed description of the problem. Indicate a return address to ship the repaired brailler.
- Braillers will be repaired and returned to the requested address.
- There is no cost to the school district.
- If the brailler cannot be repaired, a request can be made to CISAM for a replacement brailler for an eligible student.
- Mr. Tillis notifies CISAM if a brailler needs to be purged from the collection if unable to be repaired.
