

The Proven Winner brand has made an unfortunate decision to force all growers to sell their plants in branded containers in an attempt to drive the retail price up. This means two things: #1 the cost of their containers are more expensive and #2 their containers are larger thus taking more growing space and a higher portion of overhead cost. While we understand the philosophy of higher cost for perceived value, we at Garden Gate have always felt that we should offer a high quality product for the lowest price possible.

**How are we responding?** There are some varieties of Proven Winners that simply have no substitute. Such as, Petunia Vista Bubblegum! We <u>WILL</u> continue to carry these varieties. The price will be higher than in the past. However, to try to be fair to our customers <u>we will only be charging \$3.95</u> for our PW plants as opposed to the majority of retailers who will be selling them anywhere from \$5.00—\$6.50.
