

COVID-19 Infection & Isolation Order

COVID-19 (confirmed) & COVID-19 (rule out) are now available for clinicians to choose as infection options. The new isolation order for COVID-19 is also available for providers to order.

Try It Out:

Click the patient header to add infection COVID-19:

1. Click **Isolation** in the patient header to open up Infections and Isolation activity. Then type "covid-19" in the search bar, you will see two options as shown in the screenshot below. Choose the appropriate infection.
