

néos (Gr. νέος), new, i.e., a new genus presumed to be related to Cyema

Neocyema erythrosoma Castle 1978 érythrós (Gr. ἐρυθρός), red; sốma (Gr. $\sigma \widetilde{\omega} \mu \alpha$), body, referring to its bright-red coloration
