## Installers of the Software for Windows® Released to Solid State Drives

Toshiba is informing the users of Storage Utilities that a security vulnerability has been found in its Windows® based installer.

If you have downloaded the Storage Utilities installer prior to April 11, 2017, please delete the installer from your Windows® PC without

executing it.

As our immediate workaround for this issue, the affected Storage Utilities installer has been removed from the Toshiba website as of April 11, 2017.

An updated Windows® based Storage Utilities installer will be available on the Toshiba website by May 19, 2017.

**Note:** If you have already installed Storage Utilities, you may continue using it. Storage Utilities, once installed, will not cause issues to your PC. However, it is highly recommended to delete the installer from your Windows® PC to avoid inadvertently executing it.

If you wish to install or update Storage Utilities on your Windows<sup>®</sup> PC, please use the updated installer that will be available on May 19, 2017 from the Toshiba website.

#### Affected Software

The Windows® based installers of Storage Utilities listed below:

Storage\_Utilities\_v3.11 and prior revisions

### Vulnerability description

The affected installers of Storage Utilities contain an issue with their DLL (Dynamic Link Libraries) path, which may insecurely load a DLL if executed.

### **Impact**

If your Windows® PC contains an unauthorized DLL maliciously implanted by an attacker and you execute the affected installer of Storage Utilities (Storage\_Utilities\_v3.11 and/or prior), this may cause insecure operations on your Windows® PC.

# Solution

Delete the affected installers from your Windows® PC without executing them.



#### How to delete the installers


Please follow the procedure below to delete the installers from your Windows® PC:

The procedure below is an example for Windows<sup>®</sup> 10.


1. Open "File Explore" from the Taskbar.




